AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE TRINCOMALEE, PANKULAMA,
MORAWEWA SOUTH, SIRIGAJABAA GAL LEN RAJAMAH
VIHAARASTHA SANWARDHANA SABHAWA

WHEREAS a Sabhawa called and known as the “Trincomalee, Pankulama, Morawewa South, Sirigajabaa Gal Len Rajamaha Vihaarastha Sanwardhana Sabhawa” has heretofore been established in Sri Lanka, for the purpose of effectually carrying out its objects and transacting all matters connected with the said Sabhawa according to the rules agreed to by its members:

AND WHEREAS the said Sabhawa has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted the several objects and matters for which it was established and has applied to be incorporated and it will be for the public advantage to grant the application:

BE it therefore, enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Trincomalee, Pankulama, Morawewa South, Sirigajabaa Gal Len Rajamaha Vihaarastha Sanwardhana Sabhawa (Incorporation) Act, No. of 2015.

2. (1) From and after the date of commencement of this Act, such and so many person as now are members of the “Trincomalee, Pankulama, Morawewa South, Sirigajabaa Gal Len Rajamaha Vihaarastha Sanwardhana Sabhawa” (hereinafter referred to as the “Sabhawa”) or shall hereafter be admitted as members of the Corporation hereby constituted, shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession, under the name and style of the “Trincomalee, Pankulama, Morawewa South, Sirigajabaa Gal Len Rajamaha Vihaarastha Sanwardhana Sabhawa” (hereinafter referred to

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as “the Corporation”) and by that name may sue and be sued with full power and authority to have, and use a common seal and to alter the same at its pleasure.

5 (2) The Corporation shall be deemed to be a Voluntary Social Service Organization within the meaning and for the purpose of the Voluntary Social Services Organizations (Registration and Supervision) Act, No. 31 of 1980 and the provisions of that Act shall apply to and in relation to the management of the affairs of the Corporation.

10 **3.** (1) The general objects for which the Corporation is constituted, are hereby declared to be— General
objects of the
Corporation.

15 (a) providing for, maintaining and operating the Development Council, the Sirigajabaa Tharuna Bauddha Sangamaya, Sirigajabaa Kaarya Saadhaka Samithiya and Gajaba Avamangalyaadhaara Samithiya based at the Sirigajabaa Gal Len Rajamaha Viharaya in Morawewa, Pankulama, Trincomalee, organizing affairs in a manner that will create a reawakening in Buddhist people towards the Sasana and improving the social and economic activities of the residents of the area;

25 (b) developing and protecting as a place of religiously and cultureally important action including the commencement of the Development Council based at the Sirigajabaa Gal Len Rajamaha Viharaya in Morawewa, Pankulama, Trincomalee stated above;

(c) fulfilling the housing, health and clean drinking water needs of the poor and destitute persons in the area;

30 (d) providing facilities to uplift the education of poor school children in the district;

- (e) maintaining, encouraging and supporting the religious cultural, social, health and welfare services to members;
- (f) protecting and promoting Buddhism;
- 5 (g) teaching and training Buddhist priests on the Buddhist doctrine and discipline and giving them proficiency on Pali, Sanskrit, Sinhalese and other oriental languages;
- 10 (h) establishing Dhamma schools to provide the young generation with knowledge on Buddhist doctrine;
- (i) disseminating the message contained in the teachings of the Lord Buddha and propagating the Buddhist culture for world peace.

15 (2) In the implementation of the objects specified in subsection (1) the Corporation shall ensure that such implementation shall be carried out without any distinction based on race, language, caste, sex, political opinion, place of birth or any of such grounds.

20 **4.** The objects of the Corporation shall be carried out in such manner so as not to create any conflict between the work of the Corporation and any work being carried out simulataneously by any Ministry or Department of the Government or of any Provincial Council.

Corporation to ensure no conflict with work of Ministry or Department of the Government of Province.

25 **5.** (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act the management and administration of the affairs of the Corporation shall be carried out by an Executive committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee") consisting of such number of office bearers as may be specified by the rules made under section 7.

Management of the affairs of the Corporation.

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(2) (a) The Committee of the Sabhawa holding office on
the day immediately preceding the date of commencement
of this Act, shall function as the Committee of the Corporation
until the first Committee is appointed or elected in the
5 manner provided for by rules made under section 7.

(b) The first committee of the Corporation shall be
appointed or elected within one year of the date of
commencement of this Act.

(3) (a) Every office bearer of the Committee including
10 the patrons and advisors, shall be appointed or elected for a
period of three years and any such office bearer, patron or
advisor shall be eligible for re-appointment or re-election
after lapse of the said period of three years.

(b) In the event of a vacancy occurring due to the death,
15 resignation, incapacity or removal from office of an officer
bearer, the Committee shall having regard to the rules of the
Corporation, elect or appoint a person to fill such vacancy.

(c) The person elected or appointed under paragraph (b)
shall hold office only for the unexpired portion of the term
20 of office of the member whom he succeeds.

6. Subject to the provision of this Act and any other Powers of the
written law, the Corporation shall have the power to do, Corporation.
perform and execute all such acts and matters as are necessary
or desirable for the promotion or furtherance of its objects
25 of the Corporation or any one of them, including the power—

(a) to purchase, rent, construct, or renovate lands or
buildings which may be required for the purposes
of the Corporation and to deal with or dispose of
the same as may be deemed expedient with a view
30 to promoting the objects of the Corporation;

- (b) to borrow or raise funds with or without securities and to receive grants, gifts or donations in cash or in kind:

5 Provided that, the committee shall obtain the prior written approval of the Department of External Resources of the Minister assigned the subject of Finance, in respect of all foreign grants, gifts or donations made to the Corporation;

- 10 (c) to make, draw, accept, discount, endores, negotiate, buy, sell and issue bills of exchange, cheques, promissory notes and other negotiable instruments and to open, operate, maintain and close accounts in any bank;

- 15 (d) to invest any funds that are not immediately required for the purposes of the Corporation, in such manner as the Committee may determine;

- 20 (e) to undertake, accept, execute, perform and administer and lawful trust or any real or personal property with a view to promoting the objects of the Corporation;

- 25 (f) to appoint, employ, dismiss or terminate the services of officers and servants of the Corporation and exercise disciplinary control over them and to pay them such salaries, allowances and gratuities as may be determined by the Corporation;

- (g) to organize lectures, seminars and conferences with a view to promoting the objectives of the Corporation;

- 30 (h) to liaise and co-ordinate with other local and foreing institutions having similar objects to that of the Corporation; and

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- (i) to train personnel in Sri Lanka or abroad for the purposes of the Corporation.

5 7. (1) It shall be lawful for the Corporation, from time to time, at any General Meeting of the Corporation and by a majority of not less than two-third of the members present and voting, to make rules, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any other written law, for all or any of the following matters :—

Rules of the Corporation.

- 10 (a) the classification of membership, admission, withdrawal, expulsion or resignation of members and fees payable by the members;
- 15 (b) the election of office bearers of the Committee or vacation of or removal from office of office bearers and the powers, duties and functions of the office bearers;
- 20 (c) the terms and conditions of appointment, powers, functions and duties of various officers, agents and servants of the Corporation ;
- 25 (d) the procedure to be followed for the summoning and holding of meetings of the Committee or any sub-Committee thereof, notices and agenda of such meetings, the quorum and the conduct of business thereat;
- 30 (e) the qualifications and disqualifications to be a member of the Committee and Corporation;
- (f) the administration and management of the property of the Corporation;and
- (g) generally the management of the affairs of the Corporation and the accomplishment of its' objects and dissolution of the Corporation.

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(2) Any rule made by the Corporation may be amended, altered, added to or rescinded at a like meeting and in like manner as a rule made under subsection (1) of this section.

5 (3) The members of the Corporation shall at all time be subject to the rules of the Corporation.

8. The Committee shall maintain a register of members in which name, address and other essential details of the members shall be inscribed. Register of members.

9. (1) The Corporation shall have its own Fund. Fund of the Corporation.

10 (2) All moneys received by way of a gift, bequest, donation, subscription, contribution, fees or grants for and on account of the Corporation shall be deposited in one or more banks approved by the Committee to the credit of the Corporation.

15 (3) There shall be paid out of the Fund, all sums of money as are required to defray any expenditure incurred by the Corporation in the exercise, performance and discharge of its powers, duties and functions under the Act.

20 **10.** (1) The financial year of the Corporation shall be the calendar year. Accounts and Auditing.

(2) The Corporation shall cause proper accounts to be kept of its income and expenditure, assets and liabilities and all other transactions of the Corporation.

25 (3) The accounts of the Corporation shall be audited annually by the Auditor General or a qualified auditor appointed by Auditor General in terms of Article 154 of the Consitution.

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(4) For the purposes of this section “qualified auditor” means—

- 5 (a) an individual who, being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accounts of Sri Lanka or of any other Institute established by law, possesses a certificate to practice as an Accountant, issued by the Council of such Institute; or
- 10 (b) a firm of Accountants, each of the resident partners of which being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka or of any other Institute established by law, possesses a certificate to practice as an Accountant, issued by the Council of such Institute.

15 **11.** (1) The Committee shall prepare a report of the activities of the Corporation for each financial year and submit such report together with the audited statement of accounts to the Secretary of the Ministry of the Minister assigned the subject of Buddhasasana and Religious Affairs and to the Registrar of Voluntary Social Services
20 Organizations appointed under the Voluntary Social Services Organization (Registration and Supervision) Act, No. 31 of 1980 before the expiration of six months of the year succeeding the year to which such report relates.

Annual Report.

25 (2) A statement of accounts relating to the foreign and local moneys received by the Corporation during the financial year shall be attached to the report referred to in subsection (1).

30 **12.** All debts and liabilities of the Sabhawa existing on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act, shall be paid by the Corporation hereby constituted and all debts due to and subscriptions and contributions payable to the Sabhawa on that day shall be paid to the Corporation for the purposes of this Act.

Debts due by and payable to the Sabhawa.

- 13.** Subject to the provisions of this Act, the Corporation shall be able and capable in law to acquire and hold any property, movable or immovable which may become vested in it by virtue of any purchase, grant, gift, testamentary disposition or otherwise, and all such property shall be held by the Corporation for the purpose of this Act and subject to the rules of the Corporation made under Section 7, with power to sell, mortgage, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of, the same. Corporation may hold property movable and immovable.
- 14.** The moneys and property of the Corporation however derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Corporation and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus profit or profit to the members of the Corporation. Application of moneys and property.
- 15.** (1) The seal of the Corporation shall not be affixed to any instrument whatsoever, except in the presence of two members of the Committee who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence and such signing shall be independent of the signing of any person as a witness. Seal of the Corporation.
- (2) The seal of the Corporation shall be in the custody of an office bearer of the Committee as may be decided by such Committee.
- 16.** (1) If upon the dissolution of the Corporation there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, such property shall not be distributed among the members of the Corporation, but shall be given or transferred to any other institution having objects similar to those of the Corporation and which is by the rules thereof, prohibited from distributing any income or property among their members. Property remaining on dissolution.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1) the appropriate institution shall be determined by the members of the

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Corporation immediately before the dissolution, at a general meeting of the majority of votes of the members present.

5 **17.** Nothing in this Act contained shall prejudice or affect the rights of the Republic or of any body politic, or corporate. Saving of the rights of the Republic.

18. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall prevail. Sinhala text to prevail in case of inconsistency.

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
