PROCLAMATION BY THE HON. PRESIDENT



RANIL WICKREMESINGHE

KNOW YE that by virtue of the powers vested in me by Article 70 of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, I, Ranil Wickremesinghe, President of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, do by this Proclamation, prorogue Parliament with effect from midnight of the Twenty Eighth day of July, Two Thousand and Twenty Two and hereby fix the Third day of August, Two Thousand and Twenty Two, at 10.30 a.m. for the commencement of the next session and summon Parliament to meet in the Chamber of Parliament, Sri Jayewardenapura.
