MILITARY OPERATIONS CONDUCTED BY THE SRI LANKA ARMY

1. The following Operations were conducted during the year 2001.

<u>OPERATION KINIHIRA IX</u>	Jaffna	2001.01.16

a. OPERATION KINIHEERA IX was launched by 55 Division troops on 16 Jan 2001 with the intention of regaining the lost ground in general area KILALY. As planned 6/8 Gemunu Watch battalion and 5/7 Vijayaba Infantry Regiment troops of 553 Brigade with Commandos led the advance towards KILALY. Though terrorist attempted to hinder the advance, leading troops managed to complete the phase I of the Operation by 0800 hours successfully. Around 0830 hours troops commenced the consolidation of newly captured area and simultaneously terrorist fired intensive Artillery/Mortar to the newly captured area continuously. Firing continued for 6 hours.

b. Through counter bombardment directed to the identified mortar locations considerable number of casualties were caused. Reinforcement troops were sent to the holding lines in order to avoid creating vacuums due to heavy casualties. During the consolidation 51 x terrorist dead bodies were recovered and terrorist transmission confirmed that 74 x terrorists were injured. Approximately 07 x square kilometres were captured and following items were recovered during the operation.

- s. 04 x Detonating codes.
- t. 08 x Explosive tubes.

2. **OPERATION AGNIKHEELA.**

Location
Jaffna

Duration
2001.04.25

a. OPERATION AGNI KEELA commenced on 25 April 2001 with 55 Division on the north of the A - 9 road and 53 Division on the south. Consequent to Operation KINIHEERA IX conducted by the Security Force the LTTE has constructed a def line approximately 400 - 600 m forward of the Security Force Forward Defended Line in MUHAMALAI and PONNAR manned by approximately 250 cadres belonging to CHARLES ANTHONY, SODHIYA and ELLPADAI groups. Further, a second line of defence too has been constructed approximately 1800 - 2000 m behind the above line. LTTE manned a fortified bunker line approximately 400 - 600 m forward of the Security Force Forward Defence Line in NAGARKOVIL in area north of KADOLANA which is strongly held by approximately 150 BATTICALOA cadres. They have been occupying area for the past eight months anticipating a Security Force breakout from Nagarkovil Forward Defence Line.

b. 53 Division troops managed to breach the terrorists first line around 0620 hrs and by 0715 hrs captured former Security Force bunker line under heavy resistance of terrorist direct and indirect fire with Improvised Explosive Devoices (IEDs). Around 0810 hrs 6 SLSR troops who were holding the northern flank of the 53 Division area came under heavy fire resulting a gap of 500 m.

c. Special Forces Brigade who was tasked to proceed along the KILALY LAGOON could reach only up to the stream and around 0830 hrs they were pulled back due to heavy casualties. Subsequently Special Force Brigade was launched to cover the gap of 1.5 km to make a link with 6 Sri Lanka Singha Regiment of 533 Birgade and 6 Gajaba Regiment of 531 Brigade.

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d. 4 Sri Lanka Light Infantry with armour launched couple of assaults who were occupying the gap and shoulders and subsequently recaptured the northern shoulder. Security Force (Jaffna) reserve of 7 Sri Lanka Light Infantry was launched around 1600 hrs in order to create a passage through. Around 0300 hrs on 26 Apr 2001 morning, 53 Division commenced their organized withdrawal towards the former Forward Defence Line.

e. 516 Brigade and 553 Brigade broke out from the line as planned and 516 Brigade reached their objective by 0815 hrs. 553 Brigade could not proceed due to terrorist heavy resistance. Subsequently 553 Brigade regrouped and pushed through 516 Brigade and occupied the terrorist first line. Commando Brigade proceeded along KADOLANA and during the night of 25 Apr 2001 completed their capture of first objective.

f. On 26th Terrorist continue to concentrate on 55 Division newly captured area with heavy Arty and Mortar fire. Troops holding the southern line had to face continues terrorist attacks from terrorist trench line leading from A - 9 road towards the new southern Forward Defence Line. One Brigade from 53 Division was launched to strengthen the new southern line. Terrorist gained few breaches on this line but troops manage to recapture and hold.

g. On 27th by 0600 hrs terrorist gained a breach on the southern new line creating a gap of about 1000 m. 4 Gamunu Watch and 4/12 Sri Lanka Singha Regiment attempted to breach the gap but withdrawn to the Forward Defence Line having suffered heavy casualties. At 1300 hrs 53 Division troops were launched to recapture the gap. Through out the day troops on the newly captured area were subjected to terrorist heavy artillery/mortar fire and assaults on to the southern line along terrorist bunker lines.

h. Around 0445 hrs 28th Apr 2001 55 Division completed their tactical withdrawal and returned to the former Forward Defence Line.

i. Although Security Force could not achieve desired results in terms of terrain, were able to cause considerable losses to terrorist men and material.

TRAINING CONDUCTED AND PROPOSED BY THE
SRI LANKA ARMY

1. Local Training. In addition to the training courses conducted at training schools, the following courses were also conducted with immense dedication during the year 2001.

a. 20 x Regular Battalions and 03 x Volunteer Battalions were trained under Security Force Headquarters(Jaffna) and 05 x Regular Battalions and Volunteer Battalions were trained under Security Force Headquarters(Wanni). The 22 Division conducted Company level training for 05 x Regular and Volunteer Battalions and the 23 Division conducted platoon level training for 05 x Regular Battalions respectively. Further, courses such as Special Operation Platoon , Assault Pioneer, Basic marksmanship, Artillery Observation Course and small group training were also conducted in above locations.

b. Special Young Officers' Courses were conducted at the Army Training School, Maduru Oya for 304 Officer Cadets from Regular and Volunteer Intakes. Additional courses for the Volunteer Force, namely Young Officers', 2nd In Command', Company Commanders' and Adjutants' courses were conducted at Combat Training School - Ampara. In addition to training conducted at training establishments, individual training as well as group training were conducted at Division/Brigade level.

c. Tamil Language was introduced for the benefit of troops deployed in the Colombo city and the suburbs. To date more than 250 soldiers have successfully completed the course.

d. Lectures on International Affairs were organized at the BMICH for the benefit of middle grade Officers.

e. The English Language training was introduced at Army Headquarters for the benefit of Junior Officers and Other Ranks.

f. Correspondence courses in Sinhala, for the subjects of Social Studies and Mathematics were conducted to improve the literacy level of recruits.

g. The Army Command & Staff College commenced its fourth Staff College Course on 12 February 2001. 29 x Officers including two officers from the Sri Lanka Navy and three Officers from the Sri Lanka Air Force were enrolled for this course.


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

OUTLINE ORGANIZATION - HEADQUARTERS SRI LANKA ARMY




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SLAVF OUT LINE ORGANIZATION


