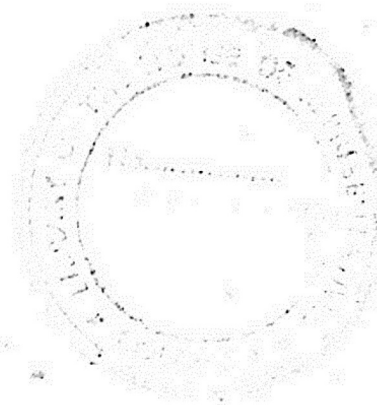

AN ACT TO AMEND THE SPECIAL AREAS (COLOMBO)
DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, No. 40 OF 1947.

[Date of Assent: March 10, 1954.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Areas (Colombo) Development (Amendment) Act, No. 16 of 1954.

Short title.

2. The Special Areas (Colombo) Development Ordinance, No. 40 of 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal enactment") is hereby amended in section 5A thereof (inserted by Act No. 41 of 1952) by the repeal of sub-section (3) of that section.

3. Section 35 of the principal enactment is hereby amended in sub-section (1) of that section, by the substitution, for the words "two-thirds of the number of", of the word "four".

4. (1) The amendment effected by section 2 of this Act shall be deemed for all purposes to have been made in the principal enactment on November 22, 1952, being the date of the commencement of Act, No. 41 of 1952.

Retrospective
and saving
provision.

(2) For the prevention of doubts, it is hereby declared that, except in so far as section 5A of the principal enactment as amended by Act, No. 41 of 1952, provides for the reference of certain disputes and for the modification of the Defence (Compensation) Regulations, 1941, in their application in relation to such disputes, nothing in that section shall be deemed to have affected the validity or effect of the resolution under section 6 of the Defence Regulations (Extension) Act, No. 24 of 1950, which was passed by the Senate on November 18, 1952, and by the House of Representatives on November 11, 1952.
