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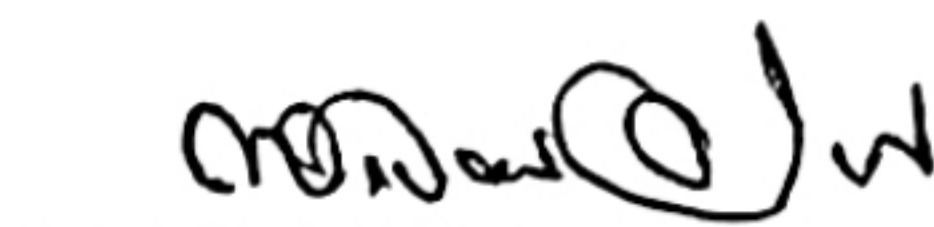

Audit Paragraph No. 4.2(c) of 2019 Officers of All Island Executive Services recruited on approval of the Public Service Commission and attached to the Southern Provincial Council, have been granted promotions, allowances and privileges contrary to service minutes without recommendations of the Public Service Commission	The report forwarded through letter No.CSS/7/4/02/2017 dated 18.04.2023 of the Chief Secretary of the Southern Province, has been recommended and submitted to the Committee on Public Accounts through letter No.PL/6/7/4/SP dated 25.04.2023. (Annexure 03)
That the total assets of the Southern Provincial Council have been increased as Rs.15,602 million in year 2019 and as Rs.55,372 million in year 2021	As a decrease in the number of institutions and the amount of assets belonging to provincial councils is indicated, registers on lands, buildings, office equipment, furniture and constructions etc. have not been properly maintained or the assessed values have not been properly recorded. As such, a Guideline on Accounting of Assets of Ministries, Departments, statutory institutions and local authorities under the purview of the provincial council (Annexure 04) has been issued for preventing irregularities arisen thereby and, all Provincial Chief Secretaries have been notified by letter No.PL/6/7/4/SP dated 03.01.2025 along with copies to the Committee on Public Accounts as well, to account assets adapting to the said Guideline.
