AN ACT TO MAKE THE FUGITIVE OFFENDERS ACT, 1881,
APPLICABLE IN RELATION TO INDIA.

[Date of Assent: March 10, 1954.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Extradition (India) Act, No. 15 of 1954. Short title.

2. The Fugitive Offenders Act, 1881, enacted by the Parliament of the United Kingdom and continuing to be part of the law of Ceylon shall have effect as though every reference therein to a part of Her Majesty's dominions includes a reference to the territory of the Republic of India. Application
