1.2 Vision, Mission, and Objectives of the Institution

Vision

Procurement system leads to the national development

Mission

To formulate policies and procedures to facilitate the implementation of procurement system through standardizing, monitoring, investigating and reporting in order to ensure value for money.

Objectives

- Formulate and develop sound public procurement policies and procedures.
- Ensure adherence to public procurement policy, guidelines and procedures.
- Establish an effective procurement performance monitoring system.
- Establish an accreditation system for officials engaged in the procurement process.
- Strengthen the service delivery through compliance with sound public procurement principles.

1.3 Key Functions

- (a) Monitor and report to the appropriate authorities, on whether all procurement of goods, works, services, consultancy services and information systems by government institutions are based on procurement plans prepared in accordance with previously approved action plans;
- (b) Monitor and report to the appropriate authorities on whether all qualified bidders for the provision of goods, works, services, consultancy services and information systems by government institutions are afforded an equal opportunity to participate in the bidding process for the provision of those goods, works, services, consultancy services and information systems;
- (c) Monitor and report to the appropriate authorities on whether the procedures for the selection of contractors, and the awarding of contracts for the provision of goods, works, services, consultancy services and information systems to government institutions, are fair and transparent;

- (d) Report on whether members of Procurement Committees and Technical Evaluation Committees relating to the procurements, appointed by government institutions are suitably qualified;
- (e) Investigate complaints/reports of procurements made by government institutions outside established procedures and guidelines, and to report the officers responsible for such procurements to the relevant authorities for necessary action; and
- (f) Promote awareness of the policies, guidelines and procedures on public procurement.

In order to implement the said constitutional mandate, the Commission had prepared an Action Plan for the years 2023 - 2025, listing in detail, the specific activities to be followed during each year. The ensuing report describes in detail, the activities carried out by the NPC during the period from January 01st to December 1st, 2024 in terms of the Action Plan assigned for the year 2024.

With respect to the Action Plan the NPC has decided to formulate following new Guidelines and Manuals for public procurement,

- Guidelines for Goods, Services and Non-Consultancy Services and Manual
- Guidelines for Consultancy Services and Manual
- Guidelines for Contract Management

By adhering to the Article 156C. (1) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, the Commission meetings and meetings/workshops conducted with other Government Institutions by the National Procurement Commission during the year 2024 are summarized below.

Organizational Structure of the NPC

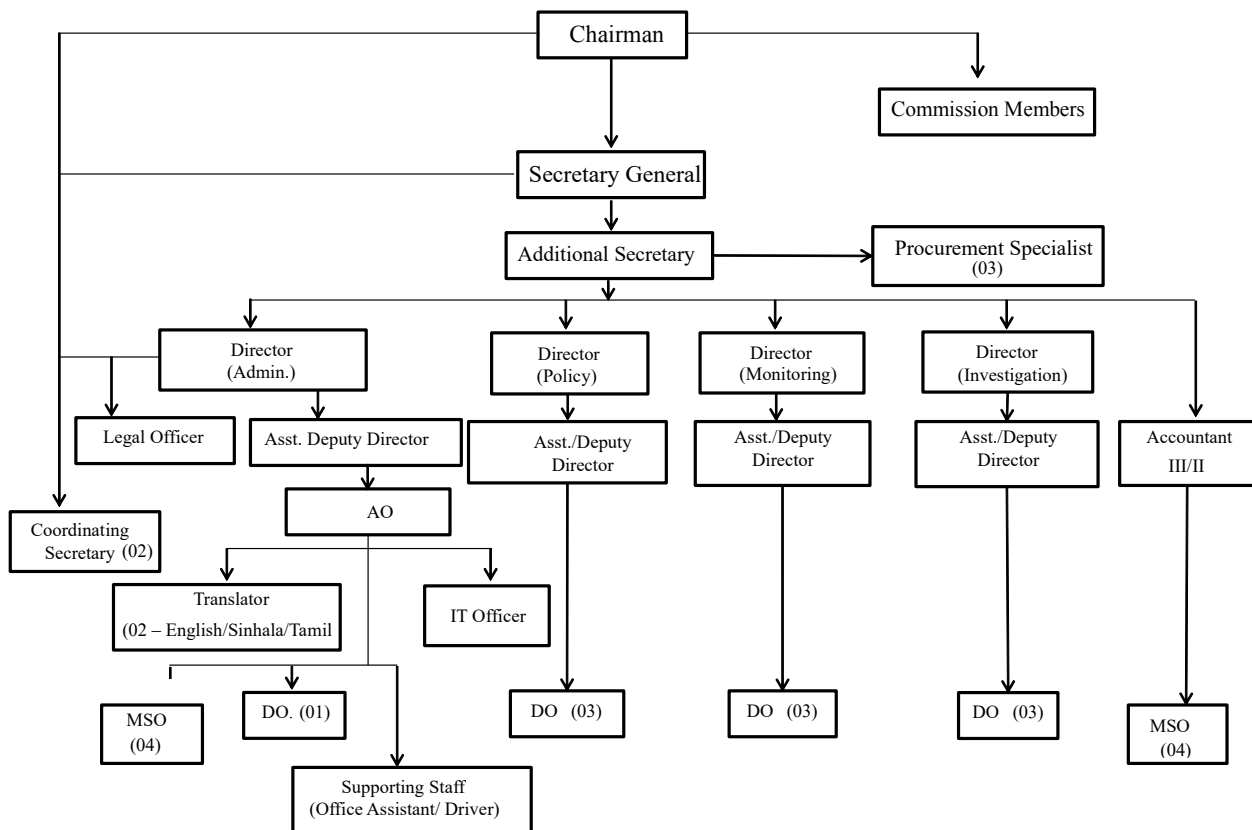


Figure 1: Organizational Structure of the NPC

1.4 Main Divisions of the National Procurement Commission

Administration and Accounts Division

The General Administration of the Institution, attending to the establishments matters as well as implementing the Core Function of Strengthening the Delivery Capacity of the NPC and responsible for all matters of finance, accounting and procurement in the office of the NPC, are undertaken by this division. Additionally, it coordinates with government institutions, including Parliament, the Office of the Cabinet of Ministers, the Presidential Secretariat, and the Ministry of Finance. It provides observations and reports on Cabinet Memoranda related to procurement matters addressed to the NPC and supports the National Procurement Commission in its functions.

The Director (Administration) leads this Division.

Procurement Policy Division

The Procurement Policy Division is responsible for policy formulation, standardization, and reforms related to public procurement. In this capacity, the Division offers observations and recommendations to the Commission on policy matters. It is also tasked with implementing capacity-building programs, training, and raising awareness among procuring entities. Additionally, the Division submits observations and reports on Cabinet memoranda directed to the NPC concerning procurement-related issues.

The Director (Policy) leads the Division.

Procurement Monitoring Division

The Division monitors and reports to the appropriate authorities on whether all procurement of goods, services, works, consultancy services, and information systems by government institutions aligns with procurement plans developed in accordance with previously approved action plans. Furthermore, the Division assesses the adherence of procuring entities to procurement principles. Additionally, it submits observations and reports on Cabinet memoranda directed to the NPC regarding procurement-related issues.

The Director (Monitoring) leads the Division.

Procurement Investigation Division

This division investigates complaints and reports regarding procurements conducted by government institutions outside established procedures and guidelines. It identifies the officers responsible for such procurements and reports them to the relevant authorities for appropriate action. Additionally, the division implements measures to prevent the recurrence of such lapses in future procurements. Additionally, it submits observations and reports on Cabinet memoranda directed to the NPC regarding procurement-related issues.

The Director (Investigations) leads the Division.

Chapter 2

2.1 Administration Division

The Administration Division is responsible for establishments matters of the office of the National Procurement Commission and for implementing the core function of strengthening the NPC's delivery capacity. This division is led by the Director (Administration).

Under the policy formulation including guidelines, procedures and standards related to public procurement, the Policy Division carried out the following tasks related to the formulation of guidelines and procedures.

i. Procurement Guidelines 2024 for Goods, Works and Non-consulting Services

The above guidelines were published in the Gazette on 25.11.2024 and the relevant circular was issued with effect from 01.01.2025. Also, the manual for the same was published at the same time.

ii. Guidelines for the Procurement of Consulting Services

The Guidelines for the Procurement of Consulting Services have been drafted and are scheduled to be issued in 2025, along with the related manual.

iii. Guidelines for Contract Management

The initial draft has been completed and is under review.

iv. Guidelines for Procurement of Pharmaceutical and Medical Devices

The first draft of this guideline was prepared under the auspices of the Asian Development Bank and is currently in the review stage.

v. Public Procurement Act

The first draft of this Act was prepared under the auspices of the Asian Development Bank and is currently in the review stage.

vi. Electronic Public Procurement (e-GP)

The necessary guidelines, advice, observations and suggestions were provided as requested by the Commission regarding the implementation of electronic public procurement (e-GP).

vii. Sustainable/ Green Public Procurement

The necessary guidelines, observations and suggestions were submitted for the introduction of Sustainable/Green Public Procurement.

3.3 Capacity Building

i. Training Programs

A training plan for the year 2025 was prepared targeting the public sector.

ii. Awareness Programs

A series of awareness programs were planned for the Procurement Guidelines for Goods and Non-Consulting Services 2024 and the following programs were conducted in 2024;

a) For Secretaries of Ministries, Chief Secretaries of Provincial Councils and Heads of Special Expenditure Units - on 6th December 2024; and

b) For Heads of Departments and Institutions - on 13th December 2024.

Chapter 4

4.1 Procurement Monitoring Division

The Monitoring Division oversees recurring procurement activities and post-procurement reviews of procurement activities conducted by procurement entities. This division plays a critical role in ensuring adherence to procurement regulations and standards by examining the processes and outcomes of government procurement activities.

In alignment with its constitutional mandate, the division requests and analyzes procurement reports and documents submitted by government institutions. The primary objective is to monitor, assess, and report on procurement processes' effectiveness, transparency, and compliance. Through its activities, the Monitoring Division seeks to uphold accountability, enhance operational integrity, and provide actionable insights to improve the overall procurement framework within the public sector.

4.2 Progress of the Procurement Monitoring Division

1. A significant milestone was achieved through successful discussions and agreement with the UNDP regarding the high-level conceptual design and implementation requirements of the National Procurement Monitoring Platform. As part of the collaboration, the UNDP will provide crucial support during the implementation phase by procuring the necessary IT equipment. This includes 10 desktop computers, 10 notebook computers, 1 high-yield office printer with scanning and copying capabilities, and 2 multifunction network printers, which will enhance the operational capacity of the Monitoring Division. Along with the software requirement specification, a comprehensive user interface guide has been submitted to the National Procurement Commission (NPC) for review. After evaluating these documents, the NPC has endorsed the overall design of the platform and agreed on the necessary adjustments that will be incorporated during the implementation phase.

The Monitoring Division has made notable strides in the early stages of developing the proposed National Procurement Monitoring Platform, a key initiative aimed at automating the procurement monitoring process and replacing the current paper-based systems. This platform is being designed as an advanced "interactive web-based system," to initiate its implementation in 2025. Currently, the system is in the pre-development phase, with foundational work underway to ensure its successful rollout.

2. Made active contributions to the compilation and review of articles and provisions related to procurement monitoring in the development of the Procurement Guidelines for Goods, Works, Services, and Non-Consulting Services.
3. Media reports, newspaper articles, and public concerns regarding procurement irregularities are being actively addressed. In response, relevant documentation on these issues is being requested from the concerned parties to ensure a thorough review and appropriate action. This process aims to investigate the reported irregularities, verify the details, and take corrective measures as necessary to uphold transparency and accountability in procurement activities.

4.3 Work in Progress

1. Requested information on awarded procurements for 2022 and 2023 from all Ministries, District Secretariats, and their respective institutions and divisional secretariats. After receiving and evaluating the data, the Commission's approval was obtained to request clarifications from the relevant institutions where non-competitive procurement methods accounted for more than 50% of the total procurement value. This process is still ongoing, with clarifications being requested from the respective institutions.
2. Requested action plans and procurement plans for the year 2024, including detailed information, from all Ministries, which are still in the process of being completed.
3. Requested information on the publication of awarded procurements for the first half of 2024, per section 8.10 of the Procurement Guidelines, which is currently being finalized.
4. Requested documentation related to the IFB/EOI published in the newspapers. After receiving and evaluating the information, a report was submitted to the Commission highlighting lapses and irregularities. A checklist has been formulated for this purpose under the supervision of the Commission. The Commission's decisions regarding these issues were then communicated to the relevant authorities.

4.4 Challenges

- The delay in receiving all the required documents, coupled with the receipt of incomplete documentation from the relevant Procuring Entities has created significant challenges in the monitoring and evaluation process. These issues have hindered the timely and thorough assessment of procurement activities, affecting the overall effectiveness of monitoring efforts and the ability to ensure compliance with established guidelines.
- A recurring challenge in the monitoring process is the lack of a designated officer responsible for collecting and compiling information from the various sectors, departments, institutions, and offices within each Ministry. Although we typically communicate with the Secretary of the relevant Ministries to request necessary information, the absence of a specific point of contact within these Ministries to coordinate the gathering and submission of data from their affiliated institutions causes delays. This lack of accountability in the information collection process also leads to difficulties in obtaining timely and complete data, and often requires additional follow-up to clarify details, hindering the efficiency of our monitoring activities.

4.5 Goals

The main purpose of monitoring is to ensure that:

- a) Verify compliance of government procurement with approved action plans;
- b) Ensure equal opportunities are provided to qualified bidders in government procurement;
- c) Promote fairness and transparency in the selection of contractors and the awarding of contracts;
- d) Evaluate the qualifications of members in procurement and evaluation committees;

- e) Review and report on procurements conducted in breach of established procedures, providing recommendations;

Additionally, the Monitoring Division;

- Advises the Heads of relevant procurement entities to take appropriate measures to prevent procurement malpractices; and
- Oversees the implementation of the National Procurement Monitoring System to track procurement process workflows, ensuring compliance, accountability, and enhanced transparency.
