"Medical Faculty of SAITM cease to be in operation. 3. Notwithstanding the provision of any other written law, immediately upon the completion of the absorption of students referred to in section 2, the Medical Faculty of SAITM shall cease to be eligible to award the MBBS Degree and shall cease to be in operation."

Question that the Clause be read a second time, put, and agreed to.

Question that the Clause be added to the Bill, put and agreed to.

"AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISIONS FOR THE ABSORPTION OF STUDENTS REGISTERED WITH THE SOUTH ASIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY AND MEDICINE TO THE GENERAL SIR JOHN KOTELAWALA DEFENCE UNIVERSITY ESTABLISHED UNDER THE SIR JOHN KOTELAWALA DEFENCE UNIVERSITY ACT, NO 68 OF 1981 AS A MATTER OF NATIONAL INTEREST AND TO PROVIDE FOR MATTERS CONNCECTED THEREWITH OR INCIDENTIAL THERETO."

Question that the Long Title stand part of the Bill, put, and agreed to.

Bill reported with Amendments.

Bill, as amended, accordingly read the third time and passed.
