- (iii) the number of Cinnamon Peelers and Cinnamon traders in Sri Lanka on the basis of each district?

(b) Will he submit to this House,—

- (i) the number of cinnamon exporters in Sri Lanka and the names of those persons or institutions; and
- (ii) the amount of cinnamon exported by those exporters during the last 5 years?

(c) If not, why?
