AN ACT TO AMEND THE TEA CONTROL ACT,
No. 28 of 1949.

[Date of Assent: June 22, 1954.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Tea Control (Amendment) Act, No. 27 of 1954.

Short title.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 17 of the Tea Control Act, No. 28 of 1949, is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) in paragraph (c) of that sub-section, by the substitution, for the words “under this Act, and”, of the words “under this Act, ”;

(2) in paragraph (d) of that sub-section, by the substitution, for the words “appointed date.”, of the words “appointed date, and ”; and

(3) by the addition, immediately after paragraph (d) of that sub-section, of the following new paragraph:—

“ (e) all expenses of the administration of the Tea Thefts Prevention Act. No. 45 of 1953. ”.
