2. To promote training and research in Buddhist meditation among Bhikku students of the University.
3. To train Bhikku students for the propagation of Theravada Buddhism in Sri Lanka and abroad.
4. To encourage the study of, and research in Buddhism.
5. To promote Buddhist culture and values.
6. To do any other thing connected with or incidental to any the objects aforesaid.

Venerable Vice Chancellor's Review.



Bhikku education is the leading role of Buddhist education tradition in Sri Lanka. Origination of Buddasrawaka Dhammapeetaya is a commendable effort taken towards the continuation of Buddhist Education following Bhikku education system initiated at Mahamewnawa garden at Anuradhapura subsequent to the arrival of Mihindu Maha Rahath Thero in the distant past. This institute was established as Buddasrawaka Dhammapeetaya by the act No. 26 of 1996. Bhiksu University of Sri Lanka was established by the provisions granted by the act No. 15 of 2012 and this is the only University in South Asia dedicated only for Bhikku.

This University has been constructed from 2007 at a 30 acre picturesque landscape beyond Malwathuoya with all facilities with the intention of converting this to focal point of the Buddhist Education in Sri Lanka.

This University comprises of Two Faculties and Four Study Departments under each faculty. Degree programmes are conducted according to the teachings of Lord Buddha in order to fulfil local and foreign student's needs. It should be specially mentioned that degree courses have been designed to be able to follow by every graduate.

This university is newly constructed at picturesque landscape beyond Malwathuoya within the limits of Anuradhapura Sacred city in order to becoming a centre of Buddhist education in Sri Lanka. Total Capital approved by the government is Rs. 2200 million. Rs. 1600 million has been already spent and actions has been taken to acquire lands and necessary infrastructure facilities. The amount spent for this purpose is 161 million. Proposed two storied dining hall which accompanys 500 Bhikku students was completed in 2018.

Even though, at present the number of Bhiksu are decreasing in the country. 148 Students were recruited in 2018 and it's a 13% growth comparing to year 2017. Accordingly, nearly 500 Bhikku undergraduates are learning in the country.

This University tries to create a friendly cultural and ethical atmosphere for Buddhist Monks through providing necessary hostel facilities. Accordingly the hostel system of this University is being managed well to provide hostel facilities to the students in the year 2018.

Total number of Bhikku students registered in the Unit of Post Graduate, External degrees and extension courses implemented by this University in order to give opportunity to lay and Bhikku students are interested to get education not only in the Northern Central Province but also in other provinces in addition to Bhikku students selected for external courses in 616. It's a growth of 95% comparing to the previous year.

Internal Quality Assurance Unit of this University is being operated to strengthen and make efficient the Academic and Administration works of this University. This Unit is established under the provisions of University Grants commission Circular no. 04/2015 issued on 05.05.2015.

The Researches, Innovations and Publications done in the year 2018 is 143. Monthly research development workshops were conducted to uplift the quality of the researchers and researches.

In this context more attention was drawn in this year to enhance the facilities such as human resources, library facilities, computer laboratory facilities and welfare. In addition to this most of the student requirements were satisfied with the instructions of the Council of the University. No student protests were taken place during this period. Therefore students were able to concentrate on their studies.

Many activities included to action plan was able to achieve within the year 2018. I believe that the current rapid development in the university would lead to provide an exceptional service to the Buddhism in this country as well as overseas.

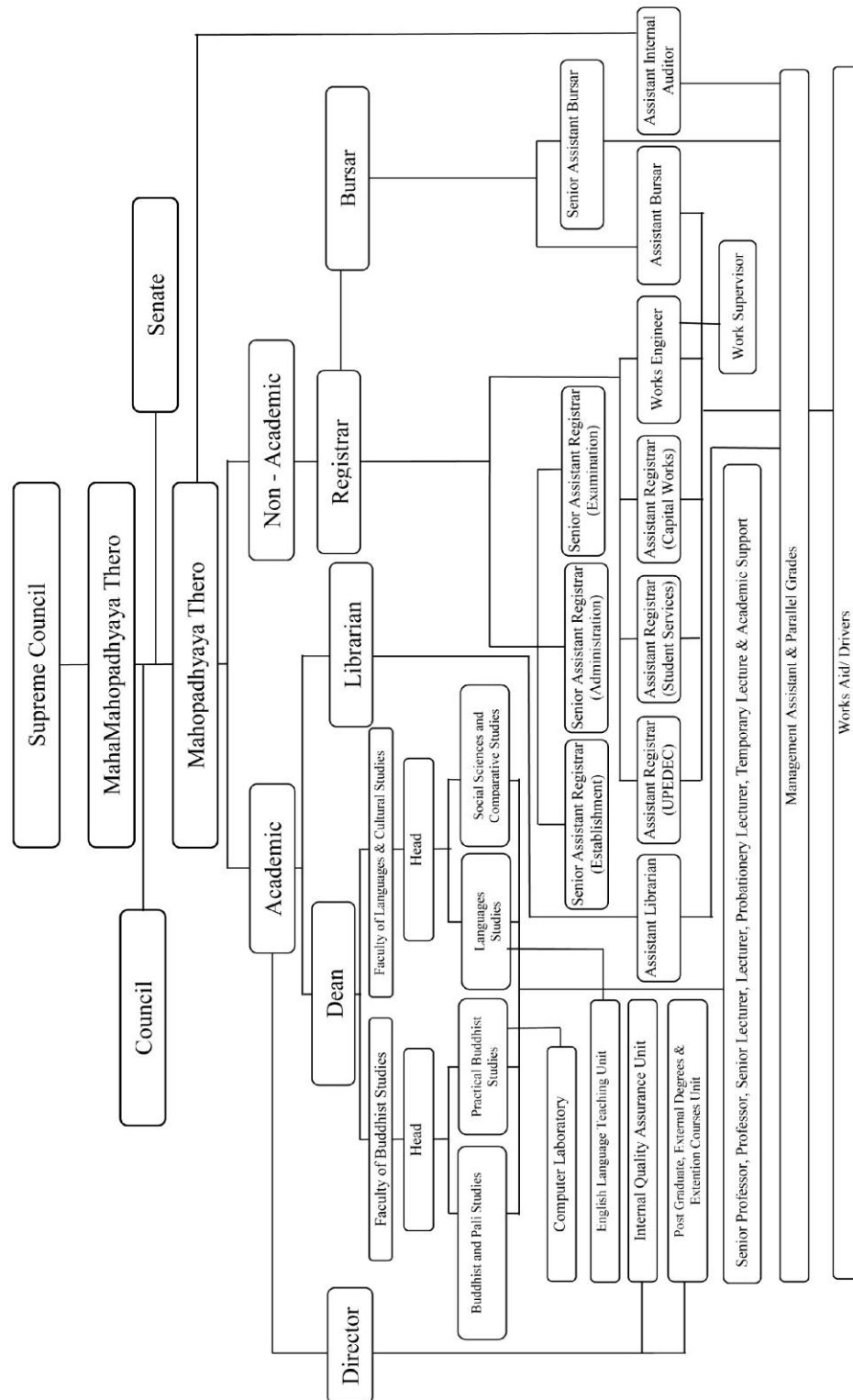

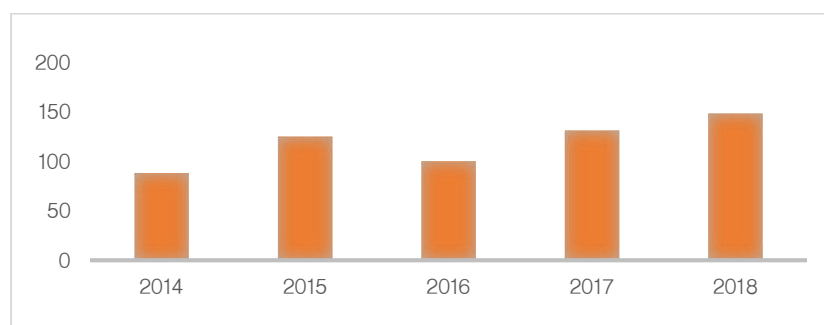


Chart - Student Enrolment within last five years

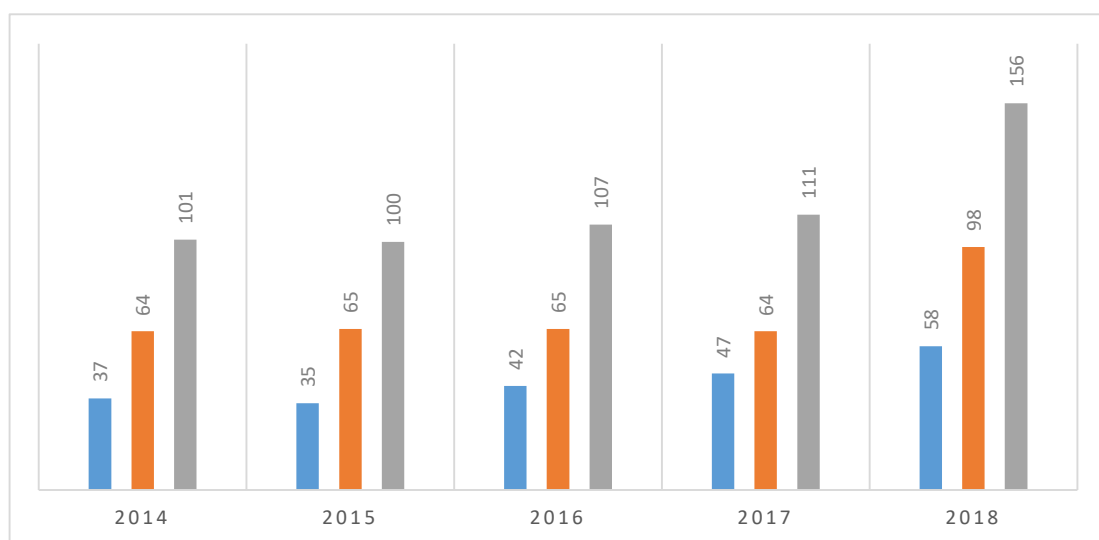


Chart - Existing Academic and Non Academic Staff 2014-2018

3. Following notes are shown in the account reports of the Bhiksu University of Sri Lanka in the year 2018. A sum of Rs. 455,325,000.00 has been received from the Government as recurrent and capital grants.

As per Lawyer's impression, liabilities over the same cannot be determined.
2. A case has been file in the labour tribunal against the dismissal of R. G. Chandrapala who served in the University. The judgment relating to the case has not been received.
3. A case has been file in the North Central Courts against the dismissal of assistant internal auditor who served in the University. The judgment relating to the case has not been received.

VIII. Accounting of Government Aids

Government Aid-Recurrent Aid have been stated as receipt revenue and expenditure report.

Rehabilitation and capital Aid have been identified as receipt and work in progress and capital assets represented by these.

In accounting the government Aid, the University has adhered the revenue access (according to accounting standard No.20)

7. 16 FUTURE EXPECTED REPORT BASED ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Preservation of environment and natural resources is a basic principal of Buddhist philosophy. Accordingly, as basic objectives of this University is amalgamated with Buddhist philosophy and incidental activities thereof, each activity implemented by the University has designed to enable the establishment of sustainable development through preserving the environment.

Activities implemented by the University based on Sustainable Development.

01. Ranges of plants sustainable for the environmental conditions of the area have been planted near buildings and open areas of the University and entered in with an agreement with an external garden maintaining firm to ensure the proper maintenance of such plants.
02. To reflect the identity of a Buddhist University, “Atawisi Bodhi Trees” has been planted and maintained within the University premises.
03. Implementation of planting herbal plants, fruit plants and other rare plants with the participation of University staff annually and initiatives have been taken to maintain such plants voluntarily by staff themselves.
04. In order to create a conducive environment for the daily rituals of Bhikku, a “Bodhi Prakara” (Wall around the Bo Tree) with ambulatory facilities being constructed on private donations and it has been proposed to plant a scion of “Jayasrimaha Bodhi” in future. Further necessary steps will be taken open a place for the Buddhist devotees of the area.
05. Action will be taken to hand over the garbage dumped by the University daily with relevant classification to urban council and in future composed project will be commenced in the University with usage of rotten garbage of the University and through the project it is expected to use carbonic manure for the flower plants and other crops of the University instead of Synthetic manure.
06. Newspapers, Magazines and Stationary disposed by the University will be sold annually to respective buyers and it prevent the environmental harm and provide an extra income for the University as well.
07. In 2018 solar electricity project was initiated to obtain electricity needed by the University and a contribution of 100KW being given to the main power source of the University and 70 street lamps also being mounted under the same. Over the project 30% of monthly power requirement of the University is fulfilled and it has been proposed to increase it up to 100% in future.
08. Special project has been implemented to reuse the waste water disposed by the University hostels daily and at present a water treatment plant has been implemented at Manamunawattha premises of the University. Purified output of the plant will be used for watering plants and grass lands. At present a water treatment plant is being constructed for Tissawewawatta hostel as well.
09. Majority of the year this University experience a dry climate and accordingly, it is planned to collect rain water during rainy seasons and use them to water plants and grass lands and water obtaining from National Water Supply & Drainage Board could be reduced and through the effort University contributes to protect the natural water resources.
10. Every actions have been to prevent any disruption whatsoever to the tributary of Malwathuoya run across the Manamunawattha premises of the University in construction of buildings for the University and measures have been taken to preserve

the said tributary of Malwathuoya and use water of the same for plants and grass lands of the University.

11. As this University is located near Malwathuoya which frequently inundated during rainy seasons buildings have been constructed on concrete pillars to enable the drain the flooded water and steps have been taken to construct a new canal at Tissawewawatta premises.
12. Initiatives have been taken to donate the annually disposed items of this University to other government institutes in accordance with the relevant circulars for reuse under resource management.
13. Proper methodology is being prepared to avoid the underutilization of resource owned by this University. At present networked printers are used by the office under the same.
14. Necessary steps are being taken by the University to communicate through internet most of the time to minimize usage of paper.
15. In order to enhance the welfare facilities, internet facilities, relief canteen facilities have already been supplied and buildings required for staff quarters (Male/Female) are being constructed at the moment.

Report of Auditor General on the Financial Statement of Bhikku University of Sri Lanka for the year ended 31 December 2018 in terms of Section 12 of National Audit Act No 19 of 2018.

1. Financial Statement.

1.1 Qualified Opinion.

The Audit of Financial Statements of the Bhiksu University of Sri Lanka for the year ended 31 December 2018 comprising the statement of financial position as at 31 December 2018, and the statement of financial performance, statement of changes in equity and cash flow statement for the year then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information was carried out under my direction in pursuance of provisions in article 154 (1) of the constitution of the democratic socialist republic of Sri Lanka read in connection with provisions of the finance act no 38 of 1971 and National Audit Act no 19 of 2018.

I am of opinion that the financial position as at 31st December 2018 of Bhiksu University of Sri Lanka and the statement of Financial Performance and cash flow statement for the year then ended and except for the effects from the information referred to in paragraph on the opinion revalued of my report have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles of Sri Lanka Government and give a true and fair view.

1.2 Basis for Qualified Opinion.

a. Omissions in accounting standards.

Even though, in terms of chapter 15 of Sri Lanka Public Sector Accounting Standards No 9. Measurements should be made to the lower value of stock cost and net realised value during the year under review unserviceable stock to the value of Rs. 22902 had accounted in the cost of current assets in the financial statement.

b. Accounting Deficiencies

- i. Although Rs. 5265585 has been accounted as capital fund degradation under other income for the year under review according to calculation it was observed a variation of Rs. 57873 and resulted of Rs. 52714458
- ii. The loss of Rs. 300723 generated by selling and disposing assets at the occasions within the year under review had not entered in to revenue statement had been adjusted to general reserve.

- iii. Amounting to Rs 44700 received by selling assets in the year under review had not been adjusted in the cash flow statement.
- iv. Even though the calculation of investment changes was Rs. 22660092 in calculating net cash flow of investment activities in the statement of cash flow. It depicted over statement of Rs. 50000 as net cash flow generated from investment activities by stating as Rs. 22610092 in the statement of cash flow.
- v. Even though it was stated the decrease of debtors under changes of working capital in the statement of cash flow was stated as Rs. 466352 the cash flow generated from operation activities had been overstated as Rs. 7046798.
- vi. Even though it was shown the difference of miscellaneous creditors as minor cash flow statement of Rs. 13909714 under working capital variation according to the calculation it was Rs. 9396202 and resulted the depicts of Rs. 4513512 in net cash flow generated from operation activities.
- vii. During the year under review total of capital expenditure amounting to Rs. 745391 has entered into accounts as recurrent expenditure and because of that value of the assets shown is a low value and value of deficiency has shown.

I conducted my audit in accordance with Sri Lanka Auditory Standards. My responsibility under these auditing standards has been further explained in the paragraph of Auditor General's responsibility regarding auditing of financial statements in this report. I believe that audit evidence i have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my audit opinion.

1.3 Managements Responsibility for the Financial Statements and partners of administrative.

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Sri Lanka public sector accounting standards and for sicj internal control as the management determines in necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material statements whether due to fraud or error.

The management is responsible to determine the possibility of maintaining the University continuously in preparation of financial statements. If the management is in the opinion the University should liquidate or not having any alternatives except taking action to hold the operation. It is the responsibility of the management to keep accounts on the basis of perusal succession and disclosure the information.

Responsibility regarding financial reporting process of University will be made by governing body.

Books, Ledgers and Reports should properly be maintained regarding its revenue, expenses assets and liabilities to abling the annual and timely financial publication of the University in terms on Sub section 16 i of National Audit Act No. 19 of 2018.

1.4 Auditor's Responsibility regarding auditing of Financial Statement.

As part of an audit in accordance with Sri Lanka Auditing Standards, I exercise professional judgment and Maintain professional scepticism throughout the audit. I also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Company's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of the management's use of the going concern basis of accounting and based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Company's ability to continue as a going concern. If I conclude that a material uncertainty exists, I am required to draw attention in my auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify my opinion. My conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of my auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Company to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

My objective is to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Sri Lanka Auditing Standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can Arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

2 Report on other legal and regulatory requirement.

Special Provisions are included regarding following requirements of National Audit Act No. 19 of 2018.

Except the effects from the matters described in the paragraph of basis of qualified opinion in my report according to the requirements contained under section 12 (a) of National Audit Act No. 19 of 2018. I have obtained sufficient information and

explanations for the purpose of my audit. I am of opinion that the University had maintained proper accounting records.

According to the requirement mentioned under section 6 I C III of National Audit Act No 19 of 2018 the financial statement submitted by the University is matched with previous years.

According to the requirement mentioned under section B 1 C of National Audit Act No 19 of 2018. The recommendations submitted by me in the previous year had been entered in to financial statement.

Over the actions taken and evidence collected and within the limitation on quantitative facts. Nothing disclosure by me to make statement.

2.1 In terms of the requirement mentioned under section 12 of National Audit Act no 19 of 2018 any member connected with the council of the University and having directly or in another way connecting to the general business through an agreement.

2.2 Acted contrary to the any relevant written law or other general or special provisions issued by the council of the University except following observations according to the requirement mentioned in the section 12 of national Audit Act No 19 of 2018

2.4 Except the observations following mentioned according to the requirement under section 12 (24) of National Audit Act No 19 of 2018 the University has not taken measures to use procurement resources efficiently and effectively within relevant period according to laws and rules

Even though the agreement was entered in to Rs. 213385000 in the year 2016 and a sum of Rs. 204330750 had been paid at the end of the year under review for planning and construction of alms giving hall and student centre, in terms of section 8 a of section 94 of 1978 as amended Urban Development Authority no 04 of 1982, relevant approval had not been granted for the purpose. Further action had not been taken in terms of paragraph 1.5.3 a and 1.5.6 relevant to contracts. (Employees Requirements)

3. Other Observations

- a. Action has not been taken to obtain prior approval for overseas travels and the expenses were incurred by the University as registration fee casual and subsistence allowance and due to cancellation of such overseas tour a loss of amounting to Rs. 138214 has been caused to the University fund.
- b. Even though 23 audit queries have been issued by internal audit unit of the University for the Year 2018 Answers were not received for 16 audit queries and as the said period was in a range between 07 months to 15 months. It was confirmed that the contribution of the internal audit unit for the productivity of University.
Further the audit queries issued by internal audit unit have not been submitted to audit.
- c. All government institutes should act in terms of the agenda 2030 of United Nations regarding sustainable development and the University had not been paid adequate attention regarding activities of subject scope of the University. Accordingly, it could not be identified that adequate provisions has provided in the annual budget that activities relevant to action plan had been into relevant to the year under review.
