## **Exploration and Documentation Division**

### **Functions of the Division**

1. Conducting of special and urgent explorations.
2. Declaring of archaeological reserves.
3. Declaring of archaeological reserves and monuments as protected monuments.
4. Preventing of destruction of antiquities and implementing the provisions of the Antiquities Ordinance against the destruction of antiquities.
5. Conducting of Archaeological Impact Assessment surveys.
6. Providing of recommendations after making inspections in suggested lands for Mineral Projects.
7. Collecting of geographical information with regard to archaeological sites and monuments and preparing maps.
8. Conducting of marine explorations.
9. Exploring of the ancient irrigational heritage and preparing a task to ensure its protection.
10. Documentating of movable antiquities
11. Answering for the problems regarding the archaeological sites and monuments in the Districts and handling of administrative affairs.

### **The projects which were carried out in 2014**

- **Course of Advanced diving (Aids of the Sri Lanka Ports Authority)**
- **The Godavaya Shipwreck Excavation (Provisions of Texas and Sorbonne universities in America and France respectively) 2013-2014**

It has been identified that the shipwreck in the sea around Godavaya dates back to 2200 years. Short term studies and experiments have been made up to the year 2008 regarding the shipwreck identified in 2003. Preliminary investigations have been commenced in 2009 by the Marine Archaeological Exploration unit of the Department of Archaeology and the Nautical Archaeology Institution of the University of Texas in the U.S.A as a joint venture. The excavations and data analyzing have been commenced in 2013 and 2014 immediately after the first academic study made between 2010 and 2013 years.

### **Historical Background**

According to the archaeological factors revealed from the site, it can be determined as the ancient maritime archaeology site in the region of Asia Pacific. According to the dating test it is determined that the shipwreck dates back to 2200 years of history. The inscriptions in the Gotapabbatha temple in Godavaya are proven factors to confirm that there was a harbor in the related area. These inscriptions, Chronicles as well as this shipwreck can be considered as major archaeological factors to prove the stretch of the Silk Route within this area before thousands of years.

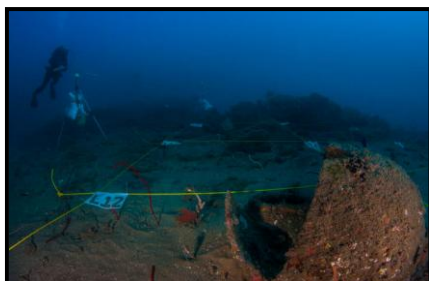
### **Archaeological researches which were carried out in 2013-2014**

Mapping of location of the wreck and collecting of data have been completed by this research. Marking of antiquities which were found by excavations on the map, handing over the resurfaced antiquities to the Architectural Conservation Division in the Department of Archaeology and carrying out post analysis have been completed in addition to the above.

### **Benefits of the projects**

- This shipwreck is the only ancient marine archaeological site which has been found in the region of Asia Pacific therefore promoting of researches related to local and foreign naval affairs in an ancient Sri Lanka are based on that valued fact.
- Confirming of the factors in historical sources connected with the naval history in ancient Sri Lanka by physical factors.
- Development of physical and human resources in the subject of Sri Lanka Marine Archaeology, local marine archaeologists can be obtained experience and technological knowledge of foreign marine archaeologists'.
- Obtaining a higher education on Marine Archaeology, development of museums, laboratory and tourism.

The project, which is the ancient marine archaeological site in Asia, was conducted under the financial and technical support of an oldest research institution of Marine Archaeology and well experienced marine archaeologists as well as the physical resource contributor was the Institute of Nautical Archaeology (INA). Advanced diving courses of Sri Lanka marine archaeologists and other special courses (Nitrox courses) were carried out in line with this project. Well qualified divers who have been discovered this site for the first time recruited to the field activities on an ad hoc basis. The project was unable to continue in 2015 due to technological, physical and theoretical factors. The excavations and researches are to be started again.



### **Project for recording of archaeological sites - Ampara District**

Identifying and recording of sites by Divisional Secretary's Division base in Ampara district have been carried out by the Department of Archaeology, Ministry of National Heritage and an Antiquities Protection Unit as a joint venture in 2013 and 2014. The number of 427 archaeological sites has been recorded by this project. Megalithic Burial which was identified from Uhana in Bandaraduwa is a very significant archaeological site. Many identified archaeological sites represent constructions of early Anuradhapura era and caves with Paintings dates back to Pre Historic era have been identified. The number of 327 archaeological reserves with ancient monuments, among identified sites have been declared in accordance with the Antiquities Ordinance. The actions have been taken to set up name boards and boundary posts for 91 archaeological sites under this project.

### **Project for documenting of movable antiquities**

A project for documenting of movable antiquities was commenced in April 2013 with the view to ensure safety and legal character while bequeathing them for future generation. Antiquities in the chemical laboratory of the head office were documented according to the instructions of the Director General of Archaeology as the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of this project. Around 850 antiquities like statues, coins and beads full of variety and belong to the various eras have been documented in 2014. This project is running in provincial basis and all information maintained as a database by the head office.



### **Special Unit for the Prevention of Destruction of Antiquities**

An exhibition stall was created to make aware the public about the importance of protecting of antiquities together with the Special Police unit for the Prevention of Destruction of Antiquities in Deyata Kirula exhibition in 2014.

Quantity of 60,000 hand bills has been printed in two categories with the quantity of 30,000 of each on the topics of “The importance of heritage” and “The protection of heritage”. (For free distribution in line with the Archaeology Week.)

## Geographical Information Preparing Unit

### An exploration to identify the archaeological sites within the Northern and Western provinces

#### Objectives -

- Documenting of antiquities to minimize the damage to them due to accelerated development in Northern Province after the 30 years of war.
- Preparing of expeditious suggestions to secure that archaeological sites and monuments as protected monuments or as prohibited lands to provide a legal protection.
- Taking prompt actions on a priority list to maintain that archaeological sites by carrying out excavations and conservations.
- Providing of all arrangements needs to protect them for future generation as well as an exhibit to the public.

#### Exploration in Vavuniya District

The 19 sites with an archaeological value have been identified within the Vavuniya District. The plans have been prepared to suggest as well as publish in gazette the 17 sites as archaeological reserves among them. Mapping of the explored archaeological sites within the area of geographical data has been completed and the explorations are in progress.

#### Exploration in Kalutara District

The 41 sites with an archaeological value have been identified within the Kalutara District. The plans have been prepared to suggest as well as publish in gazette the 15 sites as archaeological reserves among them. Mapping of the explored archaeological sites within the area on geographical data has been completed and the explorations are in progress.

#### The project to declare protected/ ancient monuments

The 246 sites in the Eastern Province have been published in the Government Gazette as ancient archaeological monuments in accordance with the 16<sup>th</sup> Section in the Antiquities Ordinance.

#### **01. Excavation at Hanguranketha city**

This excavation was carried out with the objectives of saving and conserving of the monument which was exposed to harm due to road development activities and bequeath it to the future generation. This excavation was carried out between September and October in 2014 although no any archaeological factors revealed.

#### **02. Impact Assessment Excavation of Moragahakanda Reservoir Development Project**

It was carried out with the objectives to study about ancient monuments which will be deserted or destroyed by the Moragahakanda Reservoir Development Project as well as to conserve them by excavations and conservations. The project was carried out between August and December in 2014.

#### **03 Excavation of ancient building in the vicinity of Aymara cave in Sithulpawwa**

The site was excavated with the objectives of unearthing and conserving of an ancient building in the vicinity of "Aymara" cave belongs to the Sithulpawwa Vihara complex situated in the Yala sanctuary in Southern Province dates back to the 1st century B.C. This ruined monument in the vicinity of "Aymara" cave in Sithulpawwa has an entrance consists of several rock pillars, plain guard stones and a moonstone. Studying of the belonging era of the building and collecting of historical information bound with the Sithulpawwa monastery were more objectives of this excavation. The excavations were commenced in July 2014. It directed to unearth the rest of the building.

#### **04. Excavation project of the mass grave in Thirukeswaram in Mannar**

The archaeological excavations were carried out to identify the layer deposit of the cemetery on the order of Magistrate Court to solve the problems aroused with the cemetery situated in the vicinity of Thirukeswaram Kovil in mammar in the Northern Province. Finding out about any artifacts belong to an ancient era were also among the objectives in addition to them.

The observations of the excavation project of Mathota harbor were carried out in this year and two Professors at the University of China participated in it.



#### **05. Excavation of the palace premises in Kurunegala**

The Department of Archaeology has not yet carried out a proper excavation in the area of No. 14 belongs to the Kurunegala Kingdom therefore this excavation was initiated with the objective to carry out a proper excavation in the area. The excavation was commenced in line with the Kurunegala city development project. It was carried out between on 11<sup>th</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> August in 2014.





## **06. Excavating of the new access way to the archaeological site in Mihinthale in Anuradhapura.**

The excavations were carried out with the objective to inspect about archaeological factors in the suggested area to construct the direct access way towards the main steps which leads to the Mihinthale premises from the round - about in the Anuradhapura Trincomalee road.

## **07. Excavation of the Sthupa of Thimbiriya Temple**

The project was commenced on 09<sup>th</sup> June 2014 and several objectives were bound to it as follows.

01. Removal of newly built octagonal brick wall around an ancient Sthupa.
02. Unearthing of an ancient Sthupa.
03. Identification of stone terrace
04. Identification of the parapet wall and its architectural features bound to it.
05. Identification of architecture of the ancient Sthupa as a support for conservations of other Sthupas.

Artifacts, like the remains of bricks, VOC coins, copper rings, beads, a clay tablet, a piece of quartz and edges of earthen wares have been found in this excavation. A hexagonal Chamber existed around an ancient Sthupa was revealed by the excavation. It is revealed that the Sthupa had faced with illegal human interference from the part of its Pesavalalu (Berms or Terraces) to Upper part of the Garbhaya (Chamber) in three occasions. Illegal excavations have been made horizontally from the Pesavalalla of Southern corner of Garbhaya. An illegal destruction has been made in the part of upper Garbhaya in two occasions. These places have been filled with soil and pieces of bricks. Pesavalalu (Berms or Terraces) were identified after unearthing by the excavation and the brick remains directed to assume there was a hatareskotuva (Square tee).

## **08. Excavation project of the Ampara urban park**

An Impact Assessment Project was carried out from 2014-04-07 to 2014-08-25 prior to the project of setting up of the Ampara urban park. The several test pits were excavated in the vicinity of main reservoir in Ampara but considerable artifacts were not found. Therefore the plan for setting up of an urban park was brought into action at the suggested place.



## 09. Excavation of Neelagiri Sthupa in Lahugala

Excavation of Neelagiri Sthupa in Lahugala was continuously carried out between the years of 2012 until 2014. The excavations were made under the provisions of People's Bank on the understanding about the importance of confirmation of the historical value of this Sthupa and the large amount of monuments scattered within the site and also in the external area. Construction of the Sthupa dates back to the 4<sup>th</sup> century B. C. It was confirmed that the renovations have been made between 2 - 3 B. C. The project was carried out from 2014-05-19 to 2014-12-31.



## 10. Excavation of the tunnel in Ananda Sastralaya, Kotte - Phases I and II

The project was carried out with the objectives to unearth the laterite made monument which is considered as an ancient tunnel belong to the Kotte era situated in the Ananda Sastralaya and exhibit it to the public. The allocation for the project is R.S. 269,045.00. as well as the excavations were carried out from 2014-01-21 to 2014-06-30. Evidences have not been reported to identify it as a tunnel, although a small Sthupa has been observed. It will be opened to the public after unearthing and making conservations.

### Maritime and Naval History museum in Trincomalee

The Maritime and Naval Museum at the ancient Dutch Naval Commissioner's Official residence in Trincomalee, which was renovated under the financial contribution of the Netherlands and the supervision of the Department of Archaeology has been opened on 2014.05. 09 under the patronage of the Hon. Speaker Chamal Rajapaksa.

The two story building of ancient Dutch Naval Commissioner's Official residence was in a dilapidated condition during the war season have been renovated and established a museum consists with Maritime and Naval history as well as open to the public.



### Yatala Museum



Yatala Vehera museum was established with the archaeological conservation activities made to Yatala Vehera Sthupa in line with the Katharagama Gam Udawa project which was carried out by the Government in 1987. This museum was continued as a regular exhibition and the Exhibition design was reorganized. Setting up of pedestals for museum exhibition, Preparing of almirah to store nonexhibited antiquities, displaying of photographs and 22 trilingual display boards have been completed under the reorganization. Renovating of electric lighting system of the exhibition and planning of exhibitions for outdoor antiquities as well as preparing of the security system of the museum building have been suggested for this public exhibition.

### Exhibition of antiquities and relics which were found from Neelagiriya

Exhibiting of relics and antiquities which were found from Neelagiriya in Ampara in addition to the ash remains of king Dutugemunu with many antiquities at several places in Sri Lanka throughout the year.

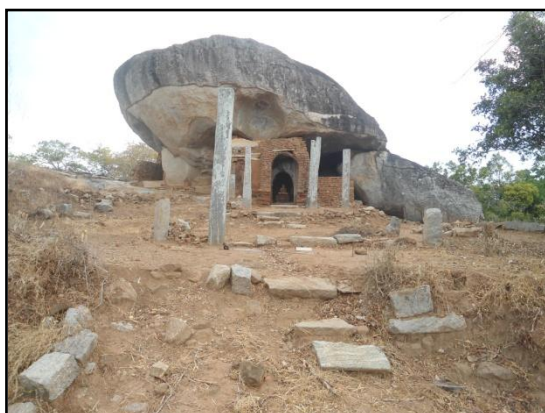

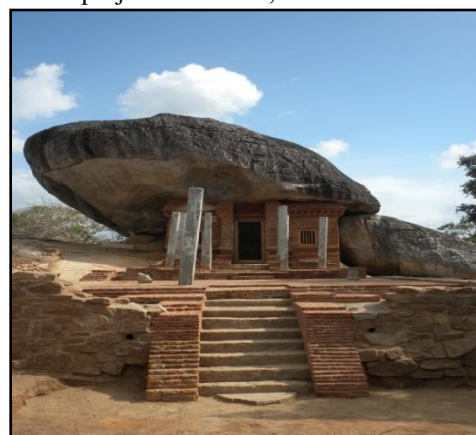

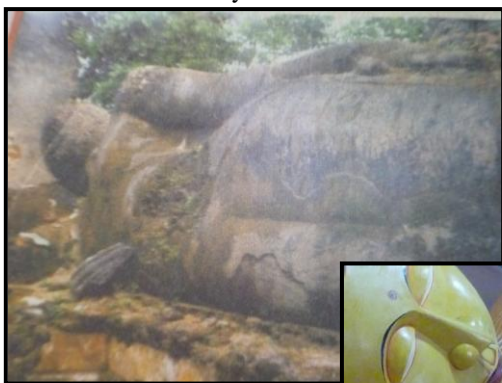

The Chemical Preservation Division has carried out 84 projects in 2013 to achieve the above mentioned objectives. It comprises with the paintings and sculptors conservation projects, antiquities conservation projects as well as projects to control weeds and micro tree species spread on monuments.

### **Mudalindaramaya in Koggala**

Sri Mudalindaramaya is situated in the Habaraduwa Divisional Secretariat Division in Galle District in the Southern Province. The Southern Architectural Conservation Division of the Department of Archaeology has renovated the image house consist with the images and paintings in an abandoned condition as well as Devalaya which were belonged to the Kandy era. The Southern Provincial Team of the Chemical Conservation Division carried out their conservations to control weeds, algae and fungi spreading on the sleeping posture statue and renovated the statue by removing old plaster and applying a new plaster. The statue is in its basic natural shape due to the strength of the base. The cement made statue has been renovated by using the remains of evidences without harming to the style and tradition of the statue and completed the conservation with 100% progress in 2014 with the facilities to worship. The Eye painting ceremony of the statue has been done at the auspicious time on 2015.05.08. All the statues in Devalaya are renovated in this year.

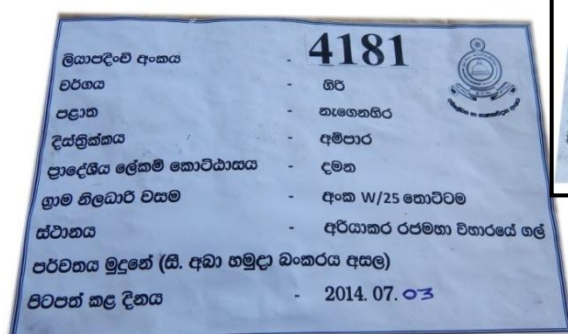

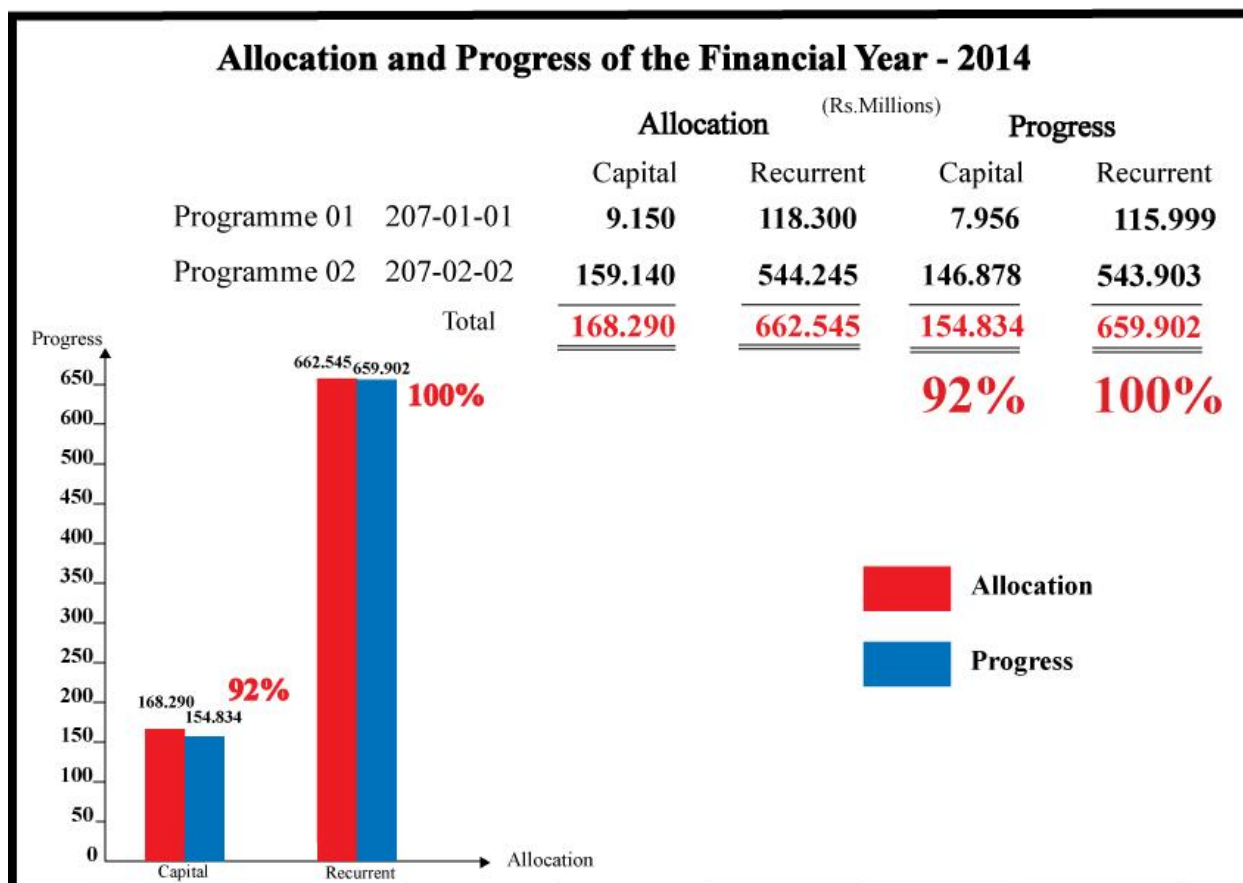

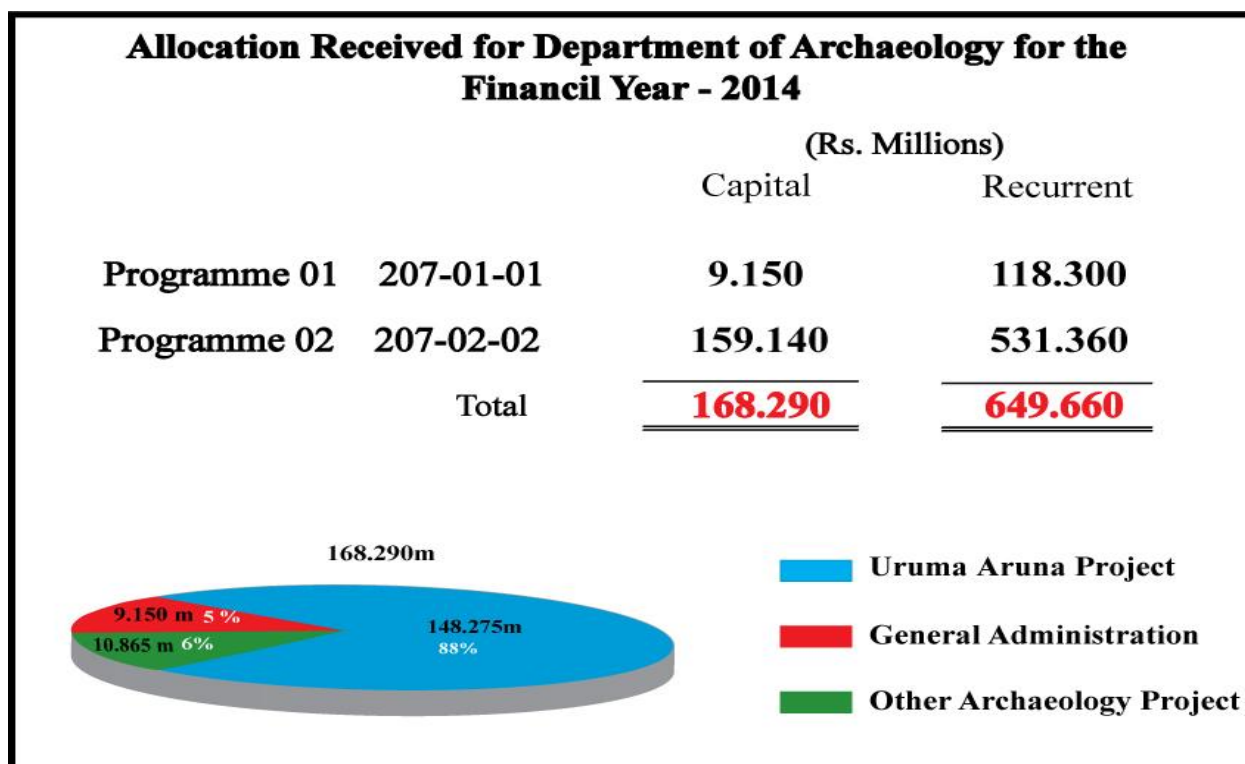

10. Identifying new projects and preparing project proposals to bring them into operation.

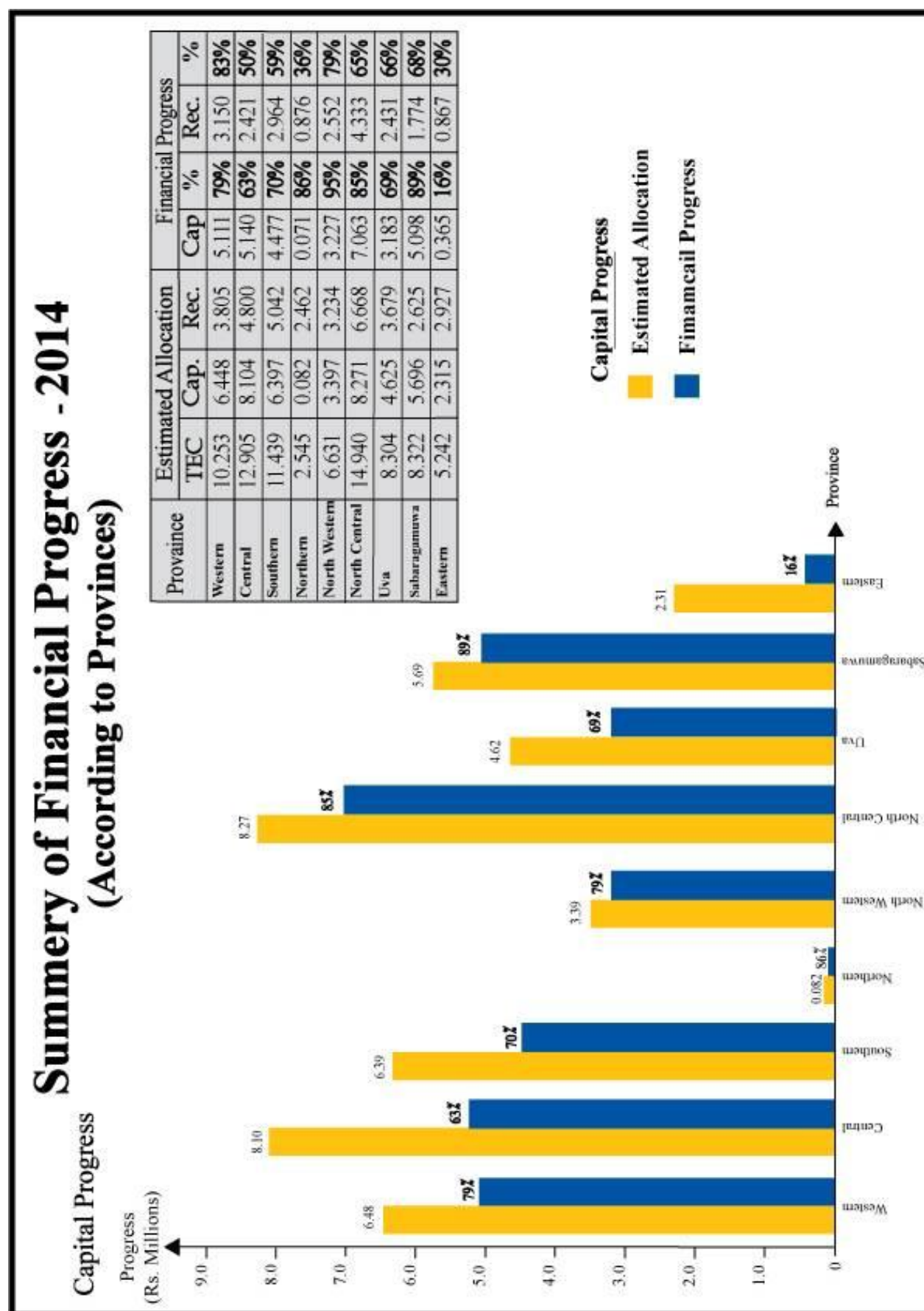

- Summary of financial progress (Order of Divisions and Provinces)

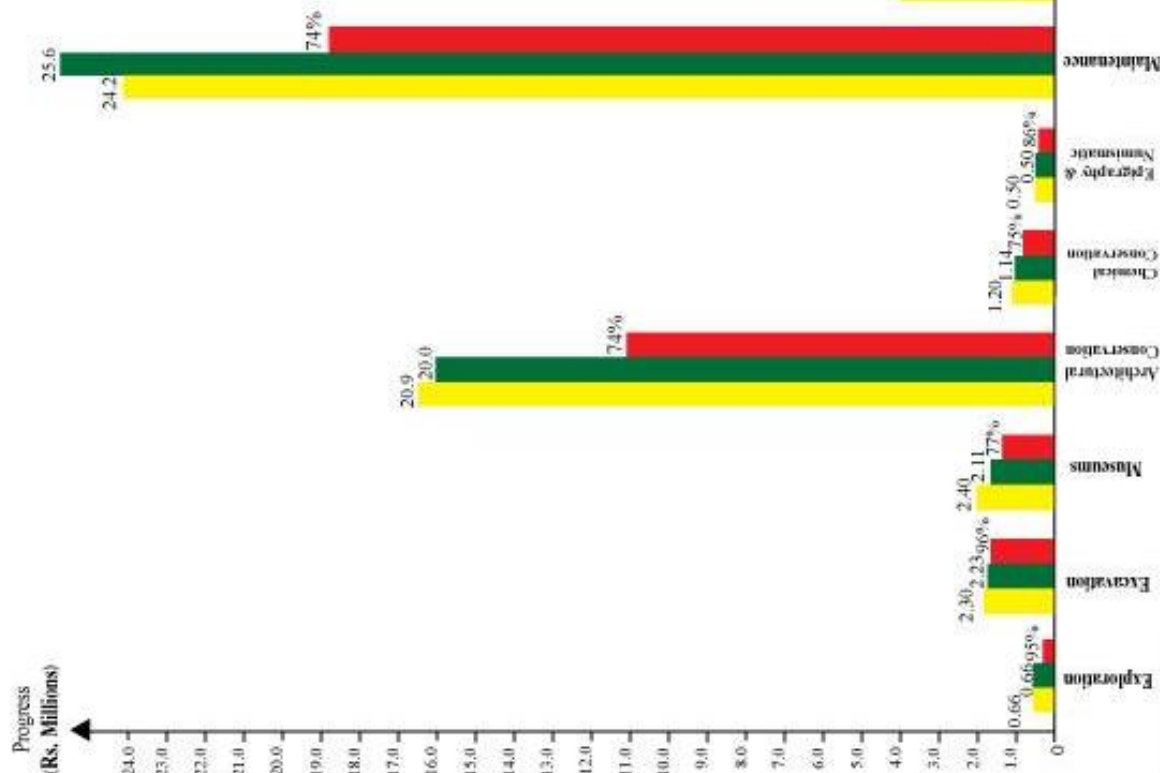

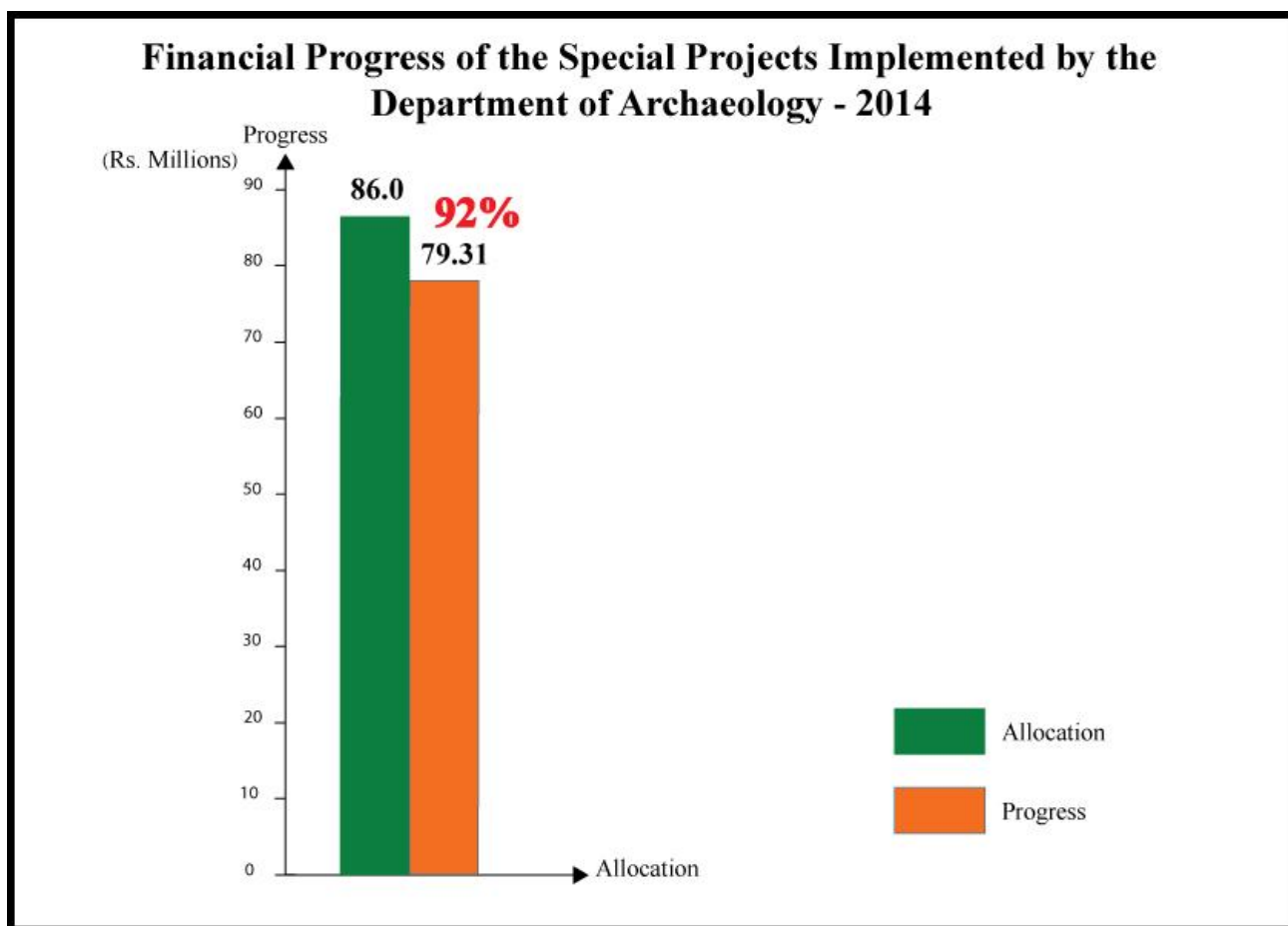
