



GENERAL

1. The objective of publishing this Annual Report is to produce an analysis into General Staff, Administrative and Logistic matters carried out by Directorates of Army Head Quarters and other establishments during year 2004 and also lapses observed due to certain constraints.
2. Assignments completed and proposals for the following year by respective authorities have been included in this report with a view to provide a broad insight into events during year 2004 and proposals for year 2005.
3. Certain programmes pre – scheduled for year 2004 had been amended to suit unforeseen demands specially in Security Force Headquarters(Jaffna), Security Force Headquarters(Wanni) and Security Force Headquarters(East).
4. All Senior appointments and Staff appointments at Army Headquarters are indicated at the beginning of the report.
5. The Directorate of Training has trained troops locally and abroad. A considerable number of Officers, Other Ranks and Recruits were trained during the year 2004.
6. A sum of Rs 33,379,356,097/= was allocated in the Annual Budget for both capital and recurrent expenditure.
7. The Army paid strength including the total number of Officers and Other Ranks disabled due to terrorist activities and non terrorist activities as well. Hence there is a shortfall of strength in Regiments/Battalions for operational duties. It is suggested that Ministry of Defence approval be obtained for the enlistment of Other Ranks in the Army excluding the strength of the disabled personnel in order to boost up the strength in the Regiments/Battalions.
8. Approximately 30% of the total number of deserters cleared by the Directorate of Pay & Records was discharged during the discharge programme launched in Gampaha, Kalutara, Colombo, Anuradhapura and Kurunegala districts. It is recommended that arresting of deserters be conducted in the same districts through which deserters of other districts could be motivated to obtain their discharge in future discharge programmes.
9. The Sports Control Board has developed both sportsmen and sports women and given opportunities to participate both at Local and International level. The Army had achieved higher standards in sports during year 2004.
10. Army was able to deploy troops in Tsunami affected areas mainly in the South and the East for rescue missions and to assist the IDP centres since the government machinery functions to become normal. Also the Army was able to help affected people in numerous ways and was honoured by the public.
11. A total number of 8569 recruits have been recruited and 120 Officer Cadets have been commissioned during year 2004. 4003 Other Ranks have been discharged during the period under review.
12. Every encouragement was given to Officers/Other Ranks who intended constructing their own houses by way of arranging various facilities.

13. The Directorate of Welfare had implemented a considerable number of programmes for the benefit of the Sri Lanka Army. Many Insurance schemes has been implemented in liaison with the Insurance Co-operation.

14. Arrangements were made to obtain the services of civil specialist Medical Officers in various fields of medical specialties in order to provide the best possible medical & surgical care to the personnel, their families and civil staff in the Army.

15. It is important to organize some refresher courses for para medical personnel to update their knowledge. Therefore it is necessary to obtain reservation of relevant vacancies for courses like, Nursing, Radiography, Medical Laboratory Technician, Physiotherapy, Pharmacist, Public Health Inspector, Electro Encephalography Technician, Electro Cardiography Technician and Ophthalmic Technician in the medical field.

16. Army Headquarters has co-ordinated Naval/Air/Rail/Road moves for the benefit of all personnel of the Army during year 2004. Officers and Other Ranks were provided with Air fare to attend courses/seminars/ visits abroad.

j. Language Courses

(1) Sinhala. Teaching of Sinhala Language was continued at Sri Lanka Army General Service Corps Training School – Kuttigala for the benefit of Other Ranks who do not possess the required reading and writing capability. 181 x Other Ranks have completed the course at the Sri Lanka Army General Service Corps Training School.

(2) English. It was evident that Officers and Other Ranks found it difficult to follow courses overseas as the medium of instruction was English Language. At present an English course is being conducted by the 531 Brigade for officers of the respective TAOR. 02 x courses have been conducted to date and 80 x officers have attended the same.

(3) Tamil. Conducting of Tamil Language courses were expanded up to brigade level to improve the Tamil proficiency of the Army personnel. At the beginning of the year 2004, it was planned to commit approximately 6000 students. However the no of personnel committed for courses had been approximately 2750 due to various difficulties such as lack of instructors, deviation from the scheduled year plan etc. 03 x instructor courses have been conducted by the Directorate of Training and 75 x instructors were sent to respective locations after completing the course. The instructor courses are planned to be continued to fulfill the instructor requirements of the Army.

Though battalions have completed their Battle Efficiency Physical Tests, they have not concentrated on the importance of PET for Officers and Other Ranks. Divisions and regiments, which had not conducted these tests, were instructed to conduct same in the 1st quarter of year 2004. Physical Efficiency Tests were conducted by the Directorate of Training for officers, prior to their confirmation of ranks and promotions.

LOCAL TRAINING WITH FOREIGN ASSISTANCE

o. Non-Lethal Weapons Seminar-04 (NOLES-04). The Non-Lethal Weapons Seminar (NOLES) was a US Army Pacific Command (PACOM) coordinated initiative designed to improve the ability of the Armed Forces of all participating countries to conduct Humanitarian Assistance/Disaster Relief and Peace Keeping Operation Missions where civil unrest may create a potential force protection issue. The Sri Lanka Army in conjunction with the US Army Marine Forces Pacific conducted this seminar from 03 Aug 2004 to 05 Aug 2004 at the Institute of Peace Support Operations Training Sri Lanka (Institute of Peace Support Operations Training – Sri Lanka). There were 50 x foreign participants from 12 x countries and 30 x local participants from the Sri Lanka Army, Sri Lanka Navy, Sri Lanka Air Force and Police Special Task Force.

p. Defense Institute of International Legal Studies (DILLS) Counter Terrorism Executive Seminar. A team of experts from the United States Military conducted this seminar which discussed the Legal Responses to Terrorism and matters concerned with Counter Terrorism. The seminar was conducted for participants of all three services from 21 June 2004 to 25 June 2004 at the Hotel Taj Samudra.

q. De-mining Training. With the assist of the RONCO consulting cooperation of the United States, Humanitarian Demining Training was conducted at the Sri Lanka School of Military Engineering, Embilipitiya. r. Recognition at UN Peace Keeping Missions is deemed advantageous to the country diplomatically. The (Institute of Peace Support Operations Training – Sri Lanka) was established in Kukuleganga on 12 June 2004 to cater towards training for Peace Keeping Missions and subsequently the MPE-3 was conducted at the same institute.

s. **Multi Platoon Exercise-3 (MPE-3)**

(1) The subject Ex co-hosted by the United States Army Pacific Command (USARPAC) was conducted at Kukuleganga from 12 Jun 2004. 180 x troops from four major foreign countries (Bangladesh, Mongolia, Nepal, USA) and 68 x troops from Sri Lanka Army participated in the same.





OUTLINE ORGANIZATION - FIELD FORMATIONS




