## **INTRODUCTION**

The National Centre for Advanced Studies in Humanities & Social Sciences (NCAS) was legally established under Section 24A of the Universities Act No.16 of 1978 by Ordinance No. 02 of 2005 and was promulgated in Gazette Extraordinary No. 1415/17 of 19<sup>th</sup> October 2005 amended by NCAS (Amendment) Ordinance No. 3 of 2008 published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 1567 of September 15, 2008.

The NCAS which was set up to address the needs and requirements of human resource development and advanced research studies has by the end of the year 2013 offered 354 financial grants through Government funding for academics to pursue their studies locally and overseas. By now the NCAS has gained the status of being the largest human resource development scheme in the university sector.

Dr. R M K Ratnayake the Incumbent Director was appointed as the Acting Director by the University Grants Commission on 01<sup>st</sup> November 2010. Many events on research and development in the areas of humanities, social sciences and related fields were organized by the NCAS.

The NCAS, during the year under review, carried out several academic activities in relation to the promotion and development of research and higher studies in not only humanities and social sciences but also in other related fields. Details of the events are enumerated separately.

The NCAS conducted a series of events including Training Programmes, Workshops on Research Proposal Development, International Financial Reporting Standards and other related subjects. More details are given in following pages.

## **Certificate course on social science research methodologies-2013**

National Centre for Advanced Studies organized a three month workshop “Certificate Course on Social Science Research Methodologies-2013” for postgraduate candidates in the faculties of arts, humanities, social sciences and allied fields to develop their research proposals based on scientific principles on 05<sup>th</sup> July 2013 to 11<sup>th</sup> October 2013 at NCAS auditorium. The main objective this course is to provide rigorous training in social science research for prospective postgraduate scholars to formulate their research proposals using advanced social science research methodologies. Accordingly 24 University Academic Staff, Policy Makers & Researchers participated for the above three month certificate course and found very successful.

## **Certificate course on research proposal development**

National Centre for Advanced Studies organized a workshop on Certificate Course on Research Proposal Development for PhD Studies for Prospective candidates on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2013 and 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2013 at NCAS. The objective of this workshop is to provide training for prospective postgraduate scholars to formulate their research proposals using advanced social science research methodologies. Accordingly 32 academic staff of university system participated for the above two day workshop and found very successful.

The National Centre for Advance Studies in Humanities & Social Sciences (NCAS) has started certificate course introduction to SPSS for statistical analysis at the NCAS computer lab, starting from 19<sup>th</sup> January 2013 on Saturdays. ## **Workshop on international Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS)**

National Centre for Advanced Studies (NCAS) conducted a workshop for the benefit of the senior accounting staff of the universities on Thursday, 15<sup>th</sup> February 2013 at Institute of chartered accountants of Sri Lanka .

The purpose of this workshop was to provide an opportunity to engage in a detailed discussion on selected IFRS applicable to the university system and to improve the quality reliability, comparability of the financial statements and update the knowledge on new standards. Fifty five senior officers of the Finance divisions (Bursars, Deputy Bursars, Senior Assistant Bursars, Assistant Bursars and Internal Auditors) participated for the workshop. This programme was conducted by Public finance experts and the selected faculty members of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka.

## **Workshop on Public Procurements**

NCAS conducted a workshop on public procurement on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2013 at post graduate Institute of Management PIM. Senior accounting, administrative and internal auditing staff of the universities were benefited from this workshop.

The purpose of this workshop was to enhance efficiency and effectiveness of procurement process, through improving the competency of relevant officials. Seventy two staff members of the Finance and Administration divisions such as Bursars, Deputy Bursars, Senior Assistant Bursars, Assistant Bursars and Registrars, Deputy Registrars, Senior Assistant Registrars Assistant Registrars and Internal Auditing staff attended for the work shop. Technical sessions were conducted by the senior officials of the treasury.

## **IELTS International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Preparatory Course**

National Centre for Advanced Studies in Humanities and Social Sciences (NCAS) has commenced IELTS preparatory course for university academics with the intention of assisting to achieve their IELTS band score requirement of 6.5/7 for their higher studies in foreign universities. Eleven students were enrolled for 1<sup>st</sup> intake and completed their studies to accomplish their IELTS band score targets.

## **INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT**

### **IT Environment of NCAS**

Overall responsibility for the IT environment includes the management of ongoing projects, resources, software and hardware vendors etc. New Computer Lab equipped with 15 Computers with Multimedia facility has been completed December 2012. This lab has been used to train University Academics, Executives and Nonacademic staff on several computer applications, Data analysis using SPSS, information security etc. Grants Management Database Software was maintained in 2013. This software will be used for calling application for next year and obtaining reports regarding existing grants accurately.

The activities undertaken by the IT Division during 2013 are as follows:


- Preparation of technical specifications, project proposals and technical reports for IT development for the Institute.
- Preparation technical evaluation reports and participates in technical evaluation committee (TEC) meeting.
- Installation, operation, configuring, management and maintaining Windows 2003/2008 Server and LINUX servers and related equipment such as Routers.
- Install and integrate software on Servers and Workstations. Install, configure, troubleshoot, and monitor core services such as Active Directory, DNS, DHCP, Group Policy, firewall, SQL Server, IIS, ISA Server, Mysql, Sendmail email server, Open web mail, Squid, RIAD server and workstation Environments.
- Server Management - The design and implementation of server related functions such as file and print servers, server virtualization, core operations system standards, operating system upgrades and maintenance, backup/restore, and server hardware configurations.
- Monitoring - Prepares recommendations on monitoring and analysis tools. Designs and implements monitoring tools. Performs Back-Up's & network troubleshooting
- Implement, support and maintain information security requirements; perform system maintenance including security patches, operating system upgrades and hardware upgrades
- Maintains Central Anti-virus Management Applications. Kaspersky Antivirus Software.
- Recommend upgrades, patches, and new applications and equipment
- Analyze business requirements to design and implement an infrastructure solution based on a Windows and Linux platform. Evaluate potential system enhancements.
- Regular Developing Web Site ([www.ncas.lk](http://www.ncas.lk)), and Intranet and Library Database for the Institution.
- [www.ncas.ac.lk](http://www.ncas.ac.lk) domain name was introduced in 2013 and set up new web based system with google cloud services.

## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

### Profile of Scholars

The Treasury allocated a total grant of Rs. 62 million for new grants and servicing of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years' studies of NCAS Grantees who had been awarded funding in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013. During the year under review, the NCAS awarded financial grants for the eighth time since its establishment in 2005.

By the end of 2013, about 354 academics selected from the different Universities/Institutions were awarded grants as supplementary funding by the NCAS for pursuing M Phil/PhD degrees. The grantees who commenced their studies in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 are in their 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years at present. The grants awarded to 28 grantees have been withdrawn as they failed to show any tangible proof of commencing their studies. Almost all grantees are in possession of a Master's degree which in fact is mandatory for applying. Grants were given in the fields of management, language studies, sociology, economics, mass media, fine arts and so on. Majority of the grantees are from the field of management.

## 1. CORPORATE INFORMATION

The National Centre for Advanced Studies in Humanities & Social Sciences Is a Centre established under Universities Act No.16 of 1978, and Domiciled in Sri Lanka. The Centre is located at No. 6A, Sukhasthan Garden, Ward Place, Colombo 07.

### 1.2 Principal Activities and Nature of Operations

Promoting Higher Studies and Research in the Fields of Humanities & Social Sciences.

This Centre Operate on Government Funds for its existence. Further, the Grants provide funds for granting of M Phil/PhD scholarships to University Teachers.

### 1.3 The Number of Employees

The Number of employees at the end of the year was 14.

## 2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### 2.1 Statement of Compliance.

The Financial statements of the NCAS have been prepared in conformity With the generally acceptable principles and the public sector accounting Standards introduced by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka (CA). When there is no public sector accounting standards Introduced dealing with the transaction and the account balances of the Organization, the relevant provisions of the Sri Lanka Financial Reporting Standards (SLFRS) and Lanka Accounting Standards (LKAS) have been used In respect of those balances in preparing and presenting of these financial Statements. Accounting policies used have been consistent with those Used in previous financial years.

### 2.2 Responsibility for Financial Statements.

The Management of NCAS is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements.

### **2.3 Going Concern**

When preparing the financial statements the Management has assessed the ability of the Institute to continue as a going concern. The Management has a reasonable expectation that the NCAS has adequate Resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. NCAS does not foresee a need for liquidation or cessation of operations, taking into account all available information about future. Accordingly, the NCAS continues to adopt the going concern basis in preparing the financial statements.

### **2.4 Post Balance Sheet Event**

There were no material post balance sheet events which require Adjustment or Disclosure in the financial statements.

### **2.5 Assets and Bases of their Valuation**

Properties, Plant & Equipment are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation. The cost of Property, Plant & Equipment is the cost of purchase or construction together with any incidental expenses thereon.

Full year's depreciation is provided in the year of purchase and no depreciation is provided in the year of disposal. Depreciation on Property, Plant and Equipment were provided for at the following rates on their cost.

### **2.7 Inventories**

Inventories are valued at cost based on FIFO basis.

### **2.8 Receivables**

Receivables are stated at the amounts they are estimated to realize.

## 2.9 Staff Loan

- a) Staff Loans are measured at amortized Cost Method in accordance with LKAS 39 Financial Instruments-recognition and measurement Using effective Interest rate equal to the average Commercial Bank lending rates as follows.

- d) **Prepaid Staff Cost**

This represents the balance arising from the staff loans given at concessionary rates to the employees of the authority.

## 2.10 Liabilities and Provisions

All known liabilities as at the balance sheet date are included in the Financial Statements and adequate provision is made for liabilities which are known to exist but the amount of which cannot be determined accurately.

## 2.11 Accounting for Grants

Government grants have been accounted in accordance with the LKAS 20 and Accordingly Capital Grants received from the government are treated as deferred income and relevant Property, Plant & Equipment are capitalized at cost and the grant is recognized as income on a systematic basis over the useful life of the assets and Recurrent Grant and the PhD MPhil grants are accounted as periodical income.

## 2.12 Capital Commitments and Contingent Liabilities

All material commitments and contingent liabilities are considered and where necessary adjustments or disclosures are made in these Financial Statements.

## 2.13 Employee Benefits

### **Defined Contribution Plans**

Employees are eligible for University Provident Fund (UPF) Contributions, Employees' Trust Fund (ETF), University pension fund, Contributions in line with the respective statutes and regulations. The NCAS pays fixed contributions of Basic emoluments Plus Cost of Living allowances of employees to University Provident Fund and Employees' Trust Fund, University pension fund and will have no legal or constructive obligation to pay further amounts.

## **Defined benefit plans**

Defined benefit plans are post-employment plans other than defined contribution plans. Authority NCAS is liable to pay gratuity in terms of the Payment of Gratuity Act No. 12 of 1983. The provision for the obligations under the Act is determined based on the present value method in accordance with LKAS 19 using the discount rate equal to the government bond rate, and average salary increment rate as follows.

### **2.14 Staff and Institutional Development Fund**

Staff and Institutional Development Fund represent the amount transferred from the internal generated funds earned through workshops & Academic Courses. The amount is decided by the management Judgment.

### **2.15 Contingent Assets**

As per the agreement reached between beneficiary and Universities, Legal actions against the recoverable amount on Grant withdrawals have been taken by respective Universities through the Department of Attorney General. The amount receivable from the respective Grantees whose grants was withdrawn is accounted on cash basic.
