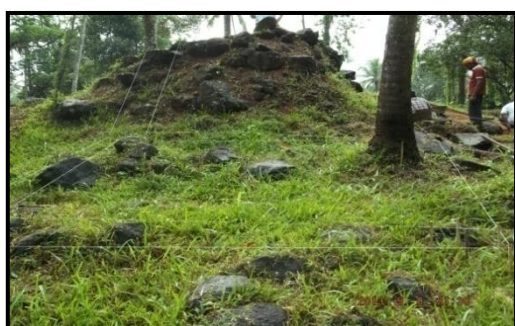
Excavation Division

➤ **Excavation of front compound of standing image of Reswehera.**

Mahawansa and other physical factors ensure that the standing image of Reswehera and other structures there had been constructed during the period from B.C. 3 to B.C. 6-7 centuries. Conservation activities were followed by revealing the part of front compound of the standing image of Reswehera by excavations.

➤ **Excavation of Seethawaka Rajasinghe Palace premises.**

The main objective of the excavation of this construction which has been located at Bandarawatta village of Divisional Secretariat Dehiowita of Kegalle District to ensure whether this palace premises has been constructed by King Mayadunna in A.D. 14-15 centuries and to discover the hillock where the fortress building has been constructed at this place. Subsequent to conservation it was open for the public exhibition.

➤ Projects implemented in 2012

- Thanthirimale Museum was splendidly opened for public exhibition on 16.August 2012 by His Excellency the President Mahinda Rajapaksha.
- Since it has been proposed to refurbish the two storied building of Archaeological Museum Anuradhapura the artifacts kept for exhibition presently shifted and store in old provincial office. Similarly the locks of cupboards were opened by a recommended group for removing and storing of the said exhibition items of the museum.
- Artifacts of Archaeological Museum Nawalar Jaffna were shifted to the Conservation office at fort Jaffna in respect of the Project Tour of Ambassador, Nederland in 2012
- Providing non exhibited replica of the Archaeological Stores with the objective of beautifying the surrounding area of publication sales outlet proposed to be commenced at the archaeological location Welekade and for tourist attraction.
- Since a properly functioned administrative museum is not within the Uwa Province action was taken to arrange initial steps required for the construction of an administrative museum at Badulla town.

Architectural Conservation Division

- **Conservation of Kalugal Pokuna (pond made of Mattel) of Idikatuseya, Mihinthale**

This conservation project was implemented with the objective of conserving the Kalugal Pokuna (the pond made of Mattel) of Idikatuseya premises situated at Divisional Secretariat Division Mihinthale in Anuradhapura District. Misplaced Mattel plaques of this pond in 100 Feet length and 80 Feet width were properly placed and conserved under this conservation project and a sum of Rs. 3,744,959.00 was incurred for this project. This project was implemented during the period from 09.07.2012 – 31.12.2012.



After conservation of the Kalugal Pokuna

- **Malasne Devalaya Uggalboda**

This conservation project was implemented with the objective of conserving the *Devalaya* belongs to *Malasne Viharaya* situated at Divisional Secretariat Kaluthara of Kaluthara District. In this conservation project extra attention was focused on conservation activities of the part of Vishnu Devalaya. Firstly the roof was conserved and action was taken to construct the frame of the roof with new timber and to thatch roofing tiles and filling craters. Then the parts where plaster was detracted were completely fixed. New blocks and bricks and stones were placed and plastered and white washed and pillars of the gate were constructed.



After conservation of the Devala

- **Conservation of Yudaganawa Dagoba.**

This conservation project was implemented for the conservation of Yudaganawa Upper Dagoba situated at Divisional Secretariat Buththala, in Monaragala District.

The prime objective of this conservation project was to construction of a formal Diagonal which was irregularly constructed and ensures the safety of it. The major attention was focused on constructing ramparts required for the direction of the circular of the Dagoba. Presently there is no soil erosion of the Dagoba is taken place and walls between eastern and northern parts of the Dagoba have been constructed in 2011. Action was taken to build the incomplete parts of the eastern bulwark of the Dagoba to the shape of a Dagoeba. The project was finalized by building ramparts in the size of 25.47 cubes for the construction of circular of the Adobe.

➤ **Conservation of window with colored glasses at the Wulfondal Church**

The Wulfondal Church positioned on a small hill at the fort was built by (VOC) Eastern Dutch in 1749. Dutch East Indian Trading Company of (VOC) This church is considered as an eye-catching church in Asia. The church which has been built according to the Greek Doric tradition and the normal thickness of a wall of this church is about five feet.

Since the colored glass windows with wooden frames have been dilapidated due the exposure to various climatic conditions for a long time these windows have been repaired by fixing led framed in 1870. However presently those windows have been yet again dilapidated. Accordingly a project for conserving colored windows was launched by the Department of Archaeology amalgamated with the Central Cultural fund and institute of (Bloom Glazier) of Netherland in 2012. Netherlands interfered for this.

Mr. Peter Bloom the head of the institute of Bloom Glazier functioned as the conservation expert of this project. Earlier he had guided a project of conserving colored windows of the contemporary reprimand church located in Galle Fort and four conservators of Central cultural fund and one conservators of the Department of Archaeology who have been trained there participated in this project. In addition one lady officer and four employees from the Department of Archaeology participated for the training of conservation of colored windows

First of all drawing of the plan of the church building and the placement of windows and photographing the same was launched. This was done by a designing Technician and a Photographer of the Department of Archaeology. Then windows were taken away from the walls and marked and photographed. Broken glasses were removed and new glasses were fixed and reusable glasses were cleaned and used. Wooden frames were removed and led frames were replaced. Old paint of the window frames were scratched and removed and new paint was applied and water proof liquids were applied on newly added wooden frames before they were painted. Finally, parts of the window were assembled and replaces in the wall.

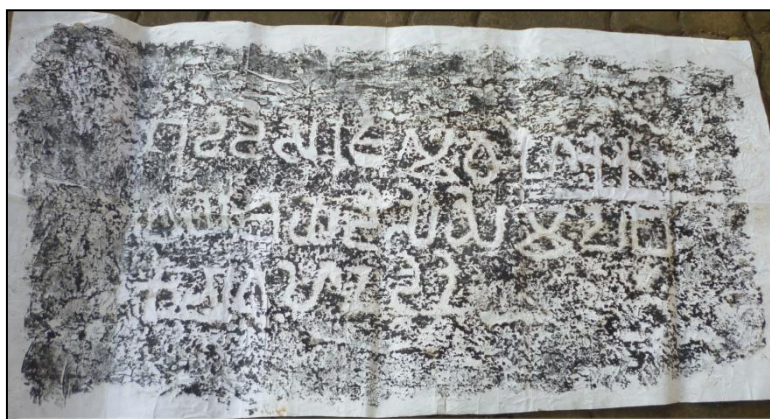

947 coins from the collection of coins at the Archaeological Museum Panduwasnuwara were indexed under this project.

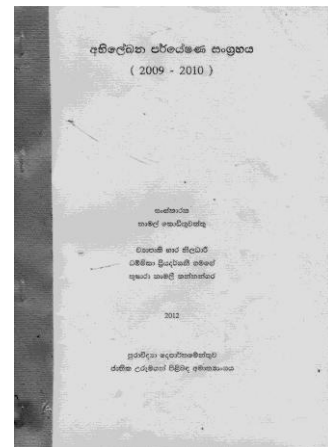


Obverse and reverse of a coin of King Wijayabahu I indexed at the Archaeological Museum Panduwasnuwara

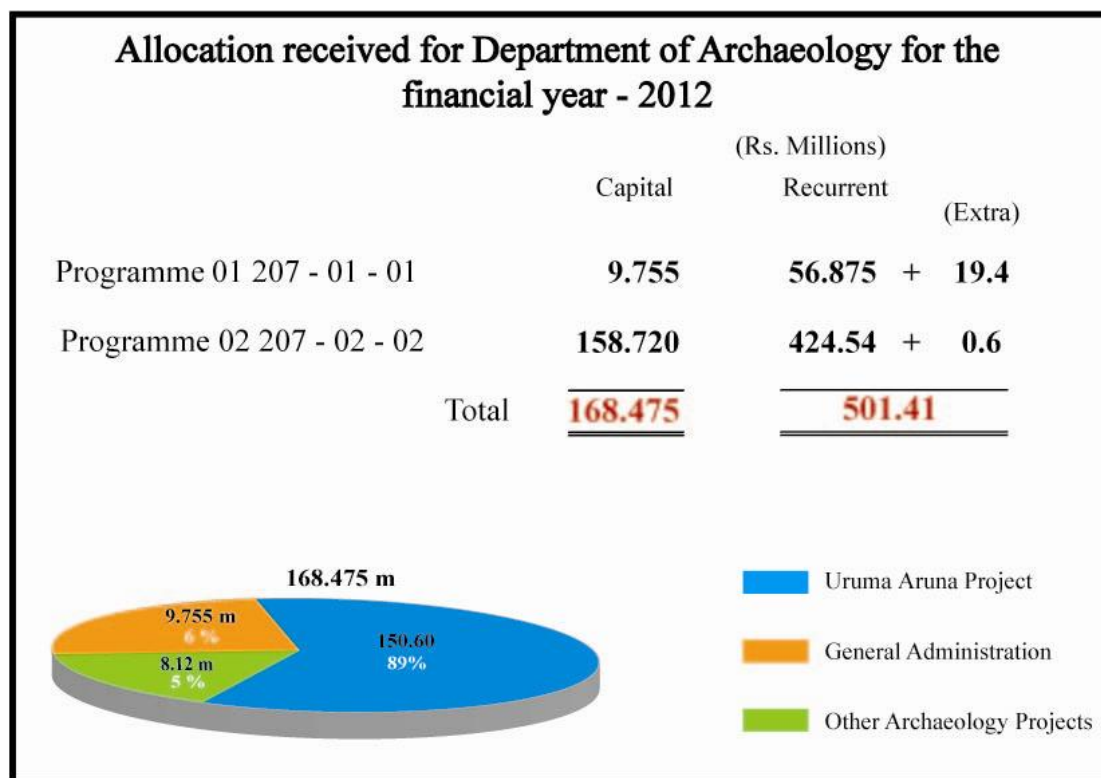

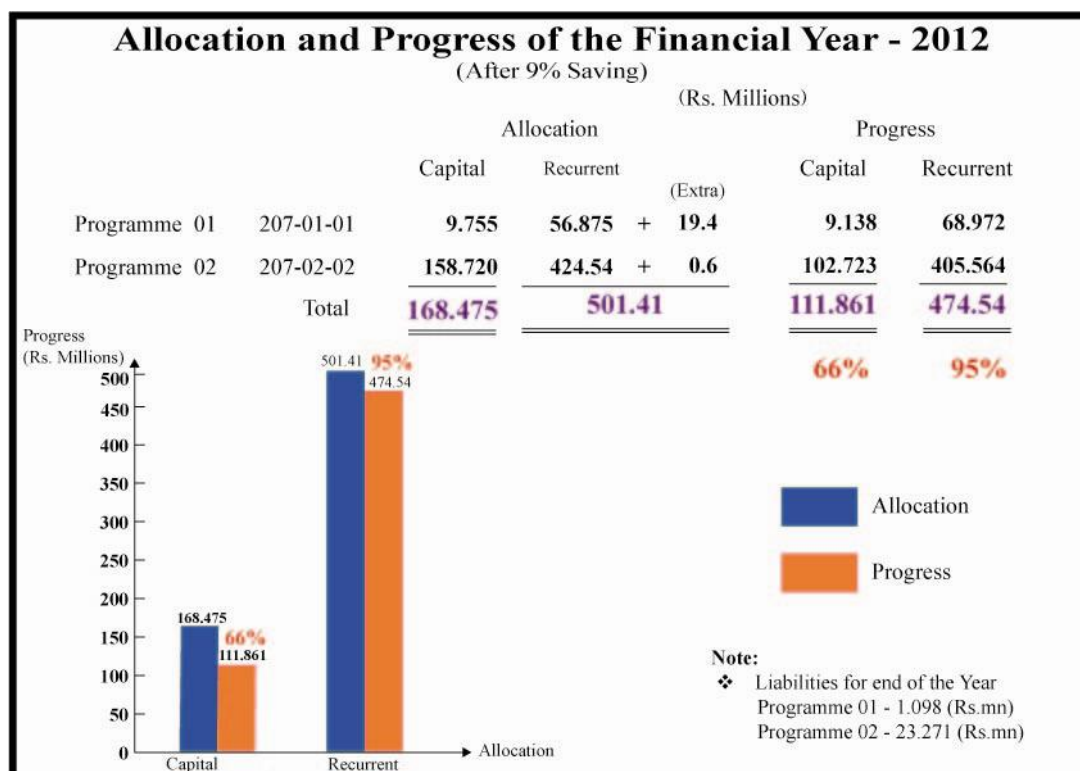

- Financial progress of provisions received by the Department of Archaeology in 2012



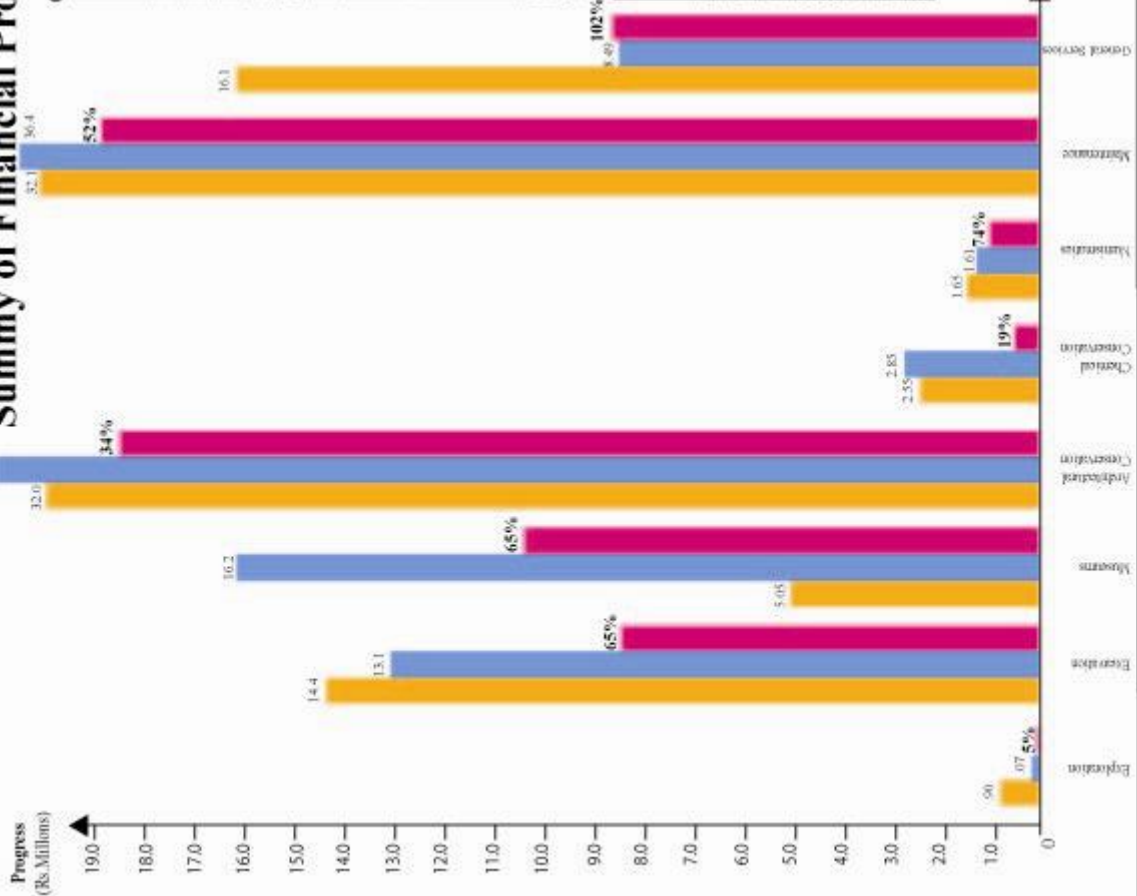

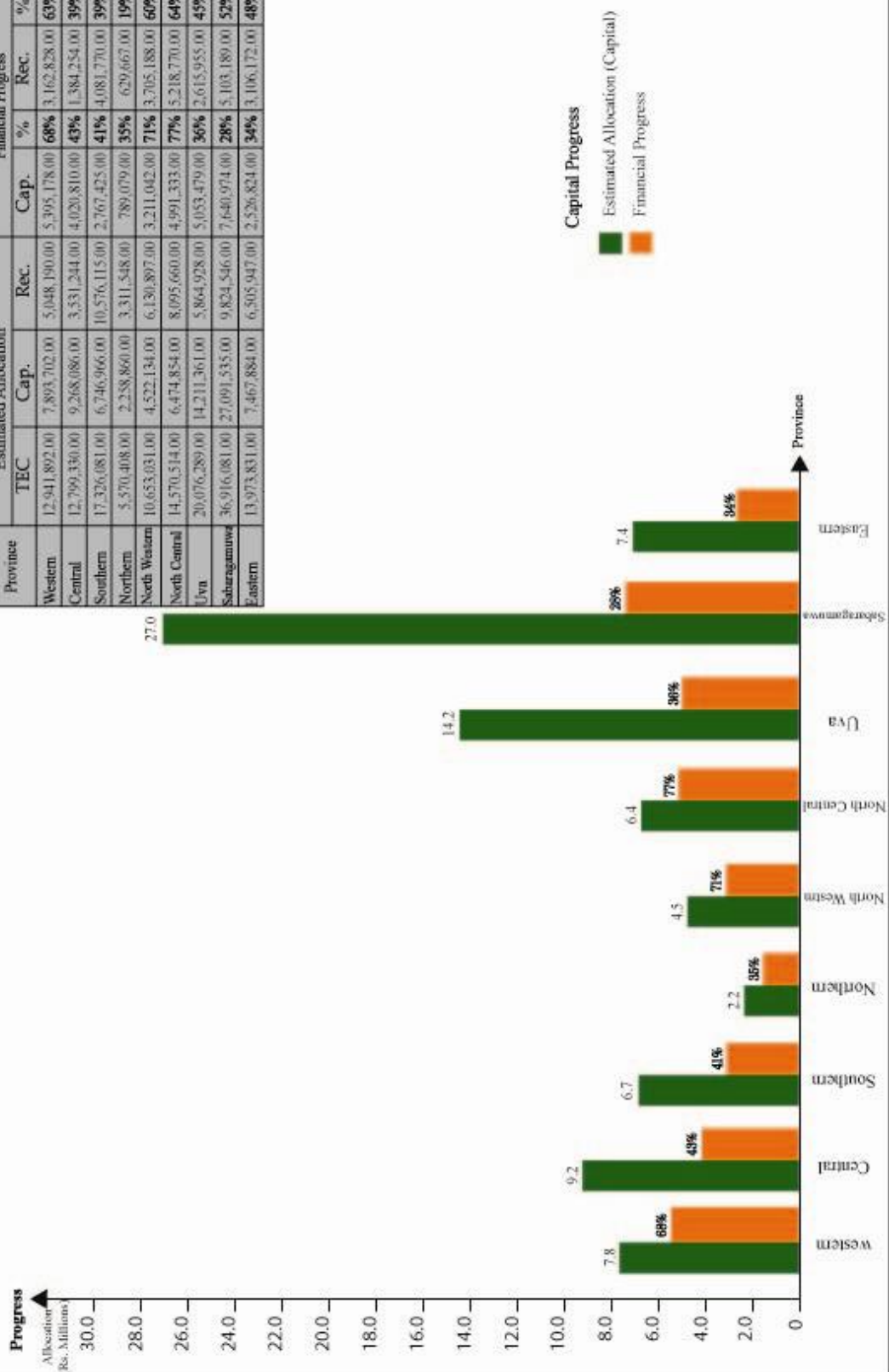
