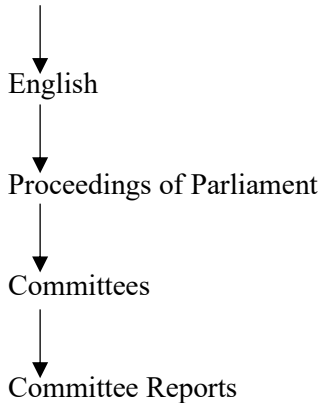

Note by the Chair

The Committee on Public Enterprises, established under the Parliamentary Committees for Special Purposes, conducted an examination on 04.06.2025 of the Auditor General's Reports for the year 2023 the current performance of the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, which falls under the purview of the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, and I hereby submit the report of the investigation carried out in this regard.

The Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka was established by the Notification published in the Extra Ordinary Gazette No. 896/2 dated 07.11.1995, under Section 21 of the Universities Act No. 16 Of 1978, with effect from the said date and the attention of the Committee was drawn to the vision and the mission of the Sabaragamuwa University.

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the importance of formulating the strategic plan of the University in line with the objectives and goals that should be established in accordance with the current State framework, as well as to matters such as the existence of universities under a common organizational structure covering the entire university system and the proper distribution of the financial authority of the university.

Further, extensive discussions were held regarding the importance of admitting the maximum possible number of students for the first-year intake of the university and taking necessary measures to expedite the recruitment of lecturers required for the successful conduct of academic activities of the university, and the relevant recommendations have also been included in this report. The attention of the Committee was also drawn to the importance of taking maximum measures to prevent irregularities within the university system and to eliminate ragging in the university system, and the relevant recommendations in that regard have been included in this report.

In order to obtain an effective service through the investigations of the Committee on Public Enterprises, it is very important to properly implement the recommendations of this Committee, to carry out follow-up action, and to establish responsibility and accountability. Having been elected to Parliament by the sovereign power of Sri Lankans and serving as the Chair of this Committee, I wish to state that, with the support of the Member MPs of the Committee, every possible effort will be made to ensure the implementation of the recommendations made herein.

Executive Summary

The Committee on Public Enterprises of the Parliament examined the Auditor General's Report for the Year 2023 of the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka and matters relating to the current performance of the university on 04.06.2025.

It was discussed at the Committee, and emphasized that important institutional matters such as the organizational structure of the university, delegation of financial authority, strategic plan, action plan, and procurement plan should be properly maintained, while also stressing the importance of a common organizational structure covering the entire university system and the need to maintain an updated strategic plan together with the preparation of the annual action plan and procurement plan in line therewith.

The Committee stressed the importance of strengthening the Internal Audit Division and noted that a university handling an annual income and expenditure exceeding Rs. 3,000 million is not adequately served by a weak internal audit unit consisting of only three officers, and further pointed out that this could lead to financial irregularities and reduced efficiency.

It was also emphasized that necessary action should be taken to promptly fill essential vacancies in the university, and that student admissions should be carried out without delay and in a fair manner ensuring equal opportunity for students.

Furthermore, in relation to the death of a student from the Faculty of Technology who died due to an incident of ragging, the responsibility of conducting an independent investigation into the circumstances leading to the death was assigned to the Secretary of the Ministry of Education, and the Committee recommended the appointment of an independent committee to investigate several administrative issues of the University.

**First Session of the Tenth Parliament
Sixth Report of the Committee on Public Enterprises (COPE)**

The Committee on Public Enterprises hereby submits its sixth report of the first session of the tenth Parliament with pleasure.

All State Corporations, as well as commercial and other undertakings vested in the Government under any written law, and companies registered or deemed to be registered under the Companies Act No. 7 of 2007 in which 50% or more of the shares are held by the Government, a State Corporation, or a local authority, are subject to the examination of accounts and current performance presented to Parliament, with the assistance of the Auditor General, which constitutes the mandate of the Committee on Public Enterprises.

At present, there are 462 public enterprises under the supervision of the Committee on Public Enterprises, which are regulated under the Department of Public Enterprises and the Department of National Budget (Source: Department of Public Enterprises).

Among them, on 04.06.2025, the Committee on Public Enterprises examined the Auditor General's reports for the year 2023 of the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka which falls under the purview of the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, as well as the current performance and the observations and recommendations of the Committee had been included in this report.

**Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka
(Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education)**

Date of examination– 04.06.2025

Matters discussed

1. General matters related with the institution

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the vision and mission of the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, which was established under Section 21 of the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978 and, in accordance with Section 26 of the said Act, was brought into effect from 07.11.1995 by the Notification published in Extraordinary Gazette No. 896/2 of the same date.

1.1 Organizational Structure

The Committee observed that the organizational structure stated in the Annual Report for the year 2024 differs from the organizational structure set out in the Corporate Plan, and the Committee inquired into the reasons for the existence of two different organizational structure.

It was revealed to the Committee that the organizational structure approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC) is the approved organizational structure, and the Governing Council of the University and the Vice-Chancellor are the highest authorities in the hierarchy of the university, with the Senate and the Faculty Boards operating under them. It was further clarified that, in terms of the Universities Act, the “authorities” of the University do not refer to individuals, rather, the governing body is the Council of the University followed by the Senate, and under the Vice-Chancellor there is the Registrar, and under him the Bursar.

During the investigation carried out by the Committee regarding the organizational structures of the University of Colombo and University of Ruhuna, it was revealed that while the organizational structure of the University of Colombo had been properly prepared as stated above, the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka had two organizational structures.

The Vice Chancellor informed the Committee that, from the beginning, the organizational structure of the university had been established with the Vice Chancellor and the Council and if any amendment is required, it can be made as necessary.

The Committee pointed out the importance of creating and maintaining a common organizational structure for all universities and emphasized that the University Grants Commission (UGC) should perform the regulatory role in this regard.

As per the recommendation made by the Committee to prepare and submit a common organizational structure covering all universities, the organizational structure submitted by the University Grants Commission has been forwarded by the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education through a letter dated 24.07.2025. (Annexure-01)

Recommendation

- i. Application of this common organizational structure to all universities.

1.2 Responsibility relating to the financial authority of the University

The Committee drew its attention to the manner in which the financial authority of the University is delegated, as issues relating to payments had arisen during the audit process.

It was revealed that payments and approvals of the university are carried out by the Council of the University through the Finance Committee, and that the payment limits relating to the Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Bursar, other Assistant Registrars, Deans, and relevant officers of each university are determined by the Finance Committee and approved by the Council, while the responsibility for making payments, subject to the final approval and signature of the Vice Chancellor, rests with the Bursar.

At the Committee, the validity of payments made without the signature of the Vice Chancellor and the annual delegation of financial authority were discussed.

It was revealed at the Committee that the Deans of the Faculties have the authority to approve payments up to Rs.200, 000/- and the reports of the Finance Committee submitted to the Council and the Audit Committee.

During the inquiry into the independence of the Audit and Management Committees, the Committee observed that the Vice Chancellor serves as the Chairman of the Finance Committee, while a representative nominated by the University Grants Commission serves as the Chairman of the Management and Audit Committee.

Although an issue arose that, according to Circular No. 1/2021 of the Department of Public Enterprises, it would be appropriate for the Treasury representative to serve as the Chairman of this Committee, and that despite the presence of a Treasury representative, the Chairmanship of the

Committee was not held by such representative, it was revealed that, in terms of the Universities Act, any person possessing the relevant management knowledge may serve as the Chairman.

The Committee on Public Enterprises was of the view that, where there is a Treasury representative possessing the requisite knowledge, such representative should appoint as the Chairman.

The Committee also pointed out that the institution does not have a clear understanding regarding its organizational structure.

In accordance with the recommendation made by the Committee to examine whether the above payments were being carried out within the relevant financial limits, a report containing recommendations relating to the investigation conducted by the Internal Audit Division of the Ministry has been submitted to the Committee by the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Training through the letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 09.07.2025 (Annexure – 02)

Recommendation

- i. Implementation of the recommendations mentioned in the above report
- ii. In accordance with Department of Public Enterprises Circular No. 1/2021, appoint a representative possessing adequate financial knowledge as the representative of the General Treasury to hold the post of Chairman of the Audit Management Committee.

1.3 Composition and meetings of the Council

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the composition of the Council and the conduct of meetings and the Committee pointed out that although Article 44(8) of the Universities Act provides that the Council should consist of 25 members and that 10 meetings should be held annually, while the required number of meetings had been conducted, there remained one vacancy for an external member.

Recommendation

- i. Taking prompt action to fill the vacancy in the Council

1.4 Strategic Plan

A Strategic Plan for the period 2024–2028 had been prepared and approved by the Council on 28.03.2024, and the attention of the Committee was drawn to the following issues pertaining to the said Plan, namely:

- (1) How do we check if this **strategic plan** aligns with the objectives?
- (2) How do we assess the progress of that strategic plan?
- (3) Has this plan, which was prepared before 2024, changed to match current governance requirements?

The Committee observed that greater attention was being focused on the action plan in practice, while enough attention was not being paid to the strategic plan.

It was revealed to the Committee that, from this year onward, in allocating funds to universities, a system has been introduced whereby discussions are held with Vice Chancellors and Bursars, and progress reports are

obtained every three months, submitted to the Council, and then forwarded to the University Grants Commission (UGC).

The Committee that considered the matter of the lack of attention paid to the strategic plan, which determines the future direction of an institution, emphasized the importance of preparing a strategic plan that covers the institution's mission and, accordingly, formulating the Annual Action Plan and the Annual Budget based on it.

Recommendations

- i. Updating the strategic plan to align with prevailing Political, Economic and Social conditions.
- ii. Forming a system to align the strategic plan with the objectives of the institution and to monitor its program.

1.5 Action Plan

The Committee informed that the action plan for the year 2025 which had been prepared by the university and approved by the Council on 27.01.2024, should be reconsidered to determine whether it is aligned with the current educational policies and conditions.

1.6 Procurement Plan

The Committee observed that the procurement Plan for the year 2025 had not been approved by the Council as of 15.05.2025 and inquired about the parties responsible for said issue.

It was revealed that responsibility for procurement planning lies with the Bursar, and that the 2025 procurement plan had been submitted to the

Finance Committee on 29.05.2025, with plans to submit it to the Council in June.

The Committee pointed out that, although the action plan had been approved on 27 January, the delay in finalizing the Procurement Plan was an issue of concern.

It was further revealed that the procurement plan could be prepared based on estimates and that specific confirmation of budgetary allocations was not required at the planning stage.

The Committee emphasized that the annual procurement plan should be approved by the Chief Accounting Officer (Secretary to the Ministry) and this delay could be considered a neglect of responsibilities of the Bursar.

Recommendation

- i. Reporting to the Committee the date of approval of the procurement plan for the years 2023–2024.
- ii. Expeditiously submitting the procurement plan prepared for the year 2025 for the approval of the Secretary to the Ministry and reporting back to the Committee within one month.
- iii. Submitting a report on the status of procurement plans of all universities

1.7 Internal Audit

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the recommendation made at the Committee on Public Enterprises held on 09.11.2023 regarding the

strengthening of the Internal Audit Division. Although it had been recommended that the vacancies in the Internal Audit Division be filled promptly, it was observed that the necessary action had not been taken even as of 15.05.2025.

It was further revealed to the Committee that, according to the approved cadre of the Internal Audit Division, four posts have been approved, namely one Senior Assistant Internal Auditor, one Assistant Internal Auditor, and two Work Assistants. However, approval for recruitment to the post of Senior Assistant Internal Auditor has not yet been granted.

It was further revealed to the Committee that, although a Senior Assistant Internal Auditor is required to head the Internal Audit Division, an Assistant Internal Auditor is currently serving in that capacity. It was also noted that filling these vacancies requires the approval of the Department of Management Services and the Committee chaired by the Secretary to the Prime Minister, and that the relevant requests have already been submitted.

The Committee emphasized the need to strengthen the Internal Audit Division and pointed out that an internal audit unit comprising only three officers is not sufficient for a university handling an annual income and expenditure exceeding Rs. 3,000 million rupees. It was further observed that this situation could lead to financial irregularities and reduced efficiency. The Committee also highlighted the need to review the existing cadre structure.

Recommendation

- i. Taking necessary action to further strengthen the Internal Audit Division within the approved cadre.

As per the recommendation made by the Committee to take prompt action to fill the vacancy in the post of Senior Assistant Internal Auditor, the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education informed the Committee, by the letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 02.09.2025, that since there was no suitable officer available for appointment to the said vacant post, arrangements had been made, with the approval and agreement of the University, for the vacancy to be covered by the Assistant Internal Audit Officer currently serving in the University, (Annexure – 03)

1.8 Number of Employees

The Committee observed that as at 15.04.2025, the total number of staff vacancies stood at 398, including 139 vacancies in the academic staff. It was further brought to the attention of the Committee that, within the 139 academic staff vacancies, there were 29 vacancies for Emeritus Professors, 8 vacancies for Senior Professors, and 107 vacancies for Lecturers, and the Committee inquired into the matter.

It was revealed to the Committee that, although provisions had recently been granted to the university for academic and non-academic staff for three new faculties, approval from the committee chaired by the Secretary to the Prime Minister is required for recruitment. Accordingly, 18 letters had been forwarded to the Department of Management Services and other responsible institutions in this regard.

However, it was further revealed that the failure to obtain approval for filling the vacancies existing in other faculties due to retirements, resignations and deaths had become a matter of concern.

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the necessity of conducting a cadre review and inquiries were made from the Department of

Management Services regarding the current situation of filling the vacancies.

It was revealed to the Committee that the Department of Management Services has already granted approval for the recruitment of staff for two faculties of the Sabaragamuwa University and arrangements would be made to consider the remaining vacancies at a next Committee meeting.

The Committee pointed out the necessity of taking relevant action to activate this process. It was further revealed that the Department of Management Services had made a request to the committee chaired by the Prime Minister to pay special attention to filling the vacancies within the university system.

Recommendation

- i. Taking necessary steps to promptly recruit lecturers.

As per the recommendation to take necessary actions to fill the vacancies existing in the university, the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education submitted a report to the Committee on the actions that have been taken by the University Grants Commission regarding the employee cadre by the letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II, dated 02.09.2025. (Annexure-03)

02. The number of vacancies that remained when recruiting internal students for the first year of the university

The Committee observed that there is a trend of students who get registered for the first year of the university leaving the university before completing the degree programme, and there are occasions where students who are registered do not participate in the programme, the required number of students are not registered, as well as instances where students have been recruited in excess of the registered number.

The Committee pointed out that this matter was raised in relation to three issues concerning the 10 faculties of the university, and that there were occasions of students leaving the programme, such as 241 students in the years 2022/2023 and 362 students in the years 2020/2021. The Vice-Chancellor of the university explained the reasons that had led to this situation.

The Committee paid its attention to students leaving the university, and it was revealed to the Committee that this does not mean that the students have completely left the university.

The Committee was of the view that an assessment should be conducted regarding this matter, as it affects not only the Sabaragamuwa University but also the entire university system.

The Committee observed that necessary steps are being taken to reduce the time spent on the student selection and admission process, and it was emphasized that, in carrying out this process, the entire university system should be reviewed and the vacancies should be filled based on the z-score.

The Committee pointed out that the University Grants Commission should have an assessment mechanism to determine whether these vacancies are

being properly filled when recruiting students for academic programmes in universities, and that it would be appropriate to maintain a digital information system for that purpose.

It was revealed during the discussion that an online method is being followed for this purpose, that students are reluctant to pursue studies at universities located in rural areas, and that the number of students admitted to universities is determined according to national policy. It was further revealed that nearly 7,000 students do not register even in the first round, and that this issue is more prevalent in subjects related to science and agriculture.

The Committee instructed that necessary future actions be taken to recruit the maximum possible number of students for university education in the very first round of admissions.

Recommendations

- i. To take necessary steps to ensure that university placements vacated due to the withdrawal of registered students are reallocated to other eligible students, to the maximum extent possible.
- ii. To conduct an analysis covering all universities to ascertain whether students are being afforded university admission opportunities appropriately and to submit a report thereon to the Committee.

03. Progress in implementing the recommendations of the Committee on Public Enterprises meeting held on 08 May 2024.

3.1 Unbuilt administrative building - Recommendation No. 05

The Committee inquired into the recommendation given to the Auditor General at the meeting of the Committee on Public Enterprises held on 08 May 2024 to surcharge the sum of Rs.1,494,543/- which had been paid as an initial expenditure for an unbuilt administrative building.

The Acting Auditor General informed the Committee that the recommendation concerning the imposition of the surcharge had been directed to the Auditor General and disclosed that the information required to impose this surcharge had not yet been received.

The Committee inquired into the reasons for not providing the Auditor General with the information required in relation to the imposition of the surcharge. It was revealed to the Committee that the recommendation regarding the imposition of the surcharge had been directed to the Auditor General at the meeting of the Committee on Public Enterprises held on 08.05.2024 and that the Seneviratne Committee, an independent committee, had recommended that the said amount be written off.

The Vice Chancellor of the Sabaragamuwa University has been informed by the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education in this regard, by letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II and dated 10.07.2025, to take necessary steps to write off

the aforesaid expenditure from the books in accordance with the recommendations of the Seneviratne Committee, and to report the action taken to the Ministry, and a copy of the same has been forwarded to the Committee. (Annexure- 04)

Recommendation

- i. To take measures to prevent the recurrence of such uneconomical expenditure in the future.

3.2 University Playground and Sports Hall - Recommendation No. 06

The Committee discussed the issues observed in relation to the playground and Sports Hall, which had been constructed in 2014 at a cost of Rs.123,052,623/- These issues included water stagnation on the playground, the roughening of the surface as a result of the use of gravel mixed soil, and cracking of the side walls.

It was revealed to the Committee that the Director of Physical Education Department had informed the University by a letter that the playground was not in a condition suitable for use, and that had subsequently been affirmed by a decision of the Council.

The committee inquired whether this was a construction related issue or a maintenance issue, and was revealed that it had been in good condition at the time of the construction, but the maintenance was inadequate. The Committee was further informed that responsibility for the maintenance of the playground had not been properly assigned.

The Committee observed that the Chief Executive Officer is responsible for implementing the decisions taken by the Council of the University and noted that, if the playground constructed in 2012 remained unfit for use by 2025, it was indicative of a long standing issue. The Committee inquired about the responsibility of the Vice Chancellor of the University with regard to the maintenance of the said playground.

The Committee inquired as to who had issued the quality report in respect of the soil layer used for the playground, which had been formed using substandard soil and in which insects such as termite had been observed. The Committee also sought information regarding the officers who had supervised the work representing the University of Sabaragamuwa.

The Committee emphasized that accountability for the release of funds in full for an incomplete task rests with the officer who approved the release of such funds.

The Committee observed that the Vice Chancellor has confirmed that this work has been constructed in accordance with the standards and that the maintenance of the playground has been assigned to the Director of the Sports Division on 27.02.2025 and that prior to 27.02.2025, the maintenance of this playground had been assigned to the Cleaning Services Department of the University.

The Committee expressed its dissatisfaction regarding the failure to undertake proper maintenance of the playground, thereby resulting in the wastage of Rs. 123 million.

It was revealed to the Committee that the Works Engineer had been subjected to disciplinary action in respect of shortcomings relating to a function that had not been assigned to him. The Works Engineer then presented facts relating to the matter.

The Committee observed that the Vice Chancellor had failed to assign responsibility for the maintenance of the playground to a suitable officer and that the necessary measures had not been taken to retain a qualified Project Manager within the University.

The Committee noted that the construction related issue had been rectified to a certain extent; however, the maintenance related issue had persisted. The Committee further observed that the recommendation issued on 09 November 2023 had not been implemented and expressed its dissatisfaction with the appointment that had since been made.

Recommendation

- i. Implementing the recommendations made at the meeting of the Committee on Public Enterprises held on 08.05.2024 in their entirety.

3.3 Construction of a new library building at the University - Recommendation No. 07

The contract for the construction of the new library building was awarded to CML-MTD Construction Ltd. on 27 December 2017 at a contract value of

Rs.315,051,433/- inclusive of VAT. However, the project was subsequently discontinued prior to its completion.

The Committee observed that, despite the contractor having failed to fulfill the contractual obligations, an Advance Payment Bond valued at Rs.72,461,830/- (inclusive of VAT) had not been encashed, resulting in a financial loss of Rs.28,809,334/- The Committee further noted that an independent committee comprising officials of the Ministry had been appointed to investigate the matter and that the Committee had recommended to the Secretary to the Ministry that a comprehensive report prepared by the said committee be submitted to the Committee on or before 08 June 2024 and that the investigation report be referred to the Criminal Investigation Department.

The Committee observed that, although it had been reported to the audit that the investigation report had been submitted to the Secretary to the Ministry of Higher Education on 27 August 2024, no confirmation had been provided to the audit that the report had been submitted to the Committee. The Committee further noted that the investigation report had been referred to the Criminal Investigation Department on 19 March 2025 and that the Criminal Investigation Department had forwarded the report to the Colombo Fraud Investigation Bureau on 11 April 2025 for further investigation and the Secretary to the Ministry of Education had informed the audit on 07 May 2025.

The Committee inquired about the current status of the matter, noting that the Auditor General had issued a surcharge notice to the relevant parties on 02 April 2025 in respect of the financial loss concerned.

It was revealed to the Committee that the Seneviratne Committee had recommended the expeditious completion of the construction work and that approval of the Cabinet of Ministers had been obtained on 10.02.2025 for the immediate construction of the buildings concerned, and that this library was also included in the list of constructions.

It was further revealed that a new committee had been appointed to reassess the value and facilitate the implementation of the construction work. The Committee was also informed that, a committee comprising experts from the Department of Buildings, the Central Engineering Consultancy Bureau (CECB), the State Engineering Corporation, and the Department of Engineering Services of the Sabaragamuwa Provincial Council had initiated the preparation of bidding documents, with the approval of the Council of the University.

The Committee examined the reasons for the failure to enforce the performance bond in order to recover the losses incurred in relation to this construction project, and the following matters were observed.

1. The contractor had been informed in writing on 13.01.2020 to renew the bank guarantee.
2. The contractor had informed the bank on 22.01.2020 regarding the renewal of the bank guarantee.
3. Following the expiry of the contract period, the Cinnamon Gardens Branch of Seylan Bank had forwarded a letter to the University on 17.02. 2020.

The Committee observed that responsibilities in relation to the construction work had not been properly assigned to the Works Engineer and expressed its dissatisfaction with the failure to take the necessary action in respect of the underperformance of the first contractor, CML-MTD Construction Ltd.

The Committee was informed, by letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 20.08.2025 from the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, that, pursuant to the recommendation to conduct an independent investigation with transparency into the construction project, a four member committee chaired by the former Supreme Court Judge Mr. Vijith K. Malalgoda had been appointed to inquire into the matter. (Annexure 05)

3.4 Irregularities in the construction of a housing complex for the staff of the university - Recommendation No. 08

The Committee observed that, in the construction of a housing complex for the staff of the University, 370 doors that were required to be finished using Powder Coated Aluminium and Cladding had instead been constructed using plywood. Furthermore, although door closers had not been installed on 316 doors, the full amount approved as a lump sum payment per housing unit under the price proposal had been paid, resulting in a loss of Rs.13,936,750/. The Committee further noted that a sum of Rs.2,600,000/- had been paid on

the certification of the Works Engineer for work that had neither been carried out nor claimed by the contractor.

Accordingly, the Secretary to the Ministry and the Vice Chancellor of the University were recommended to take all necessary measures to prevent the recurrence of such situations and to fill the vacancies in the posts of Bursar and Engineer. The Auditor General was further recommended to impose surcharges on the officers responsible and to take the necessary action in that regard.

The Committee noted that the Auditor General had issued two surcharge notices. A surcharge notice was issued on 25 March 2025 in relation to a payment of Rs.2,600,000/- made for 03 items of work that had not been executed or claimed by the contractor, and another surcharge notice was issued on 02 April 2025 in respect of a loss of Rs.9,996,272/- resulting from the use of plywood doors and the non-installation of door closers.

The Committee drew attention to the factors that had resulted in a payment of Rs.2,600,000/- being made for three items of work that had neither been carried out nor claimed by the contractor.

The Committee concluded that the manner in which financial powers had been delegated within the University was flawed, resulting in the wastage and misuse of funds, and that the process had not been subject to adequate supervision. The Committee further expressed its dissatisfaction over the failure of the Vice Chancellor, in his capacity as the Chief Executive Officer of the University, to discharge his responsibilities in this regard.

The Committee was informed, by letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 20.08.2025 from the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, that, pursuant to the recommendation to conduct an independent investigation into the matter with transparency, a four-member committee chaired by the former Supreme Court Judge Mr. Vijith K. Malalgoda had been appointed to carry out the investigation. (Annexure 05)

3.5 Purchase of library books for the Faculty of Technology in the year 2021- Recommendation No. 09

The Committee observed that, out of the library books purchased for the Faculty of Technology under the Science and Technology Human Resource Development (STHRD) Project in 2021, 114 units belonging to 33 book types, valued at Rs.7,596,400/-, were observed as used books. In addition, 179 units belonging to 69 book types, valued at Rs.6,922,982/-, which were not related to the relevant syllabus, had also been purchased.

Furthermore, a financial loss of Rs.12,116,310/- had been incurred as a result of purchasing 227 units of 63 book types at prices exceeding the minimum market prices for new books and used books available in the international market. The Committee had therefore recommended to the Secretary to the Ministry that an independent committee comprising Ministry officials be appointed to investigate the matter, that a comprehensive report be submitted to

the Committee on or before 23 May 2024, and that the investigation report be referred to the Criminal Investigation Department.

The Committee had recommended that the Dean of the Faculty of Technology of the University to submit documentary evidence, on 09 May 2024, confirming that the books had been purchased from a book supplier registered with the University.

The Secretary to the Ministry of Education informed the audit on 07 May 2025, that the investigation report of the Independent Committee had been forwarded to the Criminal Investigation Department on 19 March 2025.

The Committee inquired whether the report had identified the persons responsible for the matter.

The Committee observed that documentary evidence confirming that the books had been purchased from a book supplier registered with the University had been submitted to the Committee on 09 May 2024. The report of the independent committee appointed by the Secretary to the Ministry had recommended that the loss be recovered from the relevant book company and, in the event that the company did not agree to that recommendation, the amount should be recovered from the relevant officers. It was further recommended that the Vice Chancellor and the Council of the University to take legal action against the officers concerned. However, the Committee observed that action had not been taken in accordance with that recommendation.

The Committee was informed that, in accordance with the Seneviratne Committee Report, it had been recommended that the loss incurred in relation to this matter be recovered, in the first instance, from the supplier. It was further revealed that the Council of the University had appointed a committee to take legal action against the officers concerned, that the supplier had been notified in writing to settle the loss, and that the committee appointed to inspect the books had identified 35 used books and instructed the supplier to replace them.

It was further revealed to the Committee that the supplier has already replaced books valued at Rs.750,000/- and had informed that arrangements would be made to replace the remaining books in due course. It was also revealed that the officer who had accepted the stock of books was no longer serving at the University and that the supplier had furnished evidence that the said officer had been informed in writing that used books would be supplied.

The Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, by letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 20.08.2025, informed the Committee that a four member committee, chaired by the former Supreme Court Judge Mr. Vijith K. Malalgoda had been appointed to investigate the matter, in accordance with the recommendation that an independent investigation be conducted into the purchase of these books. (Annexure 05)

3.6 Purchase of Desktop Computers in 2016 - Recommendation No. 10

According to the report of the committee appointed to examine the non-compliance of 130 desktop computers with the prescribed specifications, purchased in 2016 at a cost of Rs.15,964,000/-, it had been recommended that the Secretary to the Ministry to take disciplinary action against the officers responsible for initiating disciplinary action against the officers who had acted irresponsibly throughout the procurement process, and report to the Committee in that regard.

The Committee was of the view that the acceptance of these desktop computers without properly verifying their compliance with the prescribed specifications was improper.

The Committee inquired into the reasons for the failure to take appropriate action against the persons responsible for the matter. It was revealed to the Committee that two committees had been appointed to examine the matter and that the findings of the two committees were contradictory.

The Committee emphasized that the Vice Chancellor had failed to discharge his responsibilities by not taking appropriate action against the officers responsible for the irregularities that had occurred in the procurement process.

The Committee inquired into the purchase of 40 desktop computers for the Faculty of Geometric at an approximate cost of Rs.840,000/- per unit. The

Dean of the Faculty explained that the order had been placed during the economic crisis in 2022, when the value of the dollar had risen substantially.

The Committee noted that the computers ordered in 2022 had been received in 2024 and observed that the relevant performance bond had been extended on several occasions.

The Committee inquired into the reasons for repeatedly extending the contract, which had originally been due to expire after a period of six months. The Committee also inquired into the officers who had represented the Procurement Committee during that period.

Although the Bursar and the Vice Chancellor of the University were inquired in this regard, they were unable to provide a clear response. It was revealed that the Dean of the Faculty of Technology had represented the Technical Evaluation Committee.

The Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, by letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 20.08.2025, informed the Committee that, in accordance with the recommendation to appoint an independent committee, without the involvement of the Vice Chancellor, to conduct an investigation into the irregularities that had occurred within the entire University, a four member committee chaired by the former Supreme Court Judge Vijith K. Malalgoda had been appointed to investigate the matter. (Annexure 05)

**3.7 Unauthorized excavation of soil from the university premises -
Recommendation No. 18**

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the approval granted by the Council of the University for a contractor to excavate 500 cubes of soil free of charge in 2022, following a personal request made by a member of the Imbulpe Pradeshiya Sabha.

The Registrar stated that no permission had been granted to any person for the removal of soil and that the soil had been excavated without the knowledge of the University. He further stated that 500 cubes of soil had not been excavated, and that as the land was under the ownership of the Divisional Secretariat, the University had no authority to grant permission for any activity to be carried out on a State owned land. He further stated that the land had been earmarked for the construction of a public road, while the Faculty of Agriculture had also been established on the same land.

It was revealed to the Committee that, based on the information provided by the Registrar, he had informed the Divisional Secretary in writing that he had not granted permission, either verbally or in writing, for this activity. It was further revealed that the Divisional Secretary had carried out a valuation with the assistance of the Mines Bureau and the Department of Valuation, and had informed the Registrar in writing that a sum of Rs.203,437.75/- had been charged as the value of the soil and as the royalty. The Registrar had informed the Secretary to the Committee, the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, the Auditor General and the Vice Chancellor of the matter in writing, by registered post on 03.12. 2024.

It was further revealed to the Committee that, although the Council of the University had granted approval for this activity, the Registrar had not informed the Pradeshiya Sabha thereof in writing in his capacity as Secretary to the Council of the University. It was also revealed that, according to the calculations of the Divisional Secretary, only 95 cubes of soil had been excavated.

The Committee pointed out that the Registrar is attempting to mislead the Committee and that it was improper for the Council of the University to grant permission to the relevant member of the Imbulpe Pradeshiya Sabha to excavate soil from land which was not owned by him.

The Committee emphasized that, according to a letter dated 2022.10.20, forwarded by the Chief Security Officer to the Vice Chancellor through the Deputy Registrar (General Administration) and the Registrar, approximately 180 cubes of soil had been excavated from the University premises. The letter further stated that, the Road Development Authority had used machinery during daytime hours to excavate approximately 45 cubes of soil and remove it in lorries bearing LK 9077 and LO 7055 on 19.10.2022

Referring to the minutes of the meeting of the Council dated 26.09.2022, the Committee emphasized that approval had been granted by the Council of the University for the excavation of soil and sternly cautioned against attempting to mislead the Committee.

It was revealed to the Committee that the Vice Chancellor had directed the Registrar to lodge a complaint with the Samanalawewa Police Station regarding

the excavation of soil, and that the Registrar had lodged such a complaint with the said Police Station on 09.09.2024.

The Committee inquired whether the University had obtained an assessment of the loss incurred as a result of the excavation of soil. It was revealed that, following the lodging of the complaint with the Police, the Divisional Secretary of Imbulpe had taken steps to recover the assessed value.

04 Other matters

4.1 Death of a Second year university student based on a ragging incident

The Committee emphasized that the death of Charith Dilshan, a Second year student of the Faculty of Technology, is considered as a damage to the reputation of the University, as well as a damage to the reputation of the University Grants Commission and the Ministry of Education.

The Committee, having considered the manner in which the New Year festival that led to the death of the student had been organized, inquired whether the Vice Chancellor had investigated the number of students participating in the event and their accommodation facilities.

It was revealed to the Committee that the Main Students' Union of the University had sought the approval of the Vice Chancellor to hold the New Year festival within the University premises by letter dated 23.04.2025, with the recommendation of the Senior Student Counsellor. It was further revealed that the Vice Chancellor had granted approval for the event and had directed the Senior

Student Counsellor to monitor its conduct. It was also revealed that, at that time, the second year students of the Faculty of Technology were engaged in online learning, and that their physical lectures were scheduled to commence on 02.05.2025.

It was revealed during this investigation that the students of the 2021-2022 intake of the Faculty of Technology who were residing in the university hostels had been instructed to vacate the hostels by the Senior Registrar of the Student Welfare Division on 13.12.2024. It was further revealed that no one had informed the Vice Chancellor regarding the ragging incident, and that the matter was only discussed at the meeting of the Council of the University held on 30.04.2025, following this incident.

The committee inquired about the responsibility of the Disciplinary Officer in this regard.

It was revealed that it is the responsibility of the Disciplinary Officer to anticipate incidents such as misconduct, disciplinary infractions, and ragging involving both new and senior students, and to take steps to protect students from such occurrences. It was further revealed that the Disciplinary Officer does not have decision making authority in respect of such incidents, and that his role is limited to informing the administration of the University. It was also revealed that no authority had informed the Disciplinary Officer that such New Year festival has been organized.

It was also revealed that the Senior Student Counsellor had not informed the Disciplinary Officer and that permission for this New Year festival had been

obtained 4 days in advance, although permission should be obtained 14 days in advance when obtaining permission for a festival or any other event.

The Committee also observed that the Disciplinary Officer had informed the administration of the University, by letter dated 04.11.2024, regarding the possible untoward incidents that could occur within the University and the measures that could be taken to prevent such occurrences.

The Committee expressed its dissatisfaction over the failure to inform the Disciplinary Officer regarding the approval granted for the conduct of the New Year festival and emphasized that the administration of the University had not discharged its responsibility to prevent ragging.

The Committee highlighted the necessity of taking necessary steps to prevent ragging in the university.

A member of the Council of the University informed the committee that, he observed that that the administration had not created an environment in which the students could pursue their education in a satisfactory manner.

It was revealed that the Secretary to the Ministry had instructed the Vice Chancellor to conduct an internal inquiry into the matter and that two members had been appointed to represent the University Grants Commission in the investigation.

The Committee was of the view that it would be appropriate for the investigation to be conducted by an independent committee without the involvement of the Vice Chancellor of the University.

In accordance with the recommendation that the minutes of the Governing Council meeting held on 30.04.2025 be submitted to the Committee, the said minutes have been forwarded to the Committee.

The Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, by letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 20.08.2025, informed the Committee that, pursuant to the recommendation to conduct an independent investigation into the death of the student, a four member committee chaired by the former Supreme Court Judge Vijith K. Malalgoda had been appointed to investigate the matter. (Annexure- 05)

4.2 Providing a house owned by the Vice-Chancellor on a lease basis for a student hostel.

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the leasing of a house owned by the Vice Chancellor for use as accommodation for University students. The Committee inquired whether the house had been provided on a lease basis with a commercial motive.

The Vice Chancellor stated that the house had been provided in good faith for the purpose of facilitating accommodation for university students, and that he would reconsider whether to provide this house for accommodation of students, as the

action taken in good faith had been misinterpreted and resulted in allegations being made against him.

In accordance with the recommendation that an investigation be conducted by an independent committee without the involvement of the Vice Chancellor, it has been reported to the Committee by the Secretary to the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, by the letter No. HE/FIN/02/COPE-SUSL-Vol.II dated 20.08.2025, that a four member committee chaired by the former Supreme Court Judge Vijith K. Malalgoda has been appointed to conduct an investigation into this matter, as a specific investigation is required in this regard. (Annexure-05)

05. Observations

The recommendations made at the previous meeting of the Committee on Public Enterprises have not been properly implemented.

2. To carry out a fact-finding process into the matters on No. 05, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11 and under "other matters" No. 01 & 02 in the minute of the COPE raised by the COPE on SUSL through confident communication with concerned parties, following the rules of natural justice.
3. All the members are required to be unbiased and impartial in the performance of their duties.
4. It is the responsibility of the members of the Committee to maintain confidentiality and to withdraw from the active investigation of complaints where a conflict of interest exists.
5. The Chair of the Committee is responsible for initiating the investigation process and producing the final report with the recommendations of the Committee, to the Secretary, Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, within Sixty (60) days from the date of the letter of appointment.
6. At the discretion of the committee, required documents and necessary evidence can be requested to conduct a comprehensive investigation. Such a request will be facilitated and coordinated by the UGC/SUSL where necessary.

The Committee may meet as often as needed to investigate the complaints.

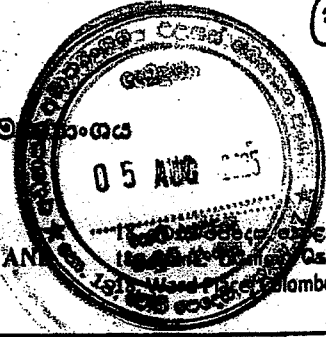

Terms of Reference (TOR)

Committee to conduct an independent investigation as per the directives given by the COPE on Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka (SUSL)

1. To consider the recommendations given by the COPE as per the attached minutes of the COPE meeting held on June 04th 2025.
2. To carry out a fact-finding process into the matters on No. 07, 08, 09, 10, 11 and under "other matters" No. 01 & 02 in the minute of the COPE raised by the COPE on SUSL through confident communication with concerned parties, following the rules of natural justice.
3. All the members are required to be unbiased and impartial in the performance of their duties.
4. It is the responsibility of the members of the Committee to maintain confidentiality and to withdraw from the active investigation of complaints where a conflict of interest exists.
5. The Chair of the Committee is responsible for initiating the investigation process and producing the final report with the recommendations of the Committee, to the Secretary, Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education, within Sixty (60) days from the date of the letter of appointment.
6. At the discretion of the committee, required documents and necessary evidence can be requested to conduct a comprehensive investigation. Such a request will be facilitated and coordinated by the UGC/SUSL where necessary.
7. The Committee may meet as often as needed to investigate the complaints.
8. After carrying out the investigation, depending on the evidence, the Committee may make suitable recommendations to the Secretary of the Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education through the Chairman/UGC.
