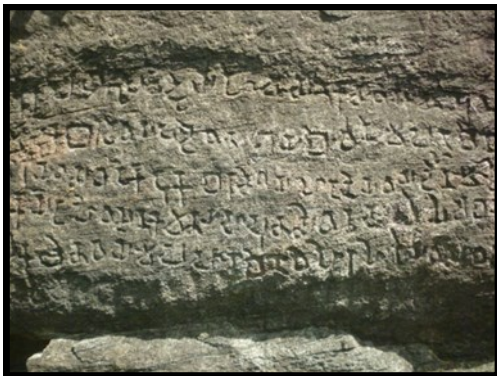
Projects conducted by the Head office

01. Archeological Research conducted at Peelekema Aranya Senasanaya and nearby area.

Location - Peelekema Aranya Senasanaya is located at Kudaoya Village of Kudaoya Grama Niladhari Division of Divisional Secretariat Division Wellawaya of Monaragala District in Uva Province.

Present Peelekema Aranyaya Senasanaya is located at one part of this site. The cave with carved ditches had been developed and used as a cottage later. In addition to this cave there are other two caves with engraved ditches on the rocks in various sized located at this premises. Further, facts of a rock cut staircase and Malaka Pana Bamma and facts of two ruined buildings believed to be of Anuradhapura Era have been revealed. The most important facts found at this premises are two inscriptions inscribed at two places of the same rock belong to C.E..4century. Among those facts there is a pond beatifying the place made by constructing dams to retain water flowing from a rock spout is used in the present day also. An amount of Rs. 60,831.50 has been allocated for this investigation project.

Conclusion and suggestions - when considering the archeological value it is proper to declare this premises as a archeological reservation. Accordingly, it is suitable to identify the zone where archeological facts are available and separate the area by fixing boundary stones and the adjoining premises without archeological facts should be assigned for the development activities of the monastery (Aranya Senasanaya).



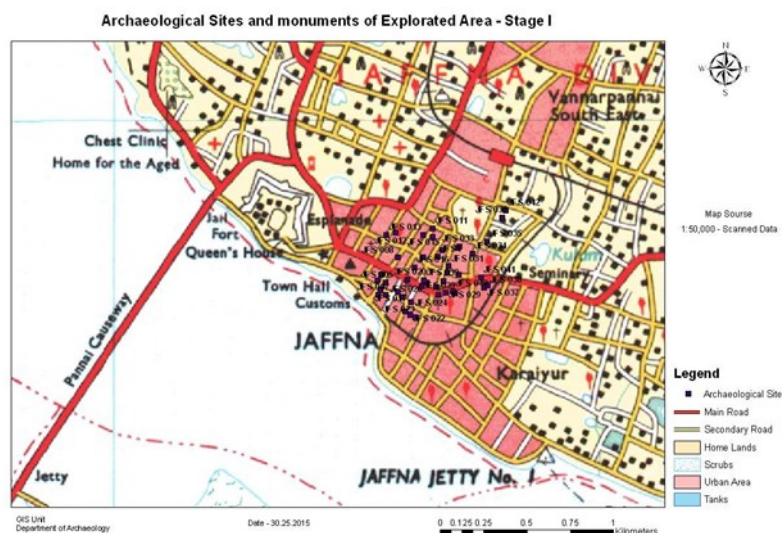
- **Archeological researches conducted at Jaffna fort area**

Location -This research was conducted at Divisional Secretariat Division Nallur of Jaffna District in the Northern Province. At the first phase ancient monuments of the part belong to the area spread from 1st cross lane to 4th cross lane of either side from 300 meters away of the A 9 road of Jaffna Fort were identified. An amount of Rs. 93,987.50 was allocated for this project.

Objectives of the project - although many archeological researches were conducted at the area of Jaffna Fort a formal archeological research has not been done at the urban area around the Fort. The main purpose of this project is to identify monuments of archeological value, proposing special monuments to be gazette as reserved monuments in order to determine antiqueness for the development projects conducted after the long term war.

Overview, observations and suggestions- 41 ancient monuments have been identified under this research conducted during the period from 28.07.2015 to 07.08.2015. Monuments belong to urban area located on the east which is considered as Dutch Colony site constructed based on the Jaffna Fort and belongs to Grama Niladhari Divisions J 72 Sinnakadei, J 73 Jaffna West, J 74 Jaffna East were identified under this research.

It has been suggested to conserve and gazette 10 monuments as reserved monuments out of the identified monuments considering the risk of devastation and architectural and archeological value of them.

- **Investigation Project of identifying archeological sites—Divisional Secretariat Division Thambalagamuwa—Trincomalee District**

Due to the long term war archeological researches conducted within the Eastern Province were minimum. To fulfill this requirement this investigation project was implemented with the coordination of Eastern Provincial Office during the period from 13.12.2015 to 31.12.2015 with the objective of identifying and reporting of archeological sites in Divisional Secretariat Division Thambalagamuwa in Trincomalee District under the financial provisions allocated in 2015 for archeological affairs of Trincomalee District.

The archeological facts found from Thambalagamuwa area which was called as “Thambalakamam”, “Thambala”, “Thambavita”, “Thambapitthi” reveal that the archeological sites in this area are belong to Anuradhapura and Polonnaruwa eras.

Conclusions and suggestions - 17 archeological sites could be identified at this Divisional Secretariat Division area. Out of them Singha Kanda Kataram Lena (cave with carved ditches), Monara Kanda ruins site, Viharakanda Archeological site, Ruins at the Ismaththa of Galmetiyawa tank, Galpokuna Rajamaha Viharaya, Kodigala Kanda ruins, Nishshankamalla Gawutha inscription and Mollipothana ruins are places of significant archeological value. Most of archeological sites have been damaged due to development activities and excavations. It has been suggested to gazette several sites as reserved monuments out of these archeological sites.



Project of registration of mobile artifacts

This project was implemented during the whole year of 2015 (from 01.01.2015 to 31.12.2015) and the main objective of this project was to identify number of artifacts and type of artifacts and identifying damages caused to those artifacts and conservations requirements for those artifacts and prevention of stealing and missing of artifacts and preparing a data base on movable artifacts. Artifacts at the following places were registered during this year.

- i. Laboratory of head office—Department of Archeology, Sir Markes Fernando Mawatha, Colombo 07.
- ii. Railway Museum—Maradana, Colombo 10
- iii. Swarna Hansa Foundation— Battaramulla

- **Declaring monuments.**

Sites identified as archeological sites at the site inspections carried out by provincial and offices and head office are declared as archeological monuments. Therefore, the number of monuments declared within each year could not be decided statistically.

In 2015 drafts were prepared to declare 235 monuments. Accordingly, 71 archeological sites in Ampara District have been declared. Notifications were published for calling objections in respect of 56 monuments.

In addition, although actions were taken to declare drafts of three documents such as 67,58,54, monuments in the year of 2015 the work could not be finalized until to date due to the changing of the Ministers in charge of the subjects from time to time. That is because every document to be published should be signed by the Minister. Procedure of publishing amendment draft Gazette Papers prepared for one Minister should be again started from the first step viz. obtaining approval from the Legal Draftsman. Similarly, one document had to be amended for three Ministers during this year.

Therefore, progress of declaring of monuments in the year 2015 could not be achieved properly and the progress has been achieved as follows.

- ◆ Number of monuments declared - **71**
- ◆ Number of monuments for which notifications were published for calling objections - **56**
- ◆ Number of monuments included in four documents amended from time to time. - **235**

Geographical Data Processing Unit (GIS Unit)

1. Project of initial research for identifying archeological sites and monuments in the Western and mapping - Kaluthara District

Mapping of archeological sites and monuments of the Western Province was commenced in 2014 through Disaster Management Center with the assistance of United Nations Development Fund (UNDP). 04 field investigations were carried out under that project and 4th phase was conducted during the year 2015. under that project 33 archeological sites of Kaluthara District were reported.

Excavation Division

A number of various projects are implemented for the purpose of securing the archeological heritage and enhancing researches and public awareness .

1. Excavation project for the evaluation of archeological impact.
2. Research excavations relating to ancient history and pre historic eras.
3. Implementation of projects, analysis of excavation data, preparing reports and excavation projects taken place before conservation of dilapidated archeological monuments.
4. Excavation projects of monuments carried out before the conservation and ensuring for the public exhibition.
5. Supervision of archeological excavations carried out by other licensed institutes under the permission of Department of Archeology.

♦ **Excavation of ruined buildings and surrounding rampart of Magul Maha Viharaya Sithulpawwa.**

This monument is located in Ranakelia Grama Niladhari Division, Zone No. 02 of Yala National Park of Divisional Secretariat Division Tissamaharamaya of Hambanthota District in the Southern Province. This project was implemented according to a request made from Sithulpawwa Rajamaha Viharaya for a period from 18.03.2015 to 28.06.2015 with the objective of excavation and conservation of this ancient monument. Provisions for this project was granted by Precedent's Fund.

Several inscriptions with Brahmi letters belong to Before Christ Era were found from this place while excavations were carried out. Similarly, it has been confirmed that the architectural features spread upon the surface of the ancient monuments are belonged to the early period of Anuradapura Era.

According to the archeological information and the information contained in Mahawanshaya this place and surrounding area had been an important security place of the country during the historical eras. Later, as a temple complex architectural constructions, ruins of a BodhiGharaya and internal and outer ramparts are important facts found at this excavation.

◆ **Excavation of the area of Hanguranketha Town**

This excavation was carried out at the vicinity of main road near the Vishnu Devalaya situated in Hanguranketha Town of Hanguranketha Grama Niladhari Division of Nuwaraeliya District in the Central Province by the central provincial office of the Department of Archeology.

The main objective of this excavation was regarding the decision of felling the Mara Tree situated nearby the ancient Vishnu Devlaya according to the project of developing Kanda Junction– Ragala Road. According to the legends the place is believed to be the place of cremation of the King Second Rajasingha and the excavation was carried out with the purpose of confirming that belief.

It has been said by the elderly people of the area that four stone pillars were emerged at this place before several decades. However, these monuments have been ruined due to the road development before several decades. A stone plaque representing the royal mark of the King Rajasingha is available there but as specified by Robert Knocks remaining of King Rajasingha has been deposited at cremation compound of Kandy.

Outer rampart wall of the Vishnu Devalaya is situated on the North 13 meters away from the place where the ancient monument is located. Awasageya of Pothgul Viharaya is situated on the North—East 15 meters away from the said place and old Ambalama is situated 03 meters away from the place.

No factors of a possible cremation was reported at the excavations. It was because that place is located at a populous place and therefore soil layers constantly subject to de-rangements due to development activities.

◆ **Excavation of ruined building of ancient Hindu Kovil near Abhaya Wewa of Anuradhapura.**

This monuments with ruins is located at the museum premises belong to the Department of Archeology close to Abhaya Wewa (Basawakkulama) of Divisional Secretariat Division of Central Nuwaragam Palatha of Anuradhapura District in the North Central Province. This excavation was carried out with the objective of conserving monuments.

This monument has been constructed smartly with granites. It is 5.55 meters in length and 13.20 meters in width. Architectural features of an ancient Hindu image house are visible here. Viz. *Antharalaya Mandapaya* and *house* have been built. However, rocks situated near the old monument have been utilized in constructing the new Pulleyar Kovil. The Shiva Lingaya previously placed at the old Devalaya also have been now placed at the new Kovil.

◆ Excavation of Medavachchiya Katuwala Stupa

Excavation activities of this Stupa which is situated in Grama Niladhari Division Thulan Katuwala No. 66 of Divisional Secretariat Division Medavachchiya of Anuradhapura District in the North Central Province were carried out during the period from 12.10.2015 to 04.12.2015.

According to the architectural facts found at the excavations it can be assumed that this Stupa had been constructed during the period from 1-3 C.E. Artifacts such as Siripathul Gal, (feet rocks), pieces of roofing tiles, pieces of pots, glass beads, parched clay figures could be found by the excavations. The Stupa had been constructed on the rocky surface.

The circumference of the Stupa is 29 meters. There are two terrace rounds, (Pesa Walalu). There were four altars at the size of 50x50 made of granite at the four directions. The Stupa Garbha had been destroyed by irregular excavations. Piece of clay pot with letters is a very important expedition.

◆ **Excavation of rampart wall of Manabharana Vihara site**

Excavation and revealing of ancient rampart wall belongs to the ancient Manabharana Viharaya situated at 123 F Grama Niladhari Division of Divisional Secretariat Division Siyambalanduwa of Monaragala District in the Uva province was commenced on 15th July 2015.

Historical resources describes that this place belongs to the 11-12 C.E. centuries . The Stupa exhibiting ancient architectural features, parts of stone pillars belong to the ancient buildings and rampart wall and other artifacts are available at this place.

The length of the rampart wall of this premises is 68x55. Before construction of the rampart wall earth was dug and snicked base stones were laid and the wall was constructed by placing side stones on it. It has been revealed that the wall was constructed gradually by placing snick stones to prevent slipping of those side stones and the middle of the rampart was filled with a mortar mixture of gravel powder, stone chips and clay. Further, base stones, stone slides and wedge stones, snick stones and mortar mixture with gravel had been mainly used for the construction of this rampart. The width of this rampart had been around 1.40 meters.

◆ **Analysis activities of Artifacts**

Analyzing of artifacts found from the excavation of Neelagiri Stupa located at the forest reservation close to Lahugala of Ampara District has now been finalized and reports of the analyze will be published in the near future.

Analyzing of a number of stone tools and ancient animal residuals found from the excavations made by the Excavation Division of the Department of Archeology at Pahiyangala cave located at the Divisional Secretariat Division Bulathsinhala in Kaluthara District in the years of 2011, 2012 and 2013 has been finalized by this year.

➤ **Projects implemented in the year of 2015**

- **Conservation o Yudaganawa Dagoba**

Yudaganawa Stupa is located at the Divisional Secretariat Division of Buttala in Monaragala District of Uwa Province. The irregular parts of the upper Dagoba of the Stupa was reconstructed as a regular Dagoba and security of the Dagoba was ensured under this conservation project. However, presently it has been able to overcome those challenges and complete about 75% conservation work due to the dedication of the officers and staff. • Kataragama Devalaya Amaduwa

Conservation activities were started on a request made by the Basnayaka Nilame of this Ammaduwa Devalaya a chief Katharagama Devalaya of the area where annual Perahera Ceremony is held. Major conservations activities were carried out at the roof of the Devalaya and electricity system and Spinnerets rail were repaired. Activities such as fixing doors



- **Conservation of Tholangamuwa Preaching Hall**

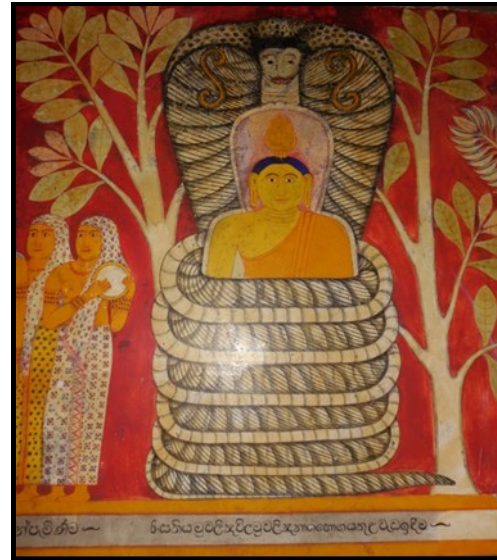

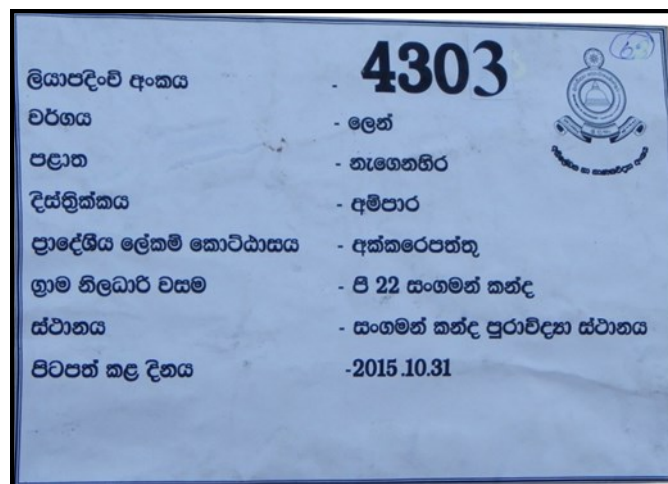

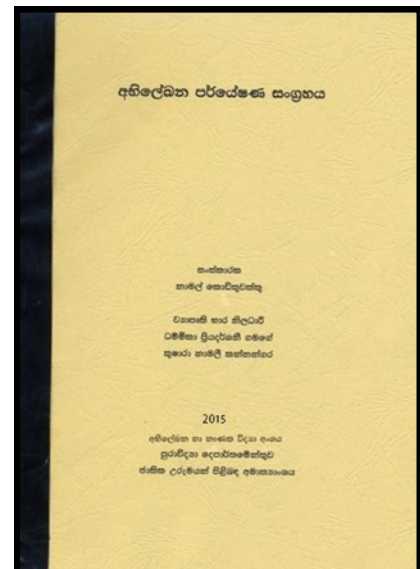

Then decayed parts of the rafters were removed and new timber parts were joined and to rectify the crookedness of the wall and an action was taken to fix supporters to the timber logs (BAIKA) running on the wooden pillars and action was taken to lift up to the roof and wooden pegs were fixed to equally level the roof. Then decayed ceiling boards were removed and new ceiling boards were fixed and then tar sheets were laid on the ceiling boards and Reepers of 2x1” were fixed and tiles were thatched. At the end action was taken to fill cavities and the work has been finalized by placing a mortar layer in order to prevent leaking water inside through the prevailed hole.

Then the supporters were fixed to the roof and cracked parts of the walls and bricks pillars were repaired. Then surface plaster of the hollowed walls was removed and re-plastered. The crookedness of the roof was recovered by removing the rafters and tiled frame and fixing new reepers and thatching petal tiles. Finally cavities of the roof (kumera) were filled and roof was made properly and pinnacle was fixed. The work has been successfully finalized by lime washing the walls of the building.

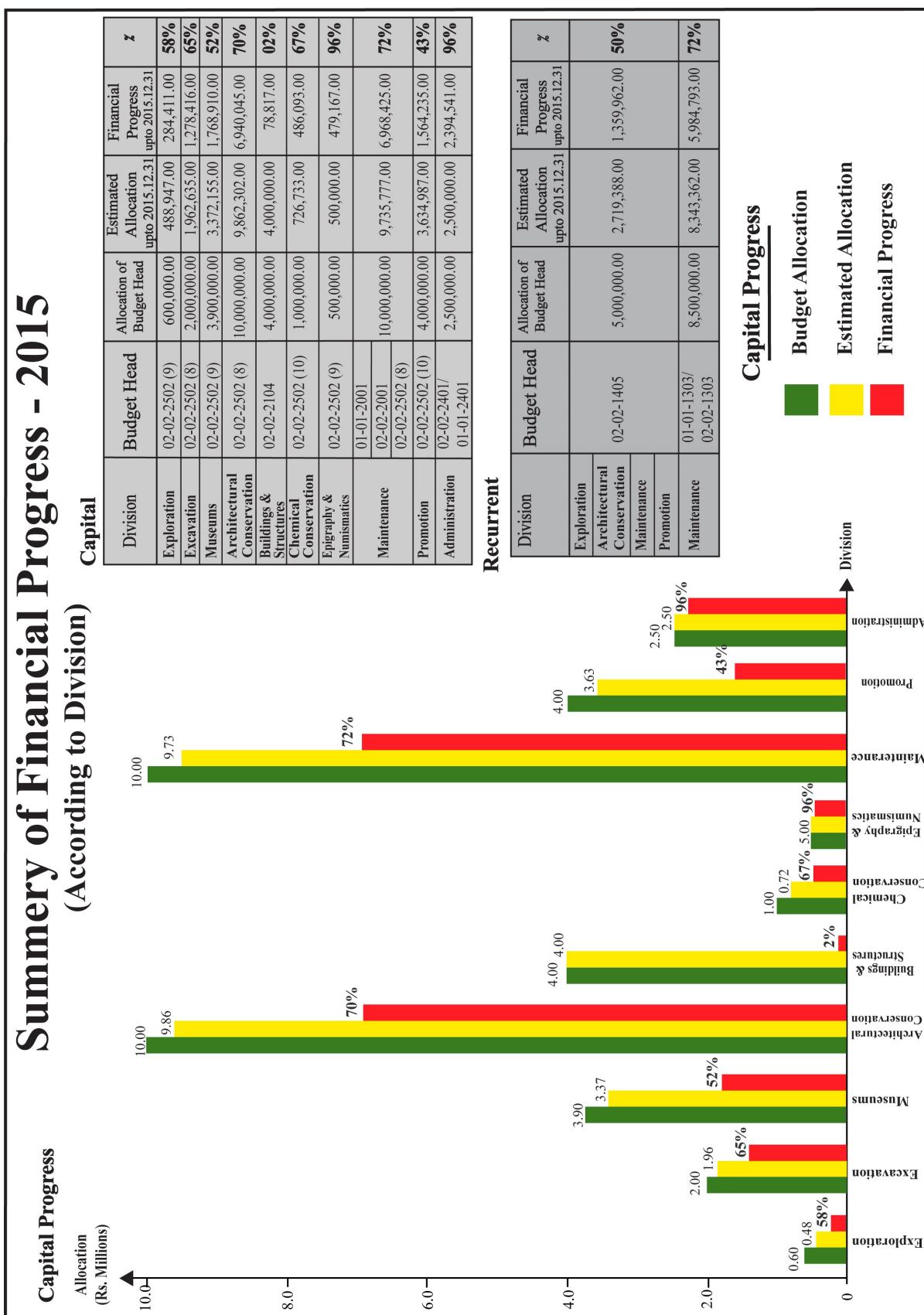

- ♦ Financial provisions prevised to the Department of Archeology in 2015

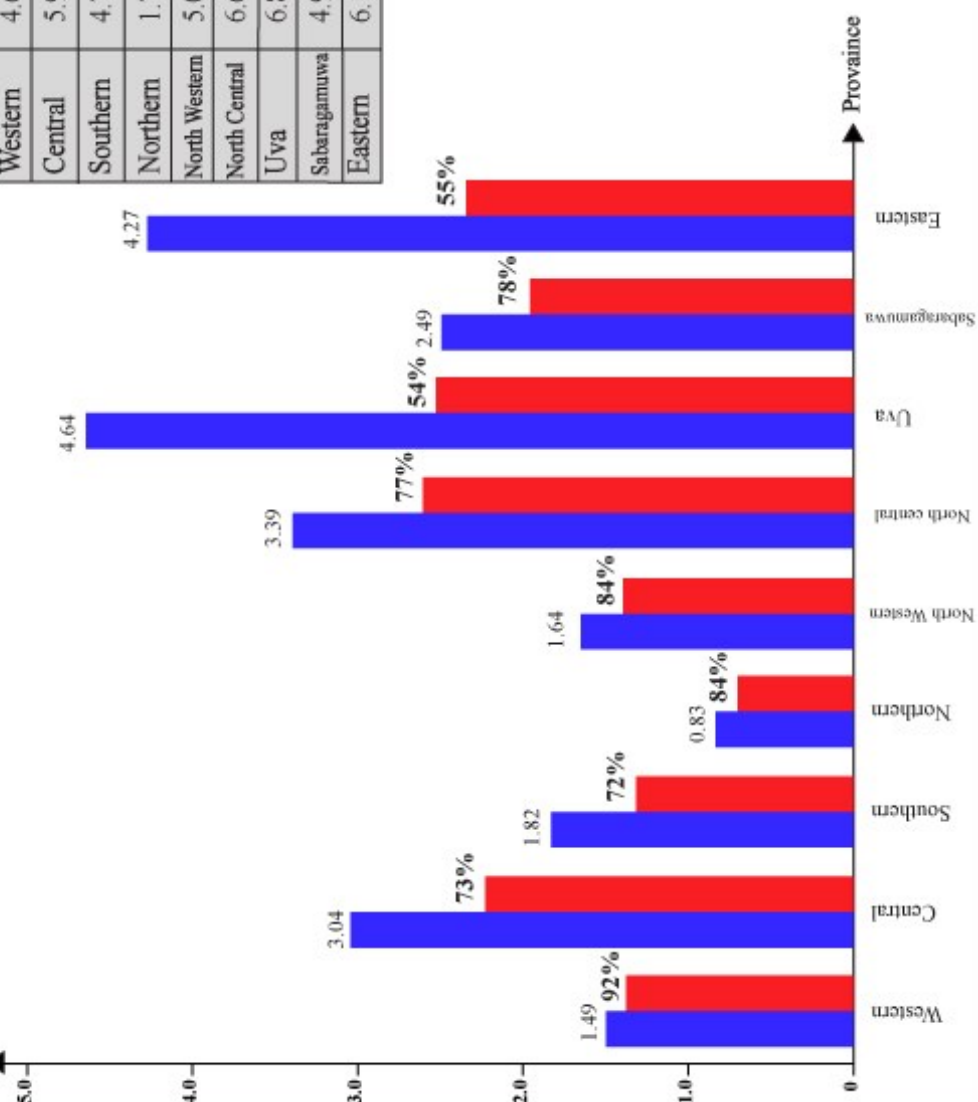


- ♦ Summery of financial progress (According to divisions and provisions)



Summery of Financial Progress - 2015 (According to Provinces)

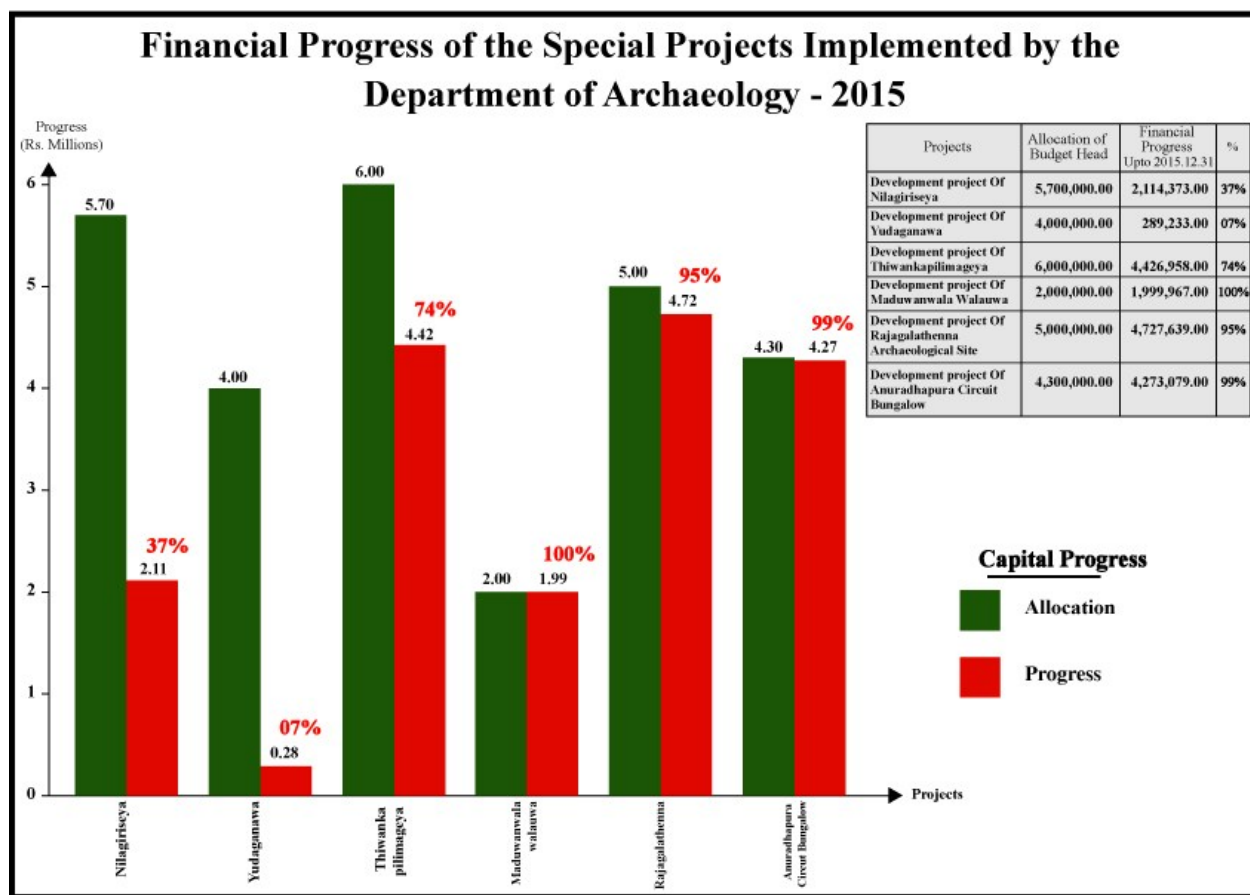
