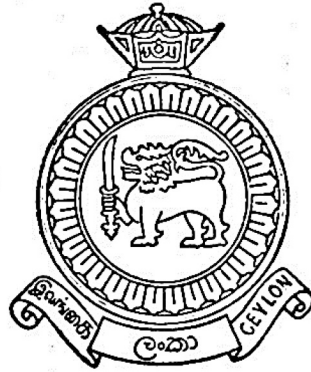

AN ACT TO AMEND THE AIR CEYLON ACT.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Air Ceylon (Amendment) Act, No. 40 of 1971.

Short title.

2. The following new section is hereby inserted immediately after section 4, and shall have effect as section 4A, of the Air Ceylon Act, hereafter referred to as the "principal Act":—

4A. The Minister may, from time to time, either of his own motion or after consultation with the corporation, give to the corporation in writing general or special directions as to the performance of its duties and the exercise of its powers, and the corporation shall give effect to such directions."

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

Amendment of
section 9 of the
principal Act.

(a) in sub-section (1) of that section by the substitution, for the word "three", of the words "not more than five"; and

(b) in sub-section (3) of that section by the omission of the words "public officer or a".
