PERFORMANCE APPRAISAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ELECTIONS FOR THE YEAR 2013

01. Introduction

Enumeration of electors and certifying of the electoral register for the year 2013, conduct of elections to Central, Northern and North Western Provincial Councils and the filling of vacancies in the Parliament, Provincial Councils and Local Authorities were the activities performed by the Department of Elections during the year 2013.

02. Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980

2.1 Revision of Electoral Registers – 2012

2.1.1 The enumeration of electors commenced on 01st June 2012 and concluded during August 2012. The “A” list which contains the names deleted from the operative register and the “B” list which contains the newly inserted names to the operative register were prepared after the enumeration were exhibited at District Elections Offices, Divisional Secretariats, Local Authorities and all Grama Niladhari Offices in October 2012. Accordingly, opportunity to submit claims and objections for the year 2012 regarding non inclusion of a name or inclusion of the name of a disqualified elector was given during the period from 4th to 31st of October 2012.

2.1.2 At the revision of electoral registers in the year 2012 a special programme was conducted through the Computer Branch relating to multiple registrations. Accordingly, multiple registrations among new names within the district, multiple registrations among the newly inserted names and the names in the operative register in respect to the district, newly inserted names in the district and newly inserted names to all other districts and newly inserted names within the district and operative registers of all other districts were traced by using computers.

2.1.3. The Electoral Register was certified on 31.12.2012 in terms of Section 18 of the Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980 taking into consideration the matters relating to multiple registrations and inquiries into claims / objections and after re-scrutinizing in the names of all the electors with the enumeration forms (BC Forms). The notice under Section 20 regarding the certification was published in Gazette No. 1791/1 of 31.12.2012 and in newspapers.

- 2.1.4 Under the procedure followed up to now in the annual revision of the electoral register, the register was certified traditionally on or on a date close to the 31st of the month of May of the following year. However, in the year 2012, the register was certified in the same calendar year for the first time. This can be considered as a significant feature.
- 2.1.5 The determination of the Commissioner of Elections in terms of Article 98(8) of the Constitution regarding the number of members to be elected for the year 2013 from each electoral district at a Parliamentary Election, based on the statements provided by Registering Officer of each electoral district, under Section 23 of the Registration of Electors Act after certifying the Electoral Register in 2012, was published in the Gazette No. 1796/7 of 6th February 2013. Relevant details are shown in Table I.
- 2.1.6 Accordingly, the number of Members of Parliament for No. 06 – Nuwara Eliya Electoral District was increased by one and the number of members for No. 19 - Badulla Electoral District was decreased by one in the year 2013. Comparative Statement on the number of members of Parliament to be elected for each electoral district (2004-2013) under the Article 98(8) of the Constitution is shown in Table II.

2.2 Revision of Electoral Registers – 2013

- 2.2.1 Necessary steps were taken to publish a notice under the Section 12(1) of the Registration of Electors Act in the Government Gazette No. 1810/33 on 15.05.2013 and to publish a notice in Sinhala, Tamil and English on the same day in the newspapers in regard to the commencement of the enumeration of electors for the year 2013.
- 2.2.2 Until the year 2013, house to house enumeration of electors commenced on 1st of June every year. But steps were taken to commence action in this regard before 1st of June after taking in to consideration the provisions of the Registration of Electors Act and the decision to certify the register within the year. But as in the previous years 1st of June in the relevant year was considered as the qualifying date to register as an elector.
- 2.2.3 Necessary instructions regarding enumeration of electors in all electoral districts were issued to District Registering Officers on 11.03.2013 and the Commissioner of Elections informed the Secretaries of all the recognized political parties on the same day regarding the revision and the procedure for appointing their representatives.

- 2.2.4 Until the revision in year 2011, general public were made aware about the commencement of enumeration of electors by way of notices in newspapers and publicity through electronic media. But in 2012 apart from those steps were taken to enlighten all Members of Parliament, Provincial Councils and Local Authorities, Secretaries to all Ministries, Chief Secretaries to Provincial Councils, Secretaries to Provincial Ministries, and Heads of Government Departments, Corporations and Boards. Further, background was prepared to obtain wide public co-operation by enlightening trade unions and Superintendents of Estates and conducting awareness programmes to Principals of all Government schools and through them the students.
- 2.2.5 In addition to all afore mentioned awareness programmes conducted in the 2012 enumeration, steps were taken to make general public aware about enumeration of electors in relation to the revision of electoral registers for the year 2013. Commissioner of Elections declared 01st of June in every year as the **“Voters Day”** and took necessary steps to conduct various awareness programmes by the Elections Secretariat and at district level.
- 2.2.6 The first day of June in the relevant year is prescribed as the qualifying date on which a person should be a citizen of Sri Lanka, should have attained the age of eighteen years and having ordinary residence in the relevant electoral district. Commissioner of Elections therefore decided to declare this date as **“The Voters’ Day”** and expected to obtain the maximum support from everyone who engages in the election process, for the awareness process and actions in relation to the revision. By declaring the 01st of June of every year as the Voters’ Day and conduct of various programmes along with this day, the main objective was to secure the voting right of every citizen who is entitled to the franchise.
- 2.2.7 After taking into consideration the reports of Enumerators and District Registering Officers on past revisions of electoral registers, various programmes for Voters’ Day were implemented, giving special attention to the categories of people mentioned below. They are
- I. People with low income as well as people with high income, belonging to upper and middle classes living in urban areas. (Who show no interest in accepting or handing over completed BC forms but enquire about when there is an election)
 - II. People living in urban high rise apartments.
 - III. Voters living in rented houses.

- IV. People living in difficult rural areas with lack of connections with external environment due to inadequate transport facilities.
- V. People migrating to urban areas in search of employment. (Specially the estate community)
- VI. Tamil people of Indian origin living in estates.
- VII. Internally displaced persons living in other areas of the Island due to military operations.
- VIII. Chronic patients hospitalized for a long period of time.
- IX. People living in homes for elders.
- X. Mentally sick persons who have been cured but continue to stay in Mental Hospitals due to non acceptance by their relatives.

2.2.8 A walk from Wijerama Mawatha, Colombo to Janadhipathi Vidyalaya, Rajagiriya which was led by Commissioner of Elections, was held on 01st of June 2013 as a main item of Voters' Day Programme, which was conducted by the Elections Secretariat to secure the franchise of all eligible citizens. This walk consisted of street dramas, sending balloons, exhibition of banners, posters, distribution of handbills and the participation of officers of Elections Secretariat and Colombo District Elections Office, Colombo District Secretariat, all Regional Divisional Secretaries and Grama Niladharis. At the end of the walk, Attorney General Mr. Palitha Fernando delivered a fruitful speech about the importance of registration as an elector in the electoral register. The said speech was greatly appreciated by every participant and it is a pleasure that the general public praised all of the programmes which were conducted to commemorate the Voters' Day.

2.2.9 Simultaneously, the District Secretaries / Registering Officers and Deputy Commissioners of Elections and Assistant Commissioners of Elections of all the districts made the general public aware about the importance to register as electors in the electoral register by conducting walks, street dramas, distributing handbills, pasting stickers on private buses, buses of Sri Lanka Transport Board, and on three wheelers and organizing seminars on 31.05.2013 and 01.06.2013.

- 2.2.10 Door to door collection of BC forms in areas of selected Municipal Councils and Urban Councils was conducted on 02.06.2013 in concurrence with the Voters' Day. Because of this one day programme of collection of BC forms from all the households within the relevant areas of authority, services of Grama Niladharis in other divisions and officers in other Government Offices had to be deployed. According to the observations of Deputy Commissioners of Elections and Assistant Commissioners of Elections in this connection, accurate information and forms from comparatively higher number of households were obtained under this programme.
- 2.2.11 The special programme which commenced in the year 2012, for registration of Tamil speaking persons of Indian origin in estates who were still not registered as electors was continued in the year 2013. Persons in the estates were made aware under this programme with the participation of Superintendants of Estates, Plantation Community Facilitators at Divisional Secretariats in estate areas and Grama Niladharis. Especially, a programme to obtain information directly through UE forms with the help of Plantation Community Facilitators at Divisional Secretaries and to insert such names was implemented during the claim period in the year 2013.
- 2.2.12 House to house enumeration of electors was conducted in the Northern Province by enumerators except for a limited area where displaced persons have not been resettled in 42 polling districts in 04 polling divisions in Electoral District No. 10 Jaffna and one polling division in Mannar district which belongs to No. 11 Vanni Electoral District. Instructions were given to retain the names of the electors, who could not be enumerated by door to door enumeration, as they appeared in the 2012 electoral register. Details of the relevant polling divisions and polling districts are shown in Table III.
- 2.2.13 Field work relating to enumeration of electors commenced on 15th May 2013 and concluded in mid-August 2013. Officers of Public Management Assistants' Service who serve at the District Elections Offices scrutinized the enumeration forms along with Enumerators. 'A' lists which consists of the names to be deleted and 'B' lists which include the new names to be inserted to the operative register (year 2012) were prepared after the scrutiny by the officers of District Elections Offices.

- 2.2.14 Before the commencement of enumeration, steps were taken to inform all recognized political parties to appoint representatives on their behalf to observe the delivery of enumeration forms (BC forms) to the Chief Occupants and acceptance of such forms after the enumeration and to submit their observations after examining the documents at the enumerators' offices after completion of field enumeration. Since 1981, this opportunity was given to all recognized political parties, as the participation of the agents of political parties to observe the duties of the enumerators will help to prepare an accurate electoral register. It is also a responsibility of all political parties to ensure the participation of their representatives in the enumeration process and ensure that the enumeration has been done correctly without complaining about depriving of the franchise of their party supporters, at a time of an election or when there are complaints from party men. However, while very limited number of political parties appoint their agents in this regard, insignificant number of those appointed contribute to this work. The details regarding appointments and participation of representatives of political parties for the revision of year 2013 are shown in Table IV.
- 2.2.15 Action was taken at the time of accepting enumeration forms (BC Forms) for the year 2013, from enumerators to inform chief occupants of the relevant households in writing to obtain further information, where the enumerators had not recommended the inclusion of names on various grounds though chief occupants entered those names or when all the voters of a household were deleted in the year 2013 though they were registered in the year 2012 or when any names were deleted due to various reasons viz. failure to handover the BC forms. According to the responses received from the chief occupants, the names which could be registered were accepted and names which could not be registered were treated as claims received during the period for claims.
- 2.2.16. The "A" and "B" lists, prepared after the enumeration were exhibited with the operative register (2012) at all District Elections Offices, all Divisional Secretariats, all Local Authorities and all Grama Niladhari Offices from 02.10.2013 to 30.10.2013 for perusal by the public. There were 717,611 names to be deleted and 1,030,025 new names to be inserted to the operative register (2012) relevant to the revision of electoral registers for all electoral districts for the year 2013. Claims and objections were accepted during this period of exhibition. The notice about exhibition of these documents was published under Section 13(2) of Registration of Electors

Act, in Gazette No. 1830/33 of 02.10.2013 and in all national newspapers on 04.10.2013. Accordingly, opportunity was given to the public to submit claims and objections after perusing the electoral register and ascertaining whether the name is to be included or deleted.

- 2.2.17 With regard to the revision of the year 2013, 106,168 claims and 801 objections were received by District Registering Officers of all the electoral districts. The Registering Officers were instructed to arrange inquiries in relation to above claims and objections within the month of November and the first week of December. Accordingly, the number of claims and objections received, accepted and rejected are shown in Table V.
- 2.2.18 The programme which was implemented in the year 2012 regarding the multiple registrations of the electoral register was carried out during the year 2013 also. Accordingly, multiple registrations among new names which were not in the operative register (2012) but to be included in the revised register within the district, multiple registrations among new names which were to be included to the revised register and the respective operative register within the district, multiple registrations among new names which were to be included to the revised register of the district and the respective operative registers of all other districts and multiple registrations among new names which were to be included to the revised register and the operative registers of all other districts were examined by using computers. Situations where two persons under the same National Identity Card number were also revealed at these examinations. However, ,617 names of multiple registrations were deleted in the year 2013 and details of the number of deleted names, because of multiple registrations, relating to each electoral district are shown in Table VI.
- 2.2.19. Enumerators were instructed to make every effort to obtain the National Identity Card Numbers of persons enumerated as the production of a valid identity card has been made compulsory at the time of voting according to the Elections (Special Provisions) Act No. 14 of 2004. Even where the identity card number given at the time of enumeration, the computer programme used in the revision process can detect any in correct numbers. In such instances, the Department of Registration of Persons and the voter concerned are informed. It was possible by this process to correct a large number of errors in identity card numbers. Attempts by voters to enter their names under several addresses, for various reasons could also be prevented by National Identity Card numbers being included in the electoral Register.

Number of persons, who produced National Identity Cards at the 2013 enumeration and the comparative statement on the number of persons producing details of the National Identity Cards at the revisions of electoral registers from year 2004 – 2013 are shown in Table VII and VIII respectively.

- 2.2.20. Action was taken to delete the name of one person from the 2013 electoral register as he was reported to be imprisoned for offences committed under the Bribery Act. Relevant details are shown in Table IX.
- 2.2.21. The Electoral Registers for the year 2013 were certified under Section 18 of the Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980 on 31.12.2013. The Notice under Section 20 of the Act was published in Gazette No. 1843 / 9 of 31.12.2013 and in newspapers.
- 2.2.22. Number of electors registered in 2012 and 2013 according to the electoral districts and the comparative statement of number of electors in polling divisions of each electoral district from the year 2004 to 2013 are shown in Table X and XI respectively.

2.3. Registration of Electors (Special Provisions) Act, No. 27 of 2013

- 2.3.1. Registration of Electors (Special Provisions) Act, No. 27 of 2013 which is to make special provisions to exempt internally displaced persons from certain requirements of the Registration of Electors Act, No. 44 of 1980 and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto was passed in the Parliament on 21st of June 2013.
- 2.3.2. Accordingly, the objective of this was to enable internally displaced persons and their children eligible to vote, to exercise their right to franchise in the electoral district in which their permanent places of residence were situated prior to being internally displaced as a result of military actions or certain actions of other militant terrorists or other groups in the recent past.
- 2.3.3. According to Section 2 of the Registration of Electors (Special Provisions) Act, No.27 of 2013, a person
 - 2.3.3.1 who is or had been an internally displaced person,
 - 2.3.3.2. whose name appeared in the register of electors for any electoral district in the Northern Province or Eastern Province for any year, until the end of the year 2009,

- 2.3.3.3. whose name has not been entered in any register in operation subsequent to the year 2009, and
- I. who had not attained the age of eighteen years on the date on which such citizen became an internally displaced person and have attained the age of eighteen years or more on the date on which the revision commenced in respect of the register in operation, at the time at which the application is made,
 - II. who were born after such citizen became an internally displaced person and have attained the age of eighteen years or more on the date on which the revision commenced in respect of the register in operation, at the time in which the application is made, and
 - III. who is a child of Sri Lankan citizens referred in afore mentioned paragraph, whose names have not been entered in any register in operation subsequent to the year 2009, could submit his application to insert his/ her name in the supplementary register.
- 2.3.4. The notice under the provisions of Registration of Electors (Special Provisions) Act, No. 27 of 2013 was published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 1815/18 of 21.06.2013 and applications from qualified persons were accepted from 22.06.2013 to 28.06.2013. Considering the applications received up to 29.06.2013 and representations submitted by qualified persons, duration for acceptance of applications was extended to 02.07.2013. The notice in this regard was published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 1816/44 on 29.06.2013 and actions were taken to issue a media release on the same day.
- 2.3.5. The notice under Section 3(1) of the Registration of Electors (Special Provisions) Act, No. 27 of 2013 was published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 1817/28 of 03.07.2013 and Assistant Registering Officers of relevant electoral districts took necessary action to declare the period for submission of appeals and objections, as from 03.07.2013 to 09.07.2013.
- 2.3.6. Total number of applications received during the whole period, including the period for appeals was 10,243. No objections were received. Number of applications which were taken in to consideration was 8,831 and from that 4,989 applications were accepted. Information in this regard is given in Table XII.

3. Parliamentary Elections Act, No. 1 of 1981

3.1 Recognition of political parties.

3.1.1. The provisions in the Parliamentary Elections Act, No. 1 of 1981 regarding the recognition of political parties were amended by Parliamentary Elections (Amendment) Act, No. 58 of 2009 which was passed on 16.09.2009 and according to the new provisions the Commissioner should call for applications from political parties for recognition in January every year. If any election is pending in this month, actions relevant to calling for applications should be taken within 30 days after such election.

3.1.2. Due to the holding of elections to Local Authorities on 17.03.2011, 23.07.2011 and 08.10.2011 and the elections to Pudukudiiruppu and Maritiméattu Pradeshiya Sabhas in Mullaitivu District were scheduled to be held before 31.12.2011 action could not be taken according to the provisions of the Act regarding the recognition of political parties during the year 2011. Elections to afore mentioned two Pradeshiya Sabhas were postponed to 10.03.2012 and to 24.03.2012. Therefore, calling for applications for recognition of political parties during the first quarter of 2012 was prevented. Meanwhile, the two cases viz. No. CA (Writ) 72/2012 and CA (Writ) 74/2012 which were filed on 12.03.2012 were considered by the Court of Appeal on 19.03.2012 and an interim order was issued to postpone the elections until the hearing of the petitions were completed. Applications for registration of new parties could not be called, as these cases were pending during the year 2013 and the elections for these two Pradeshiya Sabhas have to be held in accordance with its judgement. Advice in this regard has been sought from the Attorney General and he has also advised that it was not appropriate to call applications for recognition of political parties under these circumstances. In terms of the provisions of the Act necessary steps regarding the recognition of parties could not be taken during the year 2013 due to the aforesaid reason.

3.2 The Commissioner of Elections is required by Section 7(4) b of the Parliamentary Elections Act, to publish the list of recognized political parties in the Government Gazette at the commencement of every calendar year. Accordingly, the list of parties was published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 1794/3 of 31.01.2013 and accordingly 63 parties were registered as recognized political parties for the year 2013. The list is shown in Table No. XIII.

- 3.3 On 28.12.2010 the Commissioner of Elections rejected the application made by the Democratic Party in the year 2010 to recognize it as a Recognized Political Party under the Parliamentary Elections Act No. 1 of 1981 which was amended by the Amendment Act No. 58 of 2009. The party challenged this decision by filing petition No. HRC / 1971/11 at the Human Rights Commission. The Commission issued recommendation to the Commissioner of Elections to reconsider the party's suitability. The Commissioner then conducted interviews on 12.03.2013 and 28.03.2013 to re-examine the qualifications of the Democratic Party for recognition as a Political Party. Accordingly, from 01.04.2013 Democratic Party was considered as a recognized political party and the approved symbol for the party was determined as the Flaming Torch. Accordingly, the number of recognized political parties in year 2013 was amended to 64.
- 3.4 There were changes to the names of three recognized political parties during the year 2013. Accordingly -
- 3.4.1 Name of the recognized political party, viz. Ceylon Democratic Unity Alliance was changed in to United People's Party from 03.07.2013.
- 3.4.2 Name of the recognized political party, viz. Left Liberation Front was changed in to Nationalities Unity Organization from 23.07.2013.
- 3.4.3 Name of the recognized political party, viz. Akila Ilankai Tamil United Front was changed in to Akila Ilankai Tamil Mahasabha from 30.09.2013.
- 3.5 Action was taken to fill one vacancy in the Membership of Parliament in the year 2013 and detail of it is shown in Table XIV.

04. Administration Report of the Commissioner of Elections for the year 2012

This report was tabled in Parliament on 09.04.2013.

05. Provincial Councils Elections Act, No. 2 of 1988

5.1 Provincial Councils Elections – 2013

- 5.1.1. Provincial Councils of Central and North Western were dissolved at midnight of 05th July 2013 by Extraordinary Gazettes No. 1817/38 and 1817/39 respectively. Under the Section 10(1) of the Provincial Councils Elections Act, No. 2 of 1988, His Excellency the President by his order No. C.S.A. 9/2/8 on 5th July 2013 ordered to conduct the election to establish the Provincial Council of Northern Province in terms of Article 154 (A) (2) of Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka. Accordingly, notices of nominations for Kandy, Matale, Nuwara Eliya, Jaffna, Kilinochchi, Mannar, Vavuniya, Mullaitivu, Kurunegala and Puttalam Administrative Districts which belong Central, North and North Western Provincial Councils were published in the Extra Ordinary Gazette No. 1818/21 of 11th July, 2013.

5.1.2. Accordingly, nominations were received at relevant offices of District Returning Officers from 25.07.2013 to 12.00 noon on 01.08.2013. Out of 210 nominations received, 09 were rejected. A total number of 3785 candidates from 201 accepted nominations of 25 recognized political parties and 75 independent groups were in contest. The date of poll was fixed for 21 September 2013. There were 4,363,252 registered voters in the three provinces where the election were held, 3,712 polling stations and 24 polling stations for displaced voters were established.

5.2. Permit to cast vote at another polling station

5.2.1. According to the Section 125 of Provincial Councils Elections Act No. 2 of 1988 amended by Provincial Councils Elections (Amendment) Act No. 7 of 1988, facilities were provided to electors who were compelled by conditions prevailing in the area within which their polling stations were situated to reside outside such areas and who reasonably fear that they would be unable to cast their votes at such polling stations, to cast their votes at another polling station.

5.2.2 Electors in Vavuniya Electoral District who could not cast their votes were provided another 1 polling station in Jaffna District and 1 in Anuradhapura District, electors in Mannar were provided another 19 polling stations in Puttalam District and one in Anuradhapura and electors in Mullaitivu were provided 2 polling stations in Puttalam to cast their votes.

5.3 Procedure followed at the election

5.3.1. The competition between candidates of each of the political parties and among the candidates of the same party for preferences commenced immediately after the period of nominations. Commissioner of Elections received a large number of complaints on displaying of illegal posters, banners, cutouts and misusing of state property for election propaganda. Establishment of election offices by political parties and independent groups in excess of the number legally allowed was also observed.

5.3.2. Number of complaints received by the Commissioner of Elections grew rapidly with the spread of this phenomenon. Action was taken to establish complaint centers in all District Secretaries apart from the complaint centre established at the Elections Secretariat to accept complaints.

5.3.3. Besides the Consultative Committee comprising of Secretaries of all contesting political parties and Inspector General of Police which met regularly, a Standing Committee consisting of representatives of political parties and observer organizations was also established at the Election Complaints Monitoring Bureau to discuss and obtain views about the matters relating to conduct of free, fair and peaceful election.

Deputy / Assistant Commissioners of Elections of all the districts, where there were no elections, were attached to the districts where elections were scheduled and all steps were taken to prevent increasing illegal activities.

5.3.5. Secretaries of all Ministries, Chief Secretaries of Provincial Councils and Heads of Institutions were issued written instructions on prohibition of misuse of state property. Additional Secretaries of Ministries were summoned to a meeting held at the Elections Secretariat, at which in depth instructions were given on prevention of misuse of state property. Lengthy discussions about the steps to be followed at Government institutions on appointments and transfers during this period were held. Large amount of complaints about appointments and transfers on political grounds were received during this period and necessary steps were followed regarding them.

5.3.6. Guidelines to private and public media institutions were issued and Heads of media institutions were summoned, and necessary instructions were given about conduct of the media during the period of the election. Further, a code of conduct was issued to the political parties.

5.3.7. The Commissioner of Elections continuously interacted personally with the Secretaries of Ministries, Chief Secretaries of Provincial Councils and District Secretaries during this period and took all necessary steps to ensure the conduct of a free and fair election by preventing illegal activities.

5.3.8. Steps which were followed at the previous elections to ensure the security of polling stations and ballot boxes were implemented at this time also and necessary action was also taken after considering the various requests made by the political parties in this regard. Appropriate action was taken specially to get rid of doubts expressed by political parties regarding the poll, count of votes and declaration of results.

5.4. Pre election period and poll day

5.4.1. The poll day was calm and peaceful though the pre election period recorded disturbances and clashes to some extent. No incidents of obstructive nature occurred to disturb the poll other than some minor incidents. As the National Identity Card was mandatory for expressing the vote, situations arising out of attempts to impersonate were minimal.

5.4.2. Consideration was given to the requests of the contesting political parties at the election and action was taken to inform South Asian Election Management Body and Commonwealth Secretariat to nominate observation groups to observe the election. President of Indian Election Commission who was the Chairmen of South Asian Election Management Body at that time nominated 20 observers representing election bodies in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal and Pakistan and Mr. N. Gopalaswami, former Chief Elections Commissioner of Indian Election Commission was appointed as the Chairman of the group. Secretary General of Commonwealth Secretariat appointed a group of four observers including Mr. Stephen Kalonzo Musyoka former Vice President of Kenya Republic as the Head. Observers of South Asian Election Management Body were directed to observe election in Jaffna, Kilinochchi, Mannar, Vavuniya and Mullaitive Administrative Districts where election to Northern Provincial Council was held and they were provided the opportunity to meet the agents of the contesting political parties and local observation groups in Colombo.

5.4.3. A minimum of one officer from other districts was deployed to polling stations, besides the officers in the district for poll duties. All the officers of the Department of Elections and officers from other Departments who were engaged with the duties of the Department were also deployed for duties in the districts. The aim of the Commissioner of Elections was to carry out a comprehensive observation about the election by them. The number of centres for receiving election related complaints which were established throughout the pre election period were increased further on the poll day. Necessary steps were taken to refer the complaints, which were received by the centres, to the relevant places instantly for follow up action regarding them. Counting of votes commenced as scheduled as there were no adverse reports received through observation reports which justified annulment of polls.

5.5 Counting of votes and declaration of results

5.5.1. There were a total of 478 counting centres established in ten districts and 402 of them being ordinary counting centres, 73 postal votes counting centres and 3 centres for counting displaced votes. Results of each centre were received and checked at the Head Office and confirmed by the Commissioner of Elections. Results which were confirmed were given to the electronic Medias through the Director of Information for broadcast. Under Section 60 of the Provincial Councils Elections Act No. 2 of 1988, the names of the elected members were published in Gazette No. 1829/33 of 25th September, 2013 by Commissioner of Elections. Detailed results of the three provinces are shown in the Table XV.

- 5.6. Details regarding to filling of vacancies of members of Provincial Councils during the year 2013 are shown in Table XVI.

06. Local Authorities Elections Ordinance

- 6.1 Two petitions viz. CA (Writ) 72/2012 and CA(Writ) 74/2012 which challenged the holding of the elections to Puthukudiiruppu and Maritimapatu Pradeshiya Sabha of Mullaitive District were filed at the Court of Appeal on 12th March, 2012. An interim order to postpone the elections, until completion of resettlement of people in welfare camps due to war situation prevailing in Northern and Eastern Provinces, was issued by the Court of Appeal after considering the petitions on 19th March, 2012. Therefore, elections to those two Pradeshiya Sabhas were not conducted during the year 2013.
- 6.2. The elections to Batticaloa Municipal Council, Pradeshiya Sabhas of Eravurpattu, Koralepattu, Koralepattu North, Manmune South and Eruvilpattu, Manmune, Manmune West, Manmune South West and Porativupattu which were postponed due to security reasons by the Local Authorities (Special Provisions) Act, No. 30 of 2007, were held on 10th March, 2008. The terms of office of these Councils were scheduled to cease on 10th March, 2012. But according to the Notice published by the Minister of Local Government and Provincial Councils in the Gazette No. 1737/5 of 19th December, 2011, the terms of office of these councils were extended to 17th March, 2013. As the elections were not held until such date, administration of the Local Authorities has been vested in a Special Commissioner.
- 6.3. The Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 262) was amended by the Local Authorities Filling of Vacancies (Special Provisions) Act, No. 30 of 2013 with effect from 12th July, 2013.
- 6.4. Accordingly, only vacancies in Municipal Councils, Urban Councils and Pradeshiya Sabhas were filled in year 2013 and the relevant details are shown in Table XVII, XVIII and XIX.

07. Staff.

- 7.1. Ms. U.G.H.P. Dharmadasa, Sinhala/English Translator and Mr. A.M Muhajireen, Sinhala/Tamil Translator were appointed by the Secretary to the Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs, by his letters No. 1/104/867(G) and 1/104/884(G) respectively dated 31.12.2012. They assumed duties at the Head Office on 01.01.2013.

- 7.2. Mr. T.A.C.N. Talangama, S.L.A.S. Class I, who was serving at the Kegalle District Elections Office in this Department was appointed as the Deputy Commissioner of Elections of Kurunegala District Elections Office with effects from 15.01.2013.
- 7.3. Mr. J.A.S.P. Jayasinghe, S.L.A.S. Class III, who was attached to this Department by the Secretary to the Ministry of Administration and Home Affairs, and Secretary to the Ministry of Co-operatives and Internal Trade, by their letters No. 75/10/4548 of 07.11.2012 and No. CIT/2/2/9/9 of 11.01.2013 respectively, was appointed as Assistant Commissioner of Elections (Parliamentary Elections) with effects from 16.01.2013.
- 7.4. By the letter No. MF 12/05/0/2356 dated 27.02.2013 of the Deputy Secretary of Treasury, Ms. G.K.S.C.K Yasaratne of Class III of Sri Lanka Accountants' Service, who was attached to this Department from 08.03.2013, was appointed as Accountant (Payment) on the same date.
- 7.5. Mr. P. Kuganathan of Class III of Sri Lanka Administrative Service, who was transferred to this Department, from 12.07.2013 by letter No. HAF-2/3/DSAPP/04/325 dated 05.07.2013, by the Secretary to the Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs was appointed as an Assistant Commissioner of Elections from 01.10.2013.
- 7.6. Mr. S.S. Hettiarachchi of Special Grade of Sri Lanka Administrative Service was transferred to this Department with effect from 16.07.2013 by the Secretary, Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs, by his letter No. 75/10/3144 dated 16.07.2013. Mr. Hettiarachchi was appointed to a post of Deputy Commissioner of Elections effective from that date.
- 7.7. Mr. P. Ragunathan, Mr.R. Saseelan and Mr. D.C. Aravintharaj, probationary officers of Class III of Sri Lanka Administrative Service who were attached to this Department for training from 16.08.2013, by Secretary of Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs, by his letter No. R/1/1/2011 (SP) dated 15.08.2013 were appointed as Assistant Commissioners of Elections in the Department of Elections with effect from 19.12.2013.
- 7.8. Mr. U.D.D.D. Chandraratne of Class III of Sri Lanka Administrative Service who was transferred to this Department from 08.11.2013, by the letter No. 75/10/5243 dated 24.10.2013 of Secretary, Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs was appointed as an Assistant Commissioner of Elections from 19.12.2013.

- 7.9. The total number of vacancies in cadre of the Public Management Assistants' Service was 51 as at 01.06.2013. Ministry of Public Administration was informed to give the priority to fill these vacancies at the time of new recruitments to the Class III of Public Management Assistants' Service.
- 7.10. Approval of Cabinet of Ministers was given to extend up to 31.12.2013 the service period of 18 casual Management Assistants who were recruited by the Department of Elections to meet the special needs of working in both official languages.
- 7.11. A letter was submitted to the Department of Management Services requesting their approval to recruit 10 persons according to the provisions of Public Administration Circular 24/95 and Service Minute of Office Employees' Service to fill the vacancies in Office Employees' Service of the Department of Elections to fill vacancies as at 11.12.2013.
- 7.12. Ms. K.S.M. Rangani and Ms. A.P.P. Abeysekara officers of Public Management Assistants' Service who were attached to Elections Secretariat and Colombo City Elections Office respectively, were released after their duty on 12.07.2013 to assume duties as Grade III officers of Sri Lanka Planning Service.
- 7.13. Ms. K.K.G.S.P.Wijethilake, of the Class II of Public Management Assistants' Service who was serving at the Elections Secretariat was released after her duty on 18.07.2013 to enable her to assume duties of a post of Grade III of Sri Lanka Accountants' Service.
- 7.14. One male officer and two female officers of Public Management Assistants' Service who were serving at District Elections Offices in Ampara, Ratnapura and Puttalam were released from this Department as they received appointments in other Services.

Transfers

- 7.15 Mr. S. Suthakaran, Class III of Sri Lanka Administrative Service who was serving as the Assistant Commissioner of Elections, Vavuniya was attached to Chief Secretary's Office, Eastern Province by the Secretary, Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs, by his letter No. 75/10/4814 dated 31.12.2012. He was therefore released from the Department of Elections with effect from 17.01.2013. The service rendered to the Department by him is appreciated.

- 7.16 Mr. C.A. Suneth Lochana, Class III of Sri Lanka Administrative Service was released from the post of Assistant Commissioner of Elections, Matara with effect from 07.08.2013, enable him to assume duties as the Additional District Secretary, District Secretariat, Hambantota as per letter No. HAF - 1/ 8/2 dated 24.07.2013 of the Secretary, Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs. I appreciate the services rendered to the Department by him.
- 7.17 According to the letter No. 75/10/3144 on 13.08.2013 of Secretary, Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs, Mr. S.S. Hettiarachchi, Special Grade of Sri Lanka Administrative Service who served in the Department of Elections as a Deputy Commissioner of Elections was released to assume duties in the Department of Pensions from 18.08.2013, Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs. The Services rendered by him to the Department are appreciated.
- 7.18 Six officers of Public Management Assistant's Service were transferred out of the Department under the annual transfers in 2013 and their six substitutes assumed duties in the Department. Another ten officers of Public Management Assistants' Service who expressed their desire to serve in this Department were transferred to this Department in 2013 under inter Department transfers.
- 7.19 Five officers of Public Management Assistants' Service, four members of Office Employees' Service and 2 drivers were transferred out of the Department and one mutual transfer within the Public Management Assistants' Service was effected during the year 2013.

Creation of new posts.

- 7.20 Upgrading of the post of Accountant (Internal Audit) Grade II/III of Sri Lanka Accountants' service of this Department to Chief Internal Auditor, Grade I of Sri Lanka Accountants' Service was approved by the Director General, Department of Management Services of Ministry of Finance and Planning by his letter No. DMS/1014 dated 26.02.2013.
- 7.21 A post of Additional Commissioner of Elections (Laws and Review), Special Class of Sri Lanka Administrative Service and a post of Director (Information Technology), Grade I of Class I of Sri Lanka Information and Communication Technology Service have been approved by Director General, Department of Management Services of Ministry of Finance and Planning, by his letter No. DMS/1014 dated 02.10.2013.
- 7.22 Few more posts were created with the approval of the Management Services Department in view of the increase in the work of the Department. Accordingly, 50 new posts of Documentary Assistants as Departmental posts were created.

- 7.23 Twenty six posts under Development Officers' Service, of which 25 from Graduates with a degree in Information Technology on a district basis and one post of Budget Assistant were newly created.
- 7.24 One post of Public Management Assistants' Service and one post of Office Employees' Service were created for the Transport Unit.

Retirements

- 7.25 During the year 2013, 05 officers of Public Management Assistants' Service and 2 members of Office Employees' Service of this Department retired from the service. The services rendered by all of them to this Department are appreciated. The list of names of the retirees of 2013, is shown in Table No. XX.

8. Trainings

8.1 Local

- 8.1.1 Steps were taken to provide subjective knowledge to the staff officers and officers of Public Management Assistants' Service through the training programmes conducted by organizations such as Public Service Training Institute, Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration, Institute of Chartered Accountants', National Institute of Business Management, Department of State Accounts, Sri Lanka Foundation Institute, Centre for Construction and Equipment Training, National Institute of Labour Studies, etc.
- 8.1.2. Several training programmes on Accounts and Payments, General Administration, matters in relation with storeroom administration and Audit, revision of electoral registers, co-ordination in between District Elections Offices and the Head Office and performance of special duties assign at a election were conducted at the Head Office and District Elections Offices, in Kandy, Matara and Anuradhapura to make relevant officers of all District Offices aware about minimization of audit queries.

9. Constructions and assets

- 9.1 The room formerly occupied by the Administration Unit of the Head Office was converted for use by the Accountant (Payments) and Accounts Branch at a cost of Rs.1,50,700/-.
- 9.2 Part of the room of the Administration Unit of the Head Office was partitioned for the use of two translators costing Rs. 1, 47,114/-
- 9.3 Toilet and bathroom attached to the office room of the Election Commissioner was repaired through the Department of Buildings at a cost of Rs. 12,66,496/-
- 9.4 Rs. 1,21,170/- was expended to make necessary changes of Record Room of the Head Office.
- 9.5 The estimate submitted by the Department of Buildings for the addition to the main building of the Elections Secretariat was Rs. 42,540,000/- inclusive of all taxes. First installment, Rs.10,000,000/- and Second installment, Rs. 12,000,000 were paid on 15.03.2013 and 28.11.2013 respectively. Relevant improvements to the proposed building are being carried out.
- 9.6 Power Transformer of the Head Office had to be reestablished due to the widening of the Kotte Road and Rs. 401,133/- was paid to the Lanka Electricity (Private) Limited for this purpose.
- 9.7 In addition to this, necessary actions were taken to repair the District Elections Offices and official quarters within the limits of the provisions provided.
- 9.8 On 29.04.2013, the Ministry of Finance supplied a Toyota Car at a cost of Rs.9,000,000/- The registration no. of the vehicle is WPKV – 7617.

- 9.9 Accordingly, number of vehicles owned by the Department of Elections as at 31.12.2013 was mentioned below.

10. Financial Information

- 10.1 Rs. 874.3 million was spent to conduct elections for the Central, Northern and North Western Province Councils. The cost per elector has not been changed when compared to the Eastern, North Central and Sabaragamuwa Provincial Councils Elections, held in the previous year. While the need to summon foreign observers, and deploy additional officers to supervise the polling stations to ensure a free and fair election in the Northern Province and increase in the allowances of polling station were the reason for the increase in the cost, the election was done at a low cost due to the control of expenditure incurred by the Police Department and Postal Department and frugality of expenditure.
- 10.2 The cost of preparation of the electoral register in year 2013 was approximately Rs.87 million which shows an increase of Rs. 7 million compared to the expenditure incurred in regard to the year 2012. The expenditure in preparation of the register was increased due to the conduct of special awareness programmes for voters after naming the 01st of June 2013 as “Voters Day”.
- 10.3 The recurrent expenses in year 2012 and 2013 were Rs. 930.1 million and Rs. 1314.7 million respectively. The recurrent expenses in 2013 show a 41% increase when compared to 2012.
- 10.4 The capital expenditure in 2013 was Rs.40.6 million which is Rs. 16.8 million higher than in 2012. The increase in the capital expenditure was due to completion of the first stage of addition of a new portion to the Head Office, repairs and maintenance of existing buildings and purchase of necessary machinery, equipment, office items to the District Elections Offices.
- 10.5 All the applications for disaster loans were granted in this year and loans up to Rs.17.4 million was paid to 196 members of the staff. This is an increase of Rs. 5.49 million compared to the previous year.

- 10.6 Revenue earned by issue of extracts of the electoral register was Rs. 8.55 million in the year 2013 and it indicates an increase of Rs. 4.21 million when compared with the previous year. The reasons for the increase in this regard are due to the ability to issue all the extracts requested for interviews and for obtaining lands in Northern and Eastern Provinces.
- 10.7 Rs. 1.26 million in revenue was earned by sale of electoral register through compact discs in 2013 with the increase of production of the register in CD format while limiting the preparation of the register in book form.
- 10.8 Rs. 412,400/- was expended on domestic training courses of staff officers and non-staff officers to improve the efficiency of the Department.
