Consequently, vehicles were not in proper running condition for the fuel consumption tests. Therefore, it was not possible to properly conduct fuel consumption tests for several vehicles which repairs had been delayed. Thereafter, necessary steps were taken to ensure that fuel consumption tests of the vehicles are carried out properly, and actions are being taken in accordance with the relevant circular provisions.
