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
Introduction

The Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka which had been established by the Parliamentary Act No.74 of 1981 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka was inaugurated at No.214, Bauddhaloka Mawatha, Colombo 07 on the 22nd April 1982. The major objectives in the establishment of this University are to publizise the Buddhist Doctrine, to promote the Buddhist and Pali Studies in Sri Lanka as well as in foreign countries and to facilitate researches in the respective fields.

The above Act has been amended by the Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka (Amendment) Act No. 37 of 1995. With the enforcement of the said Amendments, the local affiliated Institutions have been invalidated and the Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka had undergone the process of restructuring to comply with the structure found in the other National Universities of Sri Lanka and it has been established in Homagama in the Month of June while the Post Graduate and External Examination Unit of the University has been established at the premises located at Bauddhaloka Mawatha, Colombo 7. The Academic Premises with hostels has been established at Pitipana, Homagama and the Administration Centre (Head Office) has been established at No. 37, Moragahahena Road, Pitipana on 12.08.2010. The required initiatives have already been taken for transforming the Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka in to an internationally recognized University that is well equipped with the necessary resources. The University has obtained the membership of the Association of Commonwealth Universities and it is an Associated Member of the Committee of Vice Chancellors and Directors (C.V.C.D.) of the University System of the Country.

The Message of the Venerable Mahopadyaya Thero

The Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka, which is currently operated under the purview of the Ministry of Higher Education and Highways is a specific University functions by the Act No. 74 of 1981 and the Act (Amendment) No. 37 of 1995. Academic and Research activities in relation to the subject fields in relation to Buddhism and the promotion of fields of subjects related to the Buddhist Doctrine and thereby, to produce universal scholars equipped with knowledge, critical understanding and proper discipline in such fields of study and to make Buddhism a Universaly recognized Doctrine are the essence of the Objectives of the University. The Academic and Research activities of the Internal Students of the Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka which has been established fro the accomplishment of the aforementioned are performed in the premises located at Gurulugomi Mawatha, Pitipana, Homagama while Academic and Research activities of the External Examinations and Post Graduate Degrees are carried out at the Post Graduate and External Examination Unit situated in Baudhaloka Mawatha Colombo 07.



Curriculams of the University have been updated taking in to consideration the modern universal trends as well as the future universal requiremetns and novel curriculams have already been introduced. Academic as well as research activities of the Buddhist and Pali University are carried out by nine Departments of Study, which are under the purview of the two Faculties namely Buddhist Studies and Language Studies. The commitment of the Academic Staff and the enthusiasm of the Students of the University deserve high appreciation. It has been scheduled to establish a separate Faculty for carrying out the Post Graduate Degree Programmes extensively and systematically. Thereby, I hope that we will be able to bestow the Universe with a novel aggregate of knowledge through the researches, which is the foremost task of a University.

At the beginning, Academic and Research Activities of the Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka were conduted by using a limited human and physical resources. It is of my utmost pleasure to inform that the Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka is currently well equipped with human and physical resources due to the numerous contribution made by the Government and courageous commitment of the former Mahopaddyaya theros and the interest and active contribution of the Academic and Non academic Staffs and the great effort exerted by the Students for the Academic activities of the University.

1) Specific Accounting Policies

1.1 General Policies

1.1.1 Institutional Entity

The Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka has been established by the Act No.74 of 1981 and the Act has been amended by the Act (Amendment) No. 37 of 1995. The major premises of Studies of the University is situated in Pitipana North, Gurulugomi Mawatha, Homagama while its Administration building is located at No. 37 of Moragahahena Road, Pitipana, Homagama. Post Graduate and External Examination Unit of the University is situated at No.214 of Baudhaloka Mawatha, Colombo 07.

This University has been established under the Ministry of Higher Education and is mainly operated with the Provisions of the Government.

The University where local lay and clergy students as well as foreign clergy students are following Degree Courses is comprised of two Faculties, namely, Buddhist Studies Faculty and Language Studies faculty.

Students are consistently encouraged by the University to follow the Post Graduate Degrees and to conduct Researches.

1.1.2 Basis of Preparation

(a) Statement of Conformity

The Final Financial Statements have been prepared as per the Sri Lanka Public Service Accounting Standards (SLPSAS) and the Principles adopted in the previous years, the Financial Act No. 38 of 1971 and the Establishments Code have been made applicable wherever necessary.

In addition, the following Circulars which have been made applicable to the University by the Administration Council of the University from time to time have also been used for keeping Accounts.

- * Public Administration Circulars and Public Financial Regulations.
- * Circulars issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC).
- * Circulars on the Policies of Public Enterprises.

(b) Basis of Accounting

Financial Statements have been prepared using the Accrual Basis or Historic Cost Basis, excluding the occasions where the basis is specifically indicated.



(c) **The Currency used in the preparation of the Financial Statements**

Values have been estimated in Rupees and Cents used in Sri Lanka in the preparation of Final Accounts and action has been taken to round off the Financial Statements to the last Rupee.

(d) **Comparative Information**

Information related to the previous Accounting period has also been revealed along with the information of the Current year with the objective of providing a higher understanding in the utilization of Financial Statements and to improve the ability of making comparisons.

(e) **Materiality and Aggregation**

Every materially similar item class has been submitted as separate notes in the Financial Statements, unless the items are not material or in dissimilar nature.

1.1.3 Property, Plant and Equipment and Valuation of Them

1.1.3.1 Revaluation of Assets

- (a) Assets such as Property, Plant and Equipment are recorded at Value after Cost less Accumulated Depreciation.
- (b) These assets are stated including the cost purchased or the cost constructed and the basic expenses incurred for that purpose.
- (c) The cost of the Four storeyed Hostel with 100 rooms assigned by the Ministry of Higher Education and Highways is Rs.220,000,151.90 and this has been accounted at Building Cost under the Property, Plant and Equipment in the year 2016.

1.1.3.2 Depreciation of Assets

- (a) i. As per the Circular No. 649 of the University Grants Commission, Fixed Assets have been depreciated by adopting the straight line Method and the net value of the fixed assets has been indicated in the Statement of Financial Position. The useful lives of the assets depreciated and the depreciation ratio has been estimated as mentioned below.
