  - (iv) the period of time for which she has been in public service on a permanent basis from 03.03.2003 up to 11.02.2013; and
  - (v) the person who is authorized to appoint an officer to act on the post of Director General of Coast Conservation?

- (v) if so, the inferences of that investigation?
