The Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40)

By virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 12 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40), I have issued an order to the effect that all members of the Armed Forces specified in the First Schedule are summoned for the maintenance of Public Order in the areas specified in Second Schedule thereof taking into consideration the need for the Public Order to be maintained.

Accordingly, I hereby inform the Parliament of the said Order in terms of Section 2(3) of the aforesaid Ordinance read with Section 21(2) thereof.

2. Announcements by the Speaker: The Speaker made the following announcements:—

“I wish to inform that I have endorsed the certificates on the ‘Samurdhi (Amendment) Bill’ and ‘Rubber Control (Amendment) Bill’ on the 22nd of August 2025 and ‘Gambling Regulatory Authority Bill’ on the 03rd of September 2025 in terms of the provisions of Article 79 of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.”

II

“I wish to announce Parliament that I have received the Determination of the Supreme Court in respect of the Bill titled ‘Presidents’ Entitlements (Repeal)’ which was challenged in the Supreme Court under Article 121 (1) of the Constitution.

The Supreme Court has determined that no provision of the Bill is inconsistent with any provision of the Constitution and can be enacted by Parliament with a simple majority.

Further, the Supreme Court has rejected the Petition No. SC/SD/29/2025 filed in this regard on the ground that the Petitioner had failed to comply with the mandatory provisions in Article 121(1) of the Constitution in invoking the jurisdiction of the Court.

I order that the Determination of the Supreme Court be printed in the official report of today's proceedings.”
