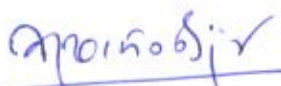
Submission of observations of Hon. Minister and steps taken with regard to the reports tabled by the Committee on Public Accounts in terms of Standing Order No. 119(4)

Submission of the observations of and action taken by the Secretary General of Parliament on the report tabled by the Committee on Public Accounts in terms of Standing Order No. 119(4)

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Recommendations made by the Committee	Action taken by the Institution to implement the said recommendations and the current progress
To take necessary steps to refer to the Attorney General the report prepared by the Committee on Public Accounts on the scheme implemented from 01 May 2022 to 15 September 2023 for issuing permits to Sri Lankans employed overseas to import fully electric vehicles on the basis of remittances they send to Sri Lanka for taking legal action by a resolution of Parliament after submitting the said report to Parliament.	(1) The said Report of the Committee, being the Third Report of the Committee on Public Accounts for the First Session of the Tenth Parliament, was tabled in Parliament on 24 October 2025. (2) Thereafter, the Report of the Committee was forwarded to the Minister in charge of Finance and to the Ministers in charge of the relevant institutions for their observations on 17 November 2025 in terms of the provisions of Standing Order 119(4) of Parliament. (3) By 04 March 2026, the observations of the Minister of Foreign Employment and Tourism have been submitted to Parliament, and it has been informed that the observations of the Minister of Finance, Planning and Economic Development have also been forwarded to the Leader of the House of Parliament in order to be submitted to Parliament. Further, the Committee on Public Accounts has sent reminder letters to the Ministry of Labour and to the Ministry of Transport, Highways and Urban Development, which have failed to submit their reports so far. (4) After the said reports from the relevant ministries have been submitted to Parliament in response to the above-mentioned reminder letters, steps will be taken to refer them back to the Committee on Public Accounts for consideration. (5) After reviewing the progress that has been made in accordance with the report of the Committee and the recommendations made, decisions will be made on the future action to be taken, and the recommendations made by the Committee based on those decisions will be submitted to Parliament in the form of a resolution. (6) Thereafter, if a resolution is passed in Parliament to refer the report of the Committee to the Attorney General for legal action, steps will be taken accordingly to refer the report to the Attorney General.
