AN ACT TO AMEND THE TEA CONTROL ACT,
No. 28 OF 1949.

[Date of Assent: March 17, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Tea Control (Amendment) Act, No. 14 of 1950.

Short title.

2. Section 17 of the Tea Control Act, No. 28 of 1949, is hereby amended in sub-section (2) thereof as follows:—

- (1) by the substitution, for the words “ may ultimately ”, of the words “ may at the end of each year of control ”; and
- (2) by the substitution, for the words “ shall be applied ”, of the words “ may be applied ”.
