Resolution for the implementation of the Domestic Debt Optimization to restore sovereign debt sustainability: The Minister of Education on behalf of the Prime Minister and Minister of Public Administration, Home Affairs, Provincial Councils and Local Government moved subject to the amendments proposed by the Committee on Public Finance,— That this Parliament resolves that as per the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of 28th June 2023, that the domestic public debt of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka (Republic) be optimized to ensure public debt sustainability of the Republic, and thereby to secure a speedy transition to economic recovery followed by sustainable economic growth, to grant all requisite approvals to implement this arrangement of domestic public debt optimization to the Minister of Finance, Economic Stabilization and National Policies.
