The Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40)

By virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 12 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40), I have issued an order to the effect that all members of the Armed Forces specified in the First Schedule are summoned for the maintenance of Public Order in the areas specified in Second Schedule thereof taking into consideration the need for the Public Order to be maintained.

Accordingly, I hereby inform the Parliament of the said Order in terms of Section 2(3) of the aforesaid Ordinance read with Section 21(2) thereof.

2. Announcements by the Speaker : The Speaker made the following announcements:—

I

“I wish to announce to Parliament that I have received the Determination of the Supreme Court in respect of the Private Member’s Bill titled ‘Human Rights Organization (Incorporation)’ which had been challenged in the Supreme Court in terms of Article 121(1) of the Constitution.

The Supreme Court has examined the Bill and determined that Clause 6 of the Bill is inconsistent with Article 76(1) of the Constitution and Clause 7 of the Bill is inconsistent with i 3, 4 and 12(1) of the Constitution.

The Supreme Court has, therefore, determined that in terms of Article 123(2) of the Constitution that the Bill is required to be passed by the special majority required under the provisions of paragraph (2) of Article 84 and approved by the People at a Referendum by virtue of the provisions of Article 83 of the Constitution.

I order that the Determination of the Supreme Court be printed in the Official Report of today’s Proceedings.”

II

“I wish to inform that I have under the provisions of Article 79 of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, endorsed the certificate on the Bill entitled ‘Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID - 19) (Temporary Provisions)’ on the 23rd of August 2021.”

“I wish to inform that the Hon. Madhura Withanage, Member of Parliament, has been nominated to serve in the Committee on Public Enterprises by the Committee of Selection on 02nd September 2021, in terms of provisions of the Standing Order 127(3) of the Parliament to fill the vacancy occurred due to the resignation of the Hon.
