Deficiencies identified by the Committee	Measures taken by the institution to rectify deficiencies / present Position
A website had not been created or maintained to provide information about the institute to the public. The website that is maintained by the institution does not provide an opportunity for the public to lodge complaints or to give commendations.	Although, the Office of the Chief Government whip is operated under a separate Head of Expenditure, functions of this office are performed in collaboration with Parliament of Sri Lanka. Coordination of functions of the Members represented the Government Group of Parliament and assisting to fulfill the businesses of Parliament are carried out by this office and the details of all the Members and other related information have been included to the Parliamentary website. Therefore, no requirement has yet arisen to maintain a separate website. Matters were presented at the Meeting of the Audit and Management Committee that it was ineffective to maintain a separate website taking into consideration the financial expenses and human resources required for this purpose.
The institution had failed to identify the sustainable development goals applicable to its scope. The targets to be reached to achieve the identified sustainable goals had not been decided. The indicators to measure the progress of implementation of Sustainable Development Goals had not been set.	Three sustainable goals have been identified for the year 2026 and the relevant targets to be reached and the indicators of measuring the progress have been set.
