13	Number of training opportunities provided out of the planned training opportunities remained at less than 50%.	Even though an amount of Rs.166 Million had been reserved for the implementation on planned training opportunities the year 2022, Followings were observed on the fact that no sufficient progress has been reported. Due to the inability to make payments in year 2022 it self for some of the programmes implemented in year 2022, payments of Rs.54.7 Million in arrears have been paid in the year 2023. Accordingly, it can be considered that there is a progress of Rs. 119 Million (72%) in relation to the year 2022 . Some of the planned programmes have not been held and payments for several programmes that were held, have not been made. a. Even though It was planned to offer a Master's degree in Educational Management at NSBM for 50 officers, this the programme could not be carried out due to the rejection of NSBM's application by the Quality Assurance and Accreditation Committee. b. Even though the Service orientation had been held for 135 officers recruited to Grade III of the Sri Lanka Principal Service at the Education Leadership Development and Management Academy,Meepe, no payments have been made for it yet . c. A Certificate course on research methodology and a certificate course on data analysis have been conducted by the Library and Documentation Services Board for officers of the Sri Lanka Education Administrative Service and payments of Rs. 1.83 Million for this had been made in the year 2024. d. Further, the course duration of officers

		who studied for the Master's Degree in Educational Management at the University of Colombo was extended due to Covid and since the course was extended by one year due to the pandemic, no advance payments were made to those officers and the course was offered to officers on the basis of reimbursement for those who have completed the course. e. Applications had to be made for the MBA (HRM) degree course at the University of Sri Jayewardenepura as per the announcement of that university, a sufficient number of officers have not applied for this.
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
